



1. Be vigilant - ask questions!

The more questions you ask, the more likely scammers will not have the answers, and you can catch them in their lies before they take advantage of you.

2. Don't give money to get money.

Legitimate sweepstakes companies do not require you to pay anything - fees, shipping, or prepaid taxes - to receive the prize you "won." If it sounds too good to be true, it probably is

3. Research, research, and more research.

The Internet is a valuable tool. If you aren't the first person a scammer has tried to swindle, others have likely shared their experiences online. If the scammer claims to be from a legitimate company, hang up, and directly call the company to determine legitimacy.

4. Don't provide credit card information via telephone.

And be wary if someone demands you transfer funds via a prepaid debit card (e.g., Green Dot, Pay Pal, Visa Vanilla, etc.) - because they aren't traceable, they are a scammer's best friend.

When in doubt, call law enforcement!



Caregiving has its rewards

s Americans live longer, families are feeling a heavier burden in the caregiving area. The Bureau of Labor Statistics estimates that some 40.5 million Americans are acting as unpaid caregivers for older family members. Most just help one person, but 22 percent are responsible for two people and 7 percent provide help to three or more. Most caregivers are between the ages of 45 and 64 (23 percent), but 17 percent of people older than 65 act as caregivers as well.

The demands may be high, but many Americans find the work worthwhile. Yes, 32 percent describe caregiving as stressful, but 88 percent say helping out an elderly loved one is a rewarding experience.

Try these year-round common cold remedies

ou can catch a cold any time of the year, no matter what the weather is. Although you can't cure it, you can relieve its symptoms with some simple remedies. Try these:

- Honey. Honey mixed with tea or warm lemon water can relieve coughing and sore throat.
- Zinc. Zinc supplements taken within the first few days of having a cold can shorten your illness and could prevent a cold in the first place.
- Hot liquids. Hot tea or water can loosen up congestion in your chest and sinuses.
- Salt water. Evidence suggests that rinsing your mouth with salty water can clear up nasal congestion and unclog your sinuses.
- Vitamin C. Evidence that vitamin C can help you avoid or shorten colds is mixed, although research does hint that it may be effective for those with a vitamin C deficiency.

Tarantulas have their own 'Man in Black'

new species of tarantula has been identified by a postdoctoral researcher at the Florida Museum of Natural History. Actually, Chris Hamilton discovered 14 previously unidentified species during his Ph.D. researcher at Auburn University, but only one of them was named after one of his favorite entertainers: country singer Johnny Cash.

Aphonopelma johnnycashi can be found, appropriately enough, near Folsom Prison in California, the setting of one of Cash's most famous songs and the site of several concerts the "Man in Black" performed during his lifetime. Tarantulas have more than 50 different species, and Hamilton examined more than 3,000 specimens, narrowing the field initially to 29 possibles and finally to 14 completely distinct species. Given that Hamilton has a tattoo of Cash himself, the name came naturally.



Shark attacks on the rise

he movie Jaws scared lots of people off the beach, but the danger of shark attacks is very real—and it's increasing. Last year saw a record number of shark attacks, totaling 98 around the world, according to the Florida Museum of Natural History.

The U.S. had the most attacks in 2015, with 30 in the waters off Florida, eight in the Carolinas, seven in Hawaii, two each in California and Texas, and one apiece in New York and Mississippi. Other attacks occurred near the island of Reunion in the Indian Ocean, along with Australia, New Caledonia, and Egypt.

Scientists believe that attacks are rising because the shark population is recovering from low levels, and human populations are increasing as well.

Do not sit still; start moving now. In the beginning, you may not go in the direction you want, but as long as you are moving, you are creating alternatives and possibilities.
