RECIPE OF THE MONTH

Taco Salad Casserole


Ingredients:

- 1-pound ground beef
- 1 cup chopped onion
- 1 can (15 ounces) chili with beans
- 1 can (about 14 ounces) diced tomatoes
- 1 can (4 ounces) diced green chiles, undrained
- 1 package (about 1 ounce) taco seasoning mix
- 1 bag (12 ounces) nacho flavored tortilla chips, crushed
- 2 cups (8 ounces) shredded Cheddar Cheese
- 3 4 cups shredded lettuce
- 1 jar (8 ounces) prepared taco sauce
- ½ cup sour cream

Directions:

- 1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees
- 2. Brown beef and onion in large skillet over medium heat,6 to 8 minutes, stirring to break up meat. Drain fat
- 3. Add chili with beans, tomatoes with juice, chiles and taco seasoning mix; cook and stir until heated through. Place half of crushed tortilla chips in 2 ½ quart casserole. Pour beef mixture over chips, top with Cheddar, mozzarella and remaining chips.
- 4. Bake 30 to 40 minutes or until hot and bubbly. Serve over lettuce, top with taco sauce and sour cream

Makes 6 to 8 servings

FROM THE OFFICE

hurricane guides are not out yet; when I get them, I will put them in the 12th street Laundromat. In the meantime, you need to get a "hurricane" kit ready. Be sure to include your meds, any important papers (title to your mobile is mandatory in order to get any FEMA help in case of a disaster), nonperishable food and water. Pinellas County has advised people to avoid shelters; use them as a last resort only. If you leave the Park when a hurricane is coming, please advise the Office, via email, phone message or a note in the office door on your way out of the Park. This is very important-in case of a disaster we would need to know who is still in the Park for rescue and recovery. All outdoor furniture, planters, ladders, etc. that could become projectiles in high winds, should be secured and put away. Let's hope we don't need this, but realistically, we need to be prepared. After a heavy rain, be sure to walk around outside and empty any standing water to cut down on mosquitos.

Mobile Home and carport maintenance: I send out a letter; if no response or results, then I will post a 7-day notice. If I still don't get any results, I will turn it over to Largo Community Development. This could result in fines! Also, continued violation of Park Rules can result in eviction.

Lawn care is now on a weekly schedule, weather permitting. Please be sure to keep the grass areas clear of "objects"-hoses, furniture, etc.

Stop signs are still being ignored; again, this is a rule violation, but most importantly they are to slow people down! We don't move as fast as we used to! 15 miles per hour.... S T O P. These signs are also supposed to be obeyed by bicycles and golf carts.

There are several unapproved people living in the Park; many carports and backyards need cleaning up. Unfortunately, I cannot do any evictions until July 2nd (that date may change if the government extends it again). However, I can get all the paperwork in order and have evictions ready to go once the ban is lifted.

I have reopened my Office and implemented the following changes due to the uncertainty of Covid-19,

- 1. Come in to pay rent ONLY
- 2. All complaints must go on a form; pick it up and then leave, you can put it in the mail slot when completed. The forms are in a file holder on the outside of the office door
- 3. I will be seeing people by appointment only, so call ahead
- 4. If you are sick, stay away!

These changes are necessary because of the size of both of the offices and the continued unknown about Covid-19. Positive cases are still on the rise in FL.

The next Manager's Meeting will be September 16th, 9:00 A.M. for coffee; meeting at 9:30 a.m. Please note that this is the 3rd Wednesday instead of the 2nd.






