everal years ago, my older sister Dorothy and I ventured up from my home area outside Boston to York Beach, Maine, to visit with our older sister Shirley who had not been well for a while. We arrived as many of her children and grandchildren were also visiting at that time. They were all engrossed around the kitchen table of her home on the beach sorting through piles and piles of Shirl's family photographs, thoroughly enjoying the visual journey. We gladly jumped into the boisterous activity to join in the fun.

It wasn't very long before I realized that Shirl kept looking at me quizzically with sideways glances. I began to realize that she didn't even know who I was! After a while, at one point she was examining one of the photographs and showed it to me, asking, "Who is this??" It was a lovely studio photograph of her when she was in her 20's or 30's. I turned back to her and said, "That's YOU, dear!" She paused and said to me, amazed, "I was very pretty, wasn't I?". "You certainly were!" I replied. I had surprisingly glanced toward the others gathered there, and they gave me a very pitying look. That, then, was my first very personal introduction to the terrible thief called Alzheimer's Disease!

Through many former years, occasionally (very occasionally) we would become aware of friends' older parents and grandparents losing their memories here and there. And at that time we attributed it to hardening of the arteries. But through the ensuing years, these occasions would become known as Alzheimers more and more, until now, it is practically running rampant and considered a somewhat usual part of aging. Almost everyone has been touched by its devastation one way or another, through friends, acquaintances, newspaper accounts, and, most heartbreaking, as it touches our own parents, siblings, close friends and associates. Alzheimers is just too familiar to us!

One resident here at our Embassy Park, Joni Allen is in the health care profession, and recently asked me if I could reproduce a poem that a relative of one of her Alzheimer's patients had given her. She wanted to frame it as a gift for family members of those patients. I thought it was so beautiful, I am sharing it with you. May its words give you and the precious caretakers the comfort that I immediately received from it.

So many of my friends, families, and relatives have also been touched in some way or other by Alzheimers. I shall always think of them and the myriad caretakers with the solace I felt from the above prayer. Oh, and on another note, one of the previous issues of the Parade Section of the Sunday paper (2/15/2015) had listed some helpful suggestions regarding our forgetfulness.

Bring on the Jazz & Trumpets!!


