Numbers in the News

tudy shows an unclear linkage between cell phones, poverty, and health issues

More and more Americans are getting rid of their landline telephones and opting to go
completely wireless: two out of five, according to the Centers for Disease Control and
Prevention. And the CDC is tracking some interesting correlations between wireless phone use,
poverty, and health.

Adults who live in poverty are more likely to use cell phones exclusively, the CDC found, with 56.2 percent of landline-free households living below the poverty threshold, as compared to 36.6 percent of households with higher incomes. Adults in wireless households are less likely to receive yearly flu shots, and more likely to drink and smoke heavily, and to have trouble finding access to health care.

The connection between wireless use and health/poverty issues isn't clear. One problem, The Washington Post reports, is that gathering demographic data gets more complicated when an increasing percentage of the population relies on cell phones exclusively, since contacting these users is more difficult than conducting surveys via landline.







he U. S. Postal Service notified the Park last spring that it would be transitioning to Kiosk (or Pod) service in our two parks (East Bay Oaks and Eldorado). This was not an option, the Post Office is making this change in mobile home parks, apartments, condominiums and sub developments to become more efficient.

The Post Office granted an alternative that should the residents choose to adopt the kiosk boxes early the Post Office would waive the cost of the boxes. If not, when the boxes were eventually installed in 2015, each resident would be charged for his or her box. It was overwhelming decided to opt for a "no charge" option. Remember, this change to centralized mail service was not optional! The boxes will soon be installed east of the laundry building. An extension to the sidewalk for this purpose has already been installed. You will receive notice directly from the Post Office when the change becomes effective and will be given a key to your box.

Should you have large items which will not fit inside your box a few large boxes will be available for those items. The Postman will place a notice in your mailbox and a key for the large, package bin nearby. You simply unlock the larger box, retrieve your package and let the key in the lock.

These changes effect only service from the United States Postal Service. FedEx, UPS, and other private carriers will continue door stoop service.

Macs taking over? Maybe not yet

re you a Windows person or a Mac user? Conventional wisdom says that Windows computers belong in business environments, while the Mac is favored by educators, creative artists, and the elite. But that may be changing, according to data from VMware and reported on the InformationWeek website.

A survey of more than 370 IT professionals found that 71 percent of organizations support Macs, not exclusively Windows computers. Employee preference is the dominant reason, cited by 73 percent of the survey participants. The next most common reason was the need for applications that run only on Mac's OS X platform, named by 41 percent. The "Bring Your Own Device" movement surge in workplaces is also a major factor.

IT teams aren't necessarily happy about all those Macs, however. Forty percent of respondents said they find Macs more difficult to support. In any event, Macs seem unlikely to outnumber Windows-based computers anytime soon, since such machines still dominate over 90 percent of the market.

ecently a meeting was pulled together with several residents of the park and the following ELS management team:

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss some major repair issues for the park. The three (3) major repair issues include:

- Repair of Sidewalks
- Pavement of Streets
- Back Fence

We were advised that \$10,000 each has been allocated for the sidewalks and the pavement of the streets. Dean has already put these two items out for bid and is waiting to hear from the contractors.

The repair work will be done on a most needed basis. As far as the back fence is concerned, this project is a "three stage" project and will be started as soon as the City of Largo does their job in cleaning up the portion of the property that belongs to them.

We were also advised that the Capital Budget preparation is under way and ELS is making changes in the allocating of monies. For instance, if say \$30,000 are allocated for road work, that money is for roadwork ONLY, and cannot be used for anything else. They will also have a "contingency" budget (which they apparently did not have before), and monies will be set aside for emergencies and thus the funds will not have to be taken from another budget item.

The new Regional Manager has a program in place which he has used in other Parks concerning the appearance and upkeep of homes, carports, etc. We will hear further on this subject from him.

Also being discussed are items concerning overnight street parking, stop signs at intersections, speed limit signs and various maintenance matters


