Valuable Information from

Dorisanne Gibson and your H.O.A.

group of interested residents met with Largo Police Officer Vu Tran in January and outlined a plan for the Eldorado Village Neighborhood Watch Program, to be initiated later this month.

As the organization comes together, we will be sharing information with our residents in terms of how the Watch will work at Koffee on Tuesdays, at our HOA meetings and thru Facebook. What you need to know now is that it is going to happen, and some residents will be observing activity in the park with an eye to spotting anything out of the ordinary. I am excited about this new initiative as is Officer Tran.

You have heard a lot about Largo Code Enforcement inspecting mobile home parks, ours included. Many have asked what they will be looking for, so the following is copied in part from Largo "Common Code Violations for Mobile Homes". Now, knowing all this, no one should be in violation of the Code.

All exterior structures on the mobile home (siding, wood, etc.) must be intact, sturdy and not have any holes, rot or broken pieces.

All roofs and gutters are to be free from any vegetation, tree limbs, and other items. Roofs and drainage are free from any breakage, leakage, holes, or other disrepair.

All windows that should be able to open to the outside, are able to be opened.

All vehicles on the property are to be properly tagged with current registration and decals. Also, the vehicle needs to be operable and cannot be taken apart, up on jacks, have flat tires, missing motors, etc.

The outside of the mobile home is to be free from any holes, rot, or other areas where rodents can enter inside. If these types of entrances are found, they are to be properly secured and fixed.

All mobile homes are to be free from any kind of infestation whether it be rodents, insects, roaches, fleas, bedbugs, etc. If there is an infestation, it is to be treated by an exterminator and prevention measures taken to prevent re-infestation.


Keep the property around your mobile home free from junk, trash, and debris and mow your lawn regularly. All grass and weeds are to be under twelve inches in height.

In open carports, there is no storage of household items, inoperative machinery, yard maintenance equipment and tools, appliances, garbage, trash or junk, used scrap or lumber, pipe, steel, aluminum or other nonferrous metals, building materials, construction equipment, tanks, totes, cans, barrels, boxes, drums, cleared trees, removed tree stumps, inoperative boats or other inoperative recreational equipment. All of these items are to be stored in a fully enclosed structure such as a garage or shed. The only items allowed in an open carport are operable vehicles with current tag, decals, and registration, a table and chairs, grill or smoker.

All iceboxes, refrigerators, deep freezers, clothes washers, clothes dryers, or similar airtight units cannot be stored outside of the mobile home or anywhere on the property unless either the doors have been removed or a lock and chain make it unable to be opened.

Thank you for your RCS Donations

The Eldorado Village Social Club has been supporting the work of RCS for more than 8 years! To date, we have records that show we have donated \$3262. and nearly 1000 pounds of food! The first records are from our former neighbor, Shirley Pratt, followed by John Campbell and Michelle Leamon and, currently, Sandy Yost delivering our club donations to RCS. Individuals and families may access services once a month, receiving 3-4 days' worth of food for all household members per visit. A photo ID, SS card and a piece of mail with current address are needed. If you or someone you know need a ride to RCS, please contact Debbie and Steve Ennis or Sandy Yost.

RCS programs and services include:

RCS Food Bank served 70,000 Pinellas County neighbors. 32,000 of these neighbors are senior citizens and children. Over 4 million lbs. of food are distributed annually with support for nearly 100 other local food banks and pantries.

RCS Grace House helps individuals and families facing homelessness return to self-sufficiency.

The Haven of RCS provides safety, security and support for women and children facing domestic abuse. Their outreach center serves nearly 17,000 women and children annually. Their safe house sheltered over 300 women and children last year and they provide a resource list for men needing assistance with domestic violence issues. Their hotline receives over 4,000 calls annually with requests for assistance in matters of domestic violence.

Goldsmith Gardens provides comfortable, safe, affordable housing and support for individuals and families. Their housing community serves 12 families and nearly 40 individuals annually. They provide wrap-around programs and services that are conducive to self-sufficiency including education, financial literacy, workforce development and life skill development.

Basic Needs are met through a variety of collaborations and partnerships.

RCS Express Center provides 'get it now' services to meet the needs of the community with direct support related to hunger, homelessness, domestic violence and basic needs. Small meal ingredients and hygiene products are distributed, and guests are connected to partner agencies for various needs via immediate referrals.



Information about water shutoff's

s most residents know, there are times that the water in Eldorado must be turned off to make repairs. There is nothing we can do about that, but there are some things that we can do to avoid trouble.



We have adopted a new system to notify residents in the event water is turned **under** off. This system will generate a phone call to the residents alerting them to the fact that the water is off or will be shortly. If you are not sure if your name is on the parks robocall list, I would suggest that you check with the office to make sure they have added you to the list.

We suggest that you turn off your hot water heater if you are concerned about it. Also, when you want to check if the water has come back on, use the cold water for this purpose to not let air into your hot water heater. You can also turn off the water coming into your home, which will prevent water from draining out of your home and into the water system. Some folks keep a few gallons of water on hand just for such emergencies.




