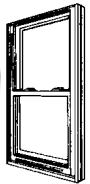

If you are not serving alcohol, the insurance is your responsibility. The function is not covered by the insurance that the Social Club carries or by ELS. When you request use of the clubhouse from the indoor social activities director, you will be given a form to fill out, a copy of which will be given to management. No private functions are permitted in the clubhouse without prior approval.

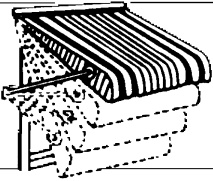

Dear Family & Friends,

Most of you know I was in the post surgery chemo treatment cycle. No more taxol due to the neuropathy I have in my feet & hands. They were giving carboplatin and gemzar week 1, then just gemzar week 2. In many ways, this was more difficult than my initial treatment that began last Nov.

On April 1st I had a 4 hour debarking surgery, stayed in Magee Hospital for 5 days then went to a physical therapy facility in near by Oakmont for 20 days. In June I began what is referred to as the clean up round of chemo. Again, the chemo caused problems with my blood counts & hemoglobin and I had another 2 unit transfusion. This past Thursday I had another CT scan with & without contrast. I despise that test but understand why it has to be done to monitor cancer detection & tumor growth. Yesterday my Oncologist called, she did not want me to have to wait for the results the scan at our appointment next Friday. The scan showed no evidence of disease & there was no need to continue with the chemo. We will meet with her in 2 wks to discuss how we will monitor my situation in the future.

I am forever grateful for your prayers, food runs, flowers & cards & will always remember how blessed I am to have you all in my life. The next step is to get back on my feet, out of this wheelchair & rollator walker and get back to normal. You all have made this journey bearable, I will never forget your kindness, Thank You so much!

## SUMMER MUSINGS FROM OUR PRESIDENT.

In a previous message, I shared some of the early history of Eldorado Village. Here's a little more. Many of the social activities we still enjoy began in the 1970's. Other events in that decade we would probably prefer not to experience. In 1975, the local weather bureau reported that Largo was experiencing the hottest summer on record. Perhaps the alligators that appeared in the lake that year were just trying to cool off. Three showed up, one at a time, each staying for just a short time. The largest was reported to be 8 feet long. When it began leaving the lake to wander around, there was an unsuccessful attempt to capture it. It disappeared a few days later, maybe because it began feeling unwelcome!

A more serious weather event occurred on Halloween in 1973. Around 10:30 p.m., a tornado struck Eldorado Village, causing serious damage to 25 homes, six of which had to be removed from the Park. Fortunately, only two people had to seek emergency treatment at hospital and their injuries were not serious. The Largo Police and Red Cross assisted residents in the aftermath, the damaged homes were repaired or replaced, and Park life went on. Let's hope we never experience a repeat of those events.

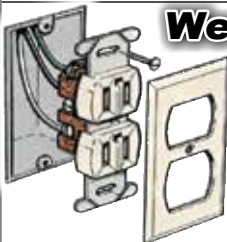

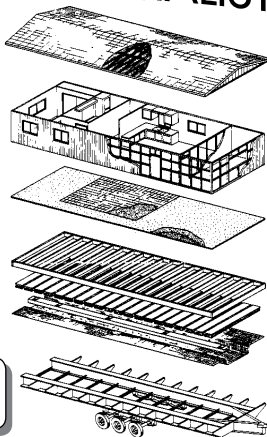

# EMERGENCY NOTIFICATIONS

**W**e have talked in the past about the problems faced when an emergency such as a water shutoff occurs. Therefore, we are looking into a couple of ways to notify residents of this or any other emergency such as an evacuation happens.

We are exploring two methods of doing this, one by having residents call one another in a chain format, the other by so-called robocalls. The first method would mean that we have to set up the call lists in a manner to achieve the best coverage during daytime hours and also when our snowbird residents go north. We have started this format and will be refining it. However, we also found out we can notify everyone at one time with a robocall. This would be achieved by creating a message pertinent to the emergency and having it sent to everyone on a call list.

The robocall method would be the easiest to carry out, but not everyone may want to be notified in that manner. So, we are going to create a robocall contact list and work from there. At the present time we have phone numbers for about 150 of the 227 homes in the park. We will be putting out an informational flyer to all residents informing them of this plan. If your phone number is listed in the Eldorado phone directory and you wish to be notified by robocall, you will not have to do anything. If your phone number is listed in the Eldorado phone directory and you would rather not be notified by robocall, the form will have a place for you to check to opt out of the robocall contact list including your lot # and signature.

If your phone number is not in the Eldorado phone directory and you wish to be notified by robocall there will be a place for you to opt in and you would need to list your phone number, lot # and sign the form.

For all others that we have the phone number for but do not wish to have a robocall notification, we will then refine our call lists and use that method to notify residents.

## City life? Not for all young adults

---

The TV sitcom *Friends* depicted a group of young New Yorkers enjoying life in the big city—but in the end, at least two of them chose to move to a house in the suburbs. Young adults in real life appear to be making the same choice (without the laugh track). A survey of more than 1,500 people born since 1977, released by the National Association of Home Builders, found that few of them want to remain in the city for their entire lives.

