DUMP HOURS: MONDAY - FRIDAY 8:00 AM - 3:30 PM PICK-UP HOURS: TUESDAY AND FRIDAY 8:00 AM TILL 12 NOON CLOSED SATURDAY AND SUNDAY

#### TRASH PICK-UP SERVICES

- 1. ALL GARBAGE MUST BE PLACED INTO PLASTIC BAGS AND SECURELY TIED WEIGHING NO MORE THAN 25 LBS.
- 2. PLEASE DO NOT PLACE TRASH INTO BOXES. BOXES MUST BE FLATTENED AND TIED WITH STRING.
  - "ALL BROKEN GLASS/MIRRORS MUST BE PLACED INTO A BOX AND TAPED SECURELY
  - DISPOSE OF ALL MEDICAL NEEDLES AND MEDICINES PROPERLY DO NOT PLACE IN TRASH BAGS.
- 3. ALL NEWSPAPER SHOULD BE BUNDLED AND TIED SECURELY WITH STRING.
- 4. TREES AND BRUSH TRIMMINGS MUST BE CUT INTO NO LARGER THAN 4 FOOT LENGTHS AND BUNDLED IN NO MORE THAN AN 18 INCH DIAMETER, IN ORDER TO BE PICKED UP.
- 5. ALL WEEDS, LEAVES AND LAWN TRIMMINGS MUST BE PLACED IN PLASTIC BAGS AND TIED CLOSED FOR PROPER PICK-UP. BAGS ARE TO WEIGH NO MORE THAN THE 25 LBS AS SPECIFIED ABOVE.
- 6. FURNITURE APPL IANCES PAINTS AND ANY CONSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS WILL NOT BE PICKED UP.
  - A. PLACE FURNITURE AND CONSTRUCTIONAL DEBRIS IN OPEN TOP DUMPSTER.
  - B. APPLIANCES AND PAINT PLEASE CALL PINELLAS COUNTY SOLID WASTE DIVISION 727-464-7500.
- 7. PLEASE DO NOT PLACE ANY TRASH OUT THE NIGHT BEFORE PICKU P. THIS WILL INVITE ANIMALS TO RIP AND OPEN YOUR GARBAGE MAKING IT MORE DIFFICULT AND TIME CONSUMING FOR PICK-UP. UNCONTAINED GARBAGE AND FLUIDS ARE A GREAT HEALTH RISK IF INHALED TO YOUR NEIGHBORS AND TO OUR STAFF.

#### **EMERGENCY NOTIFICATIONS**

Te have talked in the past about the problems faced when an emergency such as a water shutoff occurs. Therefore, we are looking into a couple of ways to notify residents of this or any other emergency such as an evacuation happens.

We are exploring two methods of doing this, one by having residents call one another in a chain format, the other by so-called robocalls. The first method would mean that we have to set up the call lists in a manner to achieve the best coverage during daytime hours and also when our snowbird residents go north. We have started this format and will be refining it. However, we also found out we can notify everyone at one time with a robocall. This would be achieved by creating a message pertinent to the emergency and having it sent to everyone on a call list.

The robocall method would be the easiest to carry out, but not everyone may want to be notified in that manner. So, we are going to create a robocall contact list and work from there. At the present time we have phone numbers for about 150 of the 227 homes in the park. We will be putting out an informational flyer to all residents informing them of this plan. If your phone number is listed in the Eldorado phone directory and you wish to be notified by robocall, you will not have to do anything. If your phone number is listed in the Eldorado phone directory and you would rather not be notified by robocall, the form will have a place for you to check to opt out of the robocall contact list including your lot # and signature.

If your phone number is not in the Eldorado phone directory and you wish to be notified by robocall there will be a place for you to opt in and you would need to list your phone number, lot # and sign the form.

For all others that we have the phone number for but do not wish to have a robocall notification, we will then refine our call lists and use that method to notify residents.





### **Eat Better to Spur Creativity**





### Danger at home: Keep your children and grandchildren safe

The home can be a dangerous place, especially for young children. Most household accidents are avoidable, though, with some commonsense precautions. Safe Kids Worldwide, a global organization providing safety information aimed at preventing accidents and injuries to children, shares these tips for keeping your family healthy and safe:

- Bathroom. Don't leave children alone in the bath, or anywhere near water.
- Hallways. Install smoke and carbon monoxide detectors, and check their batteries at least every six months to ensure they're working properly.

- Living room. Install brackets and braces to secure bookshelves and other furniture against accidental tipping. Secure television sets to the wall or place them on low platforms.
- Kitchen. Use the back burner of your stove when cooking with children present. Turn pots and pans so that their handles face away from the edge, out of reach from tiny hands. Store household cleaners in high cabinets and shelves, or lock lower cabinets to keep children out.

### **Keep kids safe from bugs during summer months**

As summer comes, so do the bugs. And some of those bugs can bite. Follow these guidelines from the American Academy of Pediatrics to protect your children from getting stung or bitten:

### Scientists delve deep into the heart of the world

Jules Verne's Journey to the Center of the Earth described an inner world of jungles, seas, and dinosaurs. The reality is quite different, but no less interesting to scientists, and it's changing all the time. The latest discovery about the nature of the Earth's core comes from a professor at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign. The inner core, about 3,000 miles beneath the world's crust, actually contains a second core about half the radius of the outer one. This inner core contains iron crystals, which are oriented in an east-west alignment. The outer inner core's crystals align north-south, although they appear to have flipped several times in the distant past.



Scientists liken the twin cores to the rings on a tree, which allow researchers to peer directly into the past. The discovery could provide important clues to the formation and development of our world.

### 'New' solar system is the oldest ever found

The oldest solar system in our galaxy is 11.2 billion years old, according to data from NASA's Kepler space telescope. By comparison, our home solar system is about 4.5 billion years old. The new find is about 117 light-years from Earth, with five Earth-sized planets in an orbit too close to their star to allow for life. But the discovery of a solar system's formation only a few billion years after the Big Bang some 13.8 billion years ago suggests that life could have proliferated throughout the cosmos much earlier than scientists previously believed.

### Sophie the Stegosaurus steps on the scale (sort of)

ow much did the dinosaurs weigh? That question has been answered—at least for one specimen at London's Natural History Museum.

Sophie the Stegosaurus is about 150 million years old, and was discovered in 2003 by pale-ontologists in Wyoming. It now resides at the British museum, its skeleton 85 percent intact. According to the Yahoo News website, British researchers created a 3-D digital version of the

skeleton, then calculated the amount of flesh it would have had around its bones, and compared that with data from modern animals

of a similar size.

The result? Sophie tipped the scales at about 1.6 tons, with a body mass roughly equivalent to a small rhinoceros. Knowing its weight will allow paleontologists to learn more about stegosaurus metabolism, food needs, and growth rate.
