





#### **HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION & LIAISON COMMITTEE**

t our HOA Annual Meeting one of the things that was brought up was what to do about the unsightly homes in our park. We suggest that if management will not address the situation, our residents are certainly within their rights to file a complaint with City of Largo Code Enforcement.

The phone number for Largo Code Enforcement is 586-7488. The website is simply Largo. com. You can file a complaint anonymously online at that website. Please callLargo police at 587-6730 if you feel threatened or have reason to believe you are in danger. We have found the Largo police to be very prompt in their response.

If you missed the Annual Membership Meeting of the Homeowners Association on Thursday, February 12, 2015, you did not hear that less than half the homeowners in the park have paid their assessments for 2015. Out of 226 lots, minus one vacant lot, and minus homes owned by ELS, we have had only 81 homeowners pay their assessments, about 40 %. At said Homeowners meeting we had 27 homes out of that 81 represented at the meeting. We are very frustrated because we do not know how to impress upon you the importance of paying your assessment and involving yourself in the Homeowners Association process of representing the park with ELS. We need your northern addresses and emails. That information is kept confidential by the HOA. Should anything happen that we need a vote of the majority of homeowners we would be unable (at this time) to contact everyone. Should we have to contact our attorney for advice, we need to have the funds readily available to pay her. Should we have a problem next fall with rent negotiations, we need to have access to our residents. I know we have a great many residents now who live in our park who are completely uninterested in the workings of the HOA, and who only want to live in "affordable housing" and go to work every day. But



#### Water Shutoff's what can we do

We have had some problems in the past with folks not knowing that the water was going to be turned off. They are not alone; no one knows when this may be necessary. Please bear in mind; we can never know when a leak in the water pipes is going to be found. When this happens, the plumber who repairs the pipes needs to turn off the water in order to do his work. Not that this is something we are happy about, but it is just a fact of life that this must be done.

We would like to make some suggestions as to what to do if you discover that the water is turned off. First, turn off your hot water heater. This assures that the elements in the heater will not burn out if the water in the heater drains down. This can be done at your circuit breaker

panel of some homes have a separate switch for their hot water heater. Second, do not turn on a hot water faucet. This will keep air from getting to the heater and allowing the water to drain. If no air gets into the heater, the water will not drain. You can turn on a cold water faucet slightly so that you can know if the water does come back on, but it is probably best to just turn on a cold water faucet from time to time to check. It is a good idea to have a few gallons of water on hand to use in the event you need some while the water is turned off. Bleach jugs make good containers for this backup supply. You should refresh the water in the jugs from time to time so that it is fairly fresh water. Most people nowadays use bottled water for drinking so that is taken care of. But, if you need water for cooking or drinking, the water in the jugs can be boiled to assure it is safe to drink.

There is one other thing that can be done. That is to have a check valve or back flow valve installed in your home where the water comes into the home. This is like an automatic shutoff that will keep the water in your home from flowing back out into the system. Bob Washam has one of these installed in his home and he has said that he would be glad to discuss this with anyone who is interested.

When the water comes back on, run the cold water for little while to make sure that any air or contaminants in the water are flushed through. Sometimes this will bring particles that might be in the pipe to the faucet and block the filter on the faucet. This can be unscrewed and tapped lightly on the countertop to remove the particles, and then replace the filter.

We are planning on putting together a call list so that we can alert folks that the water is going to be turned off or if there is some other type of emergency. We will be using the residents who are here year round and do not work to start the chain of calling. Hopefully this will give us the best coverage. We will then go to those who work. The seasonal folks who are only here part time will make up the rest of the list. We feel that, if we are notified when the plumber is called, we can be through our list and have everyone who is available notified by the time the water is turned off. One of the problems we face with this is that of the 227 homes in the park we only have 159 phone numbers. We are hopeful that this will help us to avoid any inconvenience that water shutoffs cause. But, remember, we will be having water shutoffs in the future and we cannot predict when they will occur.

#### **SOLICITATION IN THE PARK**

Thave been told by the office that they do not give anyone permission to solicit in the park so if anyone comes to your door notify the office or call the police department.

It has been brought to our attention that if you have someone soliciting at your door and the office has not approved them and you call the office to bring it to their attention the office will not due anything about it. 