Sixty-six percent indicated they'd like to live in the suburbs, and 24 percent have their hearts set on a rural residence. Only 10 percent want to live in the center of an urban area. They're mostly looking for space: Eighty-one percent said they want three or more bedrooms wherever they end up living.



## Online videos bigger than TV these days

---

Video has taken over the Internet, especially among the younger generation. A survey of 13- to 24-year-olds by Defy Media found this evidence of the influence of YouTube and other video providers on youthful fans:

- Millennials watch an average of 11.3 hours of free online video a week, and 10.8 hours of subscription video—but only 8.3 hours of scheduled broadcast TV.
- Videos are more popular than online TV content. Seventy-six percent of young people in the survey said they find YouTube more entertaining than TV programs (more popular with 55 percent of participants).
- They're tolerant of advertising on the Internet. Fewer than half—41 percent—said online videos have too many advertisements, but 63 percent feel TV does.

## Get the full impact from these healthful foods

Certain foods have definite health benefits, but you have to eat them the right way to get their full impact. Here are some common foods you might be eating “wrong,” according to the CNN website:

- Flaxseed. Full of fiber and omega-3, these little seeds may improve your heart health—as long as you grind them up first. Sprinkling them whole over your cereal or yogurt will keep their nutrients locked inside.
- Broccoli. Eat this raw or steamed, not cooked, to receive the full dose of vitamin C, chlorophyll, and antioxidants this vegetable offers.
- Strawberries. Slicing this delicious fruit exposes its healthful nutrients to light and oxygen, which can dilute their effects. Eat them whole, or hold off cutting them until the last minute.
- Garlic. The enzyme allicin, found in garlic, may help ward off cancer, but its benefits are more pronounced when it’s exposed to air. Let garlic sit for about 10 minutes after chopping to release this enzyme fully.
- Tomatoes. Fresh tomatoes are tasty, but you’re better off cooking them. The antioxidants in them increase in potency when they’re heated to about 190 degrees Fahrenheit.



## Stone tools point to early use by primitive humans

Humans have been using tools for longer than we’ve known. As reported by the journal *Nature*, a team of archeologists in Kenya have found stone tools dating back 3.3 million years, some 700,000 years older than the oldest tools previously discovered.

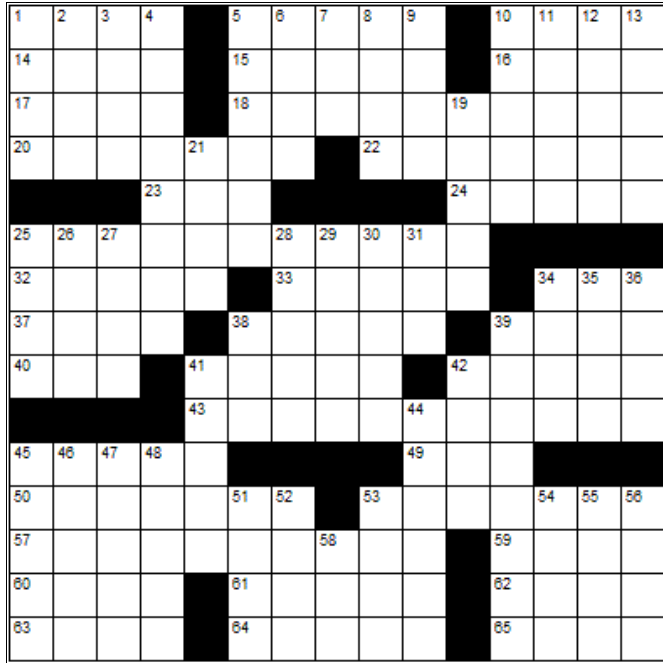
Before this find, the oldest known stone tools came from sites in Ethiopia and were believed to have been used some 2.6 million years ago. Still, evidence of earlier tool use suggested that humans may have been using stone for longer than that—fossils of animal bones, also in Ethiopia, show signs of cutting some 3.4 million years ago.

The Kenyan tools were dated with an analysis of the sedimentary layer where they were uncovered. Scientists speculate they may have been used to open nuts or fruits with hard surfaces. Weighing in at about 6.6 pounds, the tools are 10 times heavier than any stone tools discovered so far.

## Have you taken your fish oil today?

---

**N**atural dietary supplements are big business in the U.S. As part of the National Health Interview Survey, researchers looked at the use of natural supplements other than vitamins and minerals. Comparing figures from 2002, 2007, and 2012, the trends they found include:



- Fish oil. This was the top product used by adults in 2012, as well as among children (though in 2007, Echinacea was the most popular supplement among children).
- Melatonin. This sleep aid came in second for children in 2012, increasing significantly from 2007.
- Glucosamine/chondroitin. Use of this decreased between 2007 and 2012, along with a drop in the use of Echinacea and garlic.
- Ginseng. This showed another large decline from 2002 to 2007, along with the use of Gingko.
- Green tea and milk thistle. Use of these held steady (though low) between 2007 and 2012.

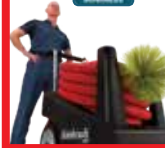
