#### As I see ELDORADO VILLAGE from MY YELLOW BIKE

he Loss of "Community" was an article in the FMO January/February 2019 which was very well written by Russell S. Watson, FMO Director at Large.

#### The Loss of "Community"

FMO President Jerry Durham & I attended the I'm Home Convention and the annual meeting of the National Manufactured Home Owners Association (NMBOA) held in Nashville, Tennessee in early December. We heard many stories from folks living in manufactured home parks that had banded together with fellow residents and formed "Communities". Much like freedom itself, the status of community is not given, it is earned. It is a perishable commodity which can be lost if residents fail to honor and nurture it.

Those living in our manufactured home parks in the 80s & 90s came to this lifestyle for affordable housing in a setting that offered companionship and comfort in the retirement years. Many of the communities that arose still exist today. Residents have passed on to each new generation moving in the need to get involved, band together, and feed the fire warming the hearts of all in the community. We heard numerous stories at both events of parks that successfully saved themselves from extinction by owners looking to profit excessively. In each case the key to success was the willingness by all in the park to join together as a community opposing the common threat. It is this lifestyle leaders at FMO seek to protect.

What does it mean to live in a "community"? It means you cherish a commitment to a lifestyle characterized by neighbors and friends - not amenities. Residents willingly give of their time and energy to run and participate in events and activities. People look out for each other and an injustice done to one in the community is answered by all. This is generally characterized by a strong, fully supported, HOA who willingly serve to represent the community against all threats. It is recognized that help is needed and can be had through membership in organizations such as PMO. The fiame that keeps the community fire going is cherished above individual interests. Community activities and events tend to be collaborations by many who volunteer their time and efforts. Those who did so in the past are widely recognized and revered for their contributions. Like tribal elders they are respected and consulted on the direction needed to maintain the "community".

In the Community Preservation Working Group, of which I am a member, we discussed a new kind of community closure. In the past we were most concerned with parks whose owners were selling the land for a different use, thereby closing the community. A phenomenon we are seeing from major park owners across the country effectively does that without the sale of the land. No regulation prohibits it and many simply hall it as good business practice. The only group standing in its way is the community.

These owners are investing large sums on clubhouses and infrastructure to elevate the status of their parks. This is appealing to many residents who have no difficulty affording the large annual rent increases ultimately needed to pay for it. Others, grandfathered into much lower rents, applaud this direction and align themselves with park owners to support these efforts. Lost are those simply trying to get by who can't afford and don't need such facilities. Those left, who held the community values found in affordable housing above amenities, are seen as impeding progress. Community input to the management of the park all but disappears. What was once a community of residents turns into a high end extended-stay hotel populated by fellow guests. Activities and events go on but are often characterized by few volunteers and a very small group in control. Park elders are admonished for their archaic approach and pushed aside. In some parks folks may actually be paid for work once done by community volunteers to kept costs down The divisiveness created effectively shuts down the HOA through large turnover until it is populated by board members embracing "progress". In effect, the "community" is closed.

There is demand for parks providing high end amenities and a resort environment. The folks seeking this infestyle have often led successful and difficult careers. Financially the costs in even the most lavish parks are far below what would be paid in traditional communities offering this lifestyle. These retirees have put in their time on the front lines and simply seek quiet harmony in an environment the kids and grandkids will be impressed with when they visit. They will often privately express concerns, but "do not want to get involved".

Unfortunately only one new park in the last fifteen years has been approved for construction in Florida. The only source for investors seeing this opportunity is to purchase properties already in operation. This can result in a bargain for those who can afford and want this lifestyle. Unfortunately we often lose the community in place to the process. There are no quick solutions or easy answers but for those of us to whom "community' is important this is a trend which must be addressed.

#### From the Kitchen of:

#### **Ingredients**

- 1/2 cup (95 grams) uncooked brown rice (certified gluten-free if necessary)
- 24 ounces (680 grams) uncooked, boneless, skinless chicken breast
- · Dash salt
- Dash pepper
- 2 teaspoons + 2 tablespoons olive oil, divided
- 1 tablespoon honey
- 3 tablespoons lemon juice (about 1 medium lemon)
- 1 teaspoon Dijon mustard
- 3/4 cup (75 grams) chopped celery (about 2 stalks)
- 1/2 cup (70 grams) diced onion (about ½ small onion)
- 1 1/2 cups (195 grams) frozen peas and carrots, thawed
- 1/4 cup (10 grams) chopped basil



#### Directions

Cook brown rice according to package directions.

To grill chicken, preheat grill to high. Place chicken breasts between two pieces of wax paper and, using a meat mallet, pound to 1/2-inch thickness. Season chicken breasts with salt and pepper, and lightly rub with 2 teaspoons olive oil. To prevent sticking, lightly oil the grill grate before adding chicken. Cook chicken until firm to the touch, about 2-3 minutes per side. (Alternatively, you may bake or cook chicken in a skillet on the stovetop until firm and opaque throughout.)

In a large bowl, whisk together remaining 2 tablespoons olive oil, honey, lemon juice and Dijon mustard. Add celery, onion, peas and carrots, and brown rice; toss to coat. Divide rice mixture into 4 servings (about 3/4 cups rice mixture or 137 grams each). Top each with about 4 ounces grilled chicken. Leftovers will keep in the refrigerator for up to 5 days.

#### **Pineapple Carrot Raisin Muffins**

Categories: Baking, Cookies, Desserts

#### **Ingredients:**

- 2 cups all-purpose flour
- 1 cup sugar
- 2 teaspoons baking powder
- 1/2 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- 1/4 teaspoon ground ginger
- 1/2 cup carrots, shredded

- 1/2 cup raisins
- 1/2 cup walnuts, chopped
- 1 can crushed pineapple (8 ounces)
- 2 eggs
- 1/2 cup butter or margarine, melted
- 1 teaspoon vanilla

#### <u>Directions:</u>

In large bowl, combine flour, sugar, baking powder, cinnamon and ginger. Stir in carrots, raisins and nuts. In small bowl, combine undrained pineapple, eggs, butter and vanilla. Stir into dry ingredients until just blended. Spoon into greased 2 1/2-inch muffin cups. Bake in 375-degree F oven 20 to 25 minutes. Remove from pan; cool on wire rack. Makes 12 muffins.

This system will generate a phone call to the residents alerting them to the fact that the water is off or will be shortly. We suggest that you turn off your hot water heater if you are concerned about it. Also, when you want to check if the water has come back on, use the cold water for this purpose so as to not let air into your hot water heater. You can also turn off the water coming into your home, which will prevent water from draining out of your home and into the water guester. Some folks keep a few gallance.






