Dump hours: Monday - Friday 8:00 am - 3:30 pm Pick-up hours: Tuesday and Friday 557 8:00 am till 12 noon **DO NOT PLACE TRASH OUT THE NIGHT BEFORE TRASH PICK UP** Closed: Saturday and Sunday

Trash pick-up services

- All garbage must be placed into plastic bags and securely tied weighing no more than 25 lbs.
- Please do no place trash into boxes. Boxes must be flattened and tied with string. All broken glass/mirrors must be placed into a box and taped securely.
- All newspaper should be bundled and tied securely with string.
- Trees and brush trimmings must be cut into no larger than 4-foot lengths and bundled in no more than an 18-inch diameter in order to be picked up.
- All weeds, leaves and lawn trimmings must be placed in plastic bags and tied closed for proper pick-up. Bags are to weigh no more than the 25 lbs. as specified above.
- Furniture and construction debris will not be picked up. Place in open topserdumpster.
- No TV's, electronics, or tires, or paint for disposal instructions, please call Pinellas County solid waste division 727-464-7500 (Paint must be dried up!)
- Uncontained garbage and fluids are a great health risk if inhaled by your neighbors and our staff. These rules are for everyone and not a certain few. People are still putting trash out before Tuesday or Friday mornings. Please try to obey these rules. They

are for everyone.




