

RECIPE OF THE MONTH

SLOW COOKER MEATBALL STEW

Ingredients:

- 1 Box Beefy Onion Soup Mix (2 Pouches)
- Carrots
- 8 Medium Potatoes Cubed
- 1 Can Peas, drained
- 1 Large and 1 small can of Tomato Sauce
- · Meatballs -cooked

Instructions:

Mix soup according to package; add cooked meatballs potatoes and carrots in a large pot or crockpot, simmer on low all day. Add the tomato sauces and peas the last 2 hours of cooking. This recipe is a double batch, can easily cut in half by using only one pouch of soup mix.

Willow Brook Cole Slaw

Ingredients:

- 1 Tbsp. cider vinegar
- 1 c. mayonnaise
- 5 Tbsp. sugar
- ½ head cabbage, shredded or precut bag
- Salt and pepper to taste

Instructions:

In saucepan, combine sugar and vinegar, cook until sugar is completely dissolved. Do not overcook. Cool Slightly. Ass mayonnaise and stir well. In a serving bowl, mix the dressing with the cabbage. It may look a little dry, but after it is placed in the refrigerator for 1 hour and then stirred again, it will have pulled moisture from the cabbage. Season to taste. Follow instructions to the letter!!

A little story about this recipe: This recipe was given to "Trudy's" mother in the 1930's. A hobo came into her sandwich shop and offered the recipe in trade for a sandwich. # FROM THE OFFICE:

nce again I need to remind everyone that we are a 55+ park; it is unfortunate if you have family or friends that become homeless, but they cannot live here! Residents are not to offer "temporary" housing to homeless people, no matter what their story is. There is a reason that residents are required to have a background check; they do not want to live in a Park where certain residents offer temporary shelter to these transients, who then are seen begging other residents for money, while sharing their sob stories (which are most always the result of them making poor life decisions)! Embassy is not a halfway house, and I will evict any resident that I find continuing to do this. Evictions cost money, so they hurt everyone in the long run. These people do not qualify for the 30 day rule, as they are bouncing from house to house and have no other permanent address.

A reminder that I will be towing any vehicles that are parked on the grass or road overnight - defined as 11 p.m. to 7 a.m. (unless you have made arrangements with me to park there for a special circumstance i.e. painting your driveway). If you, or your guests, park on the street during the day, please park on the right side of the street.....our streets are narrow and it is important to keep them clear enough for emergency vehicles to get through at all times. The only over flow parking spaces are the first row (7th street side) of the 12th street parking lot; these spots are not for storage or a car that isn't used regularly. The rest of the spots in the 12th street lot are numbered and reserved, being paid for by the person authorized to park there. The Clubhouse parking lot is for people attending events at the clubhouse, not extra parking. All available spots on 1st, 2nd and 3rd street are also assigned to certain people, so do not park out there. If you have any questions about parking, they need to be directed at the Office.

cook, read, dance. You can adopt a cat or a dog, grow a garden, play cards, checkers, chess, dominoes, golf. You can paint, volunteer or just collect certain items. Find something you like and spend some real time having fun with it.





# Many Americans still worried about their finances

The stock market may be up, but many Americans are still struggling with financial security, according to a story on the USA Today website. A September 2018 Bankrate. com survey found that among people earning less than \$30,000 a year, 78 percent said that their financial situation has failed to improve over the past two years, and many said it had gotten worse. On the other hand, people earning \$75,000 a year or more reported feeling better about their money.

The survey found other divides as well. People 65 and older reported the least financial improvement, and millennials ages 28–37 felt the most improvement. In addition, men reported doing better in earlier years than women did.

# **Coffee still in demand**

National Coffee Drinking Trends report says that the number of Americans who drank coffee in the past day is the highest it's been in six years.

According to the report, based on a study of more than 2,700 adults 18 or older, 64 percent said they drank coffee within the past day, the highest amount since 2012. This is higher than the growth from 57 percent in 2016 to 62 percent in 2017. The study also found that past-day consumption traditional coffee, defined as "regular coffee" brewed from "gourmet quality" beans, held steady over the previous years, at 16 percent. Similarly, consumption of espresso-based drinks held steady from 2017, at 24 percent.


