Keep uninvited guests out

If ants or cockroaches are calling your house "home," there's no need to resort to cruel and toxic pesticides or traps. Like all animals, these tiny beings suffer when they are poisoned, trapped, or otherwise killed. Pesticides can be hazardous to humans and other animals and, like all killing methods, don't solve the problem, since more insects will soon move in to fill the vacancy left by those who were killed.

Humane control methods—including removing food and water sources, sealing entry points, and repelling insects with safe and natural substances that you probably already have in your home—are much kinder and will keep "uninvited guests" out for good.

Ants: A product called Orange Guard is a nontoxic organic ant repellent that is harmless to humans and other animals and will drive ants away from areas where they are not wanted. However, when applied directly to ants, the active ingredient d-Limonene (orange peel extract) destroys the waxy coating of the insects' respiratory systems, causing the ants to suffocate, so please do not spray ants with the repellent. Simply spray the repellent around your home—the citrus fragrance of d-Limonene will repel the ants without killing them.

If ants are coming in the cracks of doors and windows, put a cinnamon stick, coffee grinds, chili pepper, paprika, cloves, or dried peppermint leaves near the openings. You can also squeeze the juice of a lemon at the entry spot and leave the peel there. Planting mint around the foundation of the house will also keep ants away. Place cloves of garlic around indoor and outdoor ant pathways

Roaches: Once you have taken away food and hiding places for roaches, you can place bay leaves, cucumbers, garlic, hedgeapples, or catnip in high and damp spaces around your home to repel them.





TRASH/DUMP AREA SCHEDULE

Dump hours: Monday - Friday 8:00 am - 3:30 pm Pick-up hours: Tuesday and Friday 8:00 am till 12 noon

DO NOT PLACE TRASH OUT THE NIGHT BEFORE TRASH PICK UP

Closed: Saturday and Sunday

Trash pick-up services:

• All garbage MUST be placed into plastic bags and securely tied weighing no more than 25 pounds.

- Please do no place trash into boxes. Boxes must be flattened and tied with string. All broken glass/mirrors must be placed into a box and taped securely.
- Dispose of all medical needles and medicines properly. Do not place in trash bags.
- All newspaper should be bundled and tied securely with string.
- Trees and brush trimmings must be cut into no larger than 4-foot lengths and bundled in no more than an 18-inch diameter to be picked up.
- All weeds, leaves and lawn trimmings must be placed in plastic bags and tied closed for pickup. Bags are to weigh no more than 25 pounds as specified above.
- Furniture and construction debris will not be picked up. Place in open top dumpster.
- NO TVs, ELECTRONICS, TIRES OR PAINT FOR DISPOSAL INSTRUCTIONS, PLEASE CALL PINELLAS COUNTY SOLID WASTE DIVISION 727-464-7500. (Paint must be dried up!)

Uncontained garbage and fluids are a great health risk if inhaled by your neighbors and our staff. These rules are for everyone and not a certain few. People are still putting trash out before Tuesday or Friday mornings. Please try to obey these rules. They are for everyone.



January

"The name, given to the month of 'January', is derived from the ancient Roman name 'Janus' who presided over the gate to the new year. He was revered as the 'God of Gateways', 'of Doorways' and 'of the Journey.' Janus protected the 'Gate of Heaven', known as the 'Lord of Beginnings', is associated with the 'Goddess Juno-Janus', and often symbolized by an image of a face that looks forwards and backwards at the same time. This symbolism can easily be associated with the month known by many as the start of a new year which brings new opportunities. We cast out the old and welcome in the new. It is the time when many reflect on events of the previous year and often resolve to redress or improve some aspect of daily life or personal philosophy."

The Roman Senate, in 153 BC, declared January 1st to be the beginning of the new year. During the Middle Ages, the Church remained opposed to celebrating New Year's Day - it has only been celebrated in the western world for about 400 years.

"January is named for Janus (Ianuarius), the god of the doorway; the name has its beginnings in Roman mythology, where the Latin word for door (ianua) comes from - January is the door to the year. Traditionally, the original Roman calendar consisted of 10 months, totalling 304 days, winter being considered a monthless period. Around 713 BC, the semi-mythical successor of Romulus, King Numa Pompilius, is supposed to have added the months of January and February, allowing the calendar to equal a standard lunar year (355 days). The first day of the month is known as New Year's Day.

Although March was originally the first month in the old Roman Calendar, January assumed that position beginning in 153 BC when the two consuls, for whom the years were named, began to be chosen on January

1. The reason for this shift of the new year into the dead of winter was to allow the new consuls to complete the elections and ceremonies upon becoming consuls, and still reach their respective consular armies by the start of the campaigning.

Various Christian feast dates were used for the New Year in Europe in the Middle Ages, including March 25 and December 25. However, medieval calendars were displayed in the Roman fashion of twelve columns from January to December. Beginning in the 16th century, European countries began officially making January 1 the start of the New Year once again, sometimes called Circumcision Style because this was the date of the Feast of the Circumcision, being the 8th day from December 25."

Wasted days

man was diagnosed with a rare but fatal illness and was told he had one year left. Because he believed he had nothing to live for, he refused treatment, quit his job, withdrew from the company of family and friends, and began to drink heavily and adopt other self-destructive behaviors.

Two years later the man realized he'd outlived his initial diagnosis. He made an appointment with a new doctor, who ordered lab work and a battery of tests. The results were shocking: He'd been misdiagnosed.

As he sat in the doctor's office trying to make sense of the news he'd received, his thoughts turned to how he'd been infected with hopelessness and wasted his days over the past few years. He knew he could never reclaim that time, but he vowed to live a more purposeful life starting that day.

He stopped drinking and took an active role in maintaining his health. He returned to work and spent time with family and friends. He even made the effort to do things that he'd always dreamed about.

His advice to those who might be sick or troubled or simply down on their luck is to make every day count for something meaningful and good. Life is too precious for wasted days.

It's all about the journey

Inspirational author and minister Steve Goodier often shares a version of this story to remind us to enjoy the journey as we set out to explore our horizons.


