ave and his wife Laurie, of Tonawanda, New York, bought their home in Eldorado Village in approximately 2006. Dave, a retired NY Firefighter, chose Eldorado Village Community after visiting a fellow firefighter who lived in East Bay Oaks. Dave is one part of the "Three D's" who cook our monthly breakfast. Thank you, Dave for sharing your recipe.

Banana Nut Bread

Ingredients1 cup all-purpose flour2 eggs½ cup whole-wheat flour1 cup mashed ripe bananas (3 medium)1 cup granulated sugar½ cup (1 stick) butter, melted1 teaspoon baking powder1 tablespoon vanilla extract½ teaspoon baking soda1 cup coarsely chopped walnuts, toasted½ teaspoon salt1

Place oven rack in center of the oven. Preheat to convection bake at 325 degrees. Grease and flour a 9x5 inch loaf pan.

Mix the flours, sugar, baking powder, baking soda and salt in a medium bowl. Add the eggs, bananas, butter and vanilla and beat until the batter is smooth. Stir in the nuts and pour into pan.

Bake in the center of the oven for 50 to 55 minutes or until a wooden skewer inserted into the center of the loaf comes out clean and dry. Let bread stand in the pan for 5 minutes. Loosen the edges with a knife and turn the bread out of the pan to cool on a wire rack.

To adapt for conventional ovens, increase oven temperature to 350 degrees and bake about 1 hour.

Information about water shutoff's

s most residents know, there are times that the water in Eldorado must be turned off to make repairs. There is nothing we can do about that, but there are some things that we can do to avoid trouble. We have adopted a new system to notify residents in the event water is turned off. This system will generate a phone call to the residents alerting them to the fact that the water is off or will be shortly. We suggest that you turn off your hot water heater if you are concerned about it. Also, when you want to check if the water has come back on, use the cold water for this purpose so as to not let air into your hot water heater. You can also turn off the water coming into your home, which will prevent water from draining out of your home and into the water system. Some folks keep a few gallons of water on hand just for such emergencies.

The city of Largo charges by weight for garbage and trash, so the more recyclables that we can put into the recycle bin in the "salad bowl" in East Bay Oaks, the more we can save on our trash bills. The new recycle plan in Largo is great in that we do not have to separate our recyclables. Everything that is recyclable goes into the one bin. This certainly makes it much easier to "do the right thing" and we not only save money for ourselves, but we are helping with the environment as well. The things we can put in the bin is as follows: Glass (colored bottles and jars) Cartons (milk and juice containers) Mixed Paper (Newspapers, flattened cardboard boxes and office paper) Plastic Containers (food and beverage) Aluminum and Metal (cans and containers).

The things we <u>should not</u> put in are as follows: plastic bags and wrap, Styrofoam containers/ packaging, food waste/household garbage or chemicals/electronics (which includes, paint, light bulbs, batteries, computers etc.)

So fellow residents, please consider all of the above and let's work to help save ourselves a few bucks and at the same time, work toward a greener environment


