<ul> <li>1 # ground beef</li> <li>1 can mixed drained veggies</li> <li>1 chopped onion</li> <li>Chopped green pepper</li> <li>1 large can spaghetti sauce with noodles</li> <li>Garlic bread</li> </ul>

#### Health benefits of coffee for (almost) everyone

s coffee good for you? Bad? The arguments go on and on, but a meta-analysis of 127 studies on the question by the University of Catania in Italy has found that drinking coffee is associated with the following health benefits:

• Decreased risk of breast, colorectal, colon, endometrial and prostate cancers, among others, from 2-20 percent depending on the cancer type.

• Five percent reduction in risk for cardiovascular disease.

• An approximately 30 percent lower risk for both Type 2 diabetes and Parkinson's disease, thanks to coffee's ability to improve enzymes that regulate glucose and insulin metabolisms.

• A lower death rate.



Coffee's natural antioxidants reduce free radicals that can damage cells and cause aging. It's also an anti-inflammatory that calms you down so you don't overact to stress.

One group that should avoid coffee, however, is pregnant women. Coffee, the study notes, can increase the risk of miscarriage.

#### Be ready to donate

re you nervous about donating blood or signing up to be an organ donor? You don't have to be. An infographic from Work The World explores some of the common misconceptions about blood and organ donations. They include:

• Age. There is no age limit on organ donations. In fact, the oldest known donor to date was a Scottish woman of 107 who donated one of her corneas after death. The main factor is the health of the organ and the donor.

• Organs. A single organ donor can improve or save up to eight lives. Donating tissue can save even more.

• Blood type. All blood types are needed, even the most common ones.

• Tattoos. Got a tattoo? That won't prevent you from donating blood as long as you're otherwise healthy.




#### Bad dog

#### Survey looks at who argues about money

oney is a major cause of conflict and stress in many relationships, but it affects some couples more than others. In a survey by CompareCards.com, a subsidiary of LendingTree, only 15 percent of respondents said they fought about money with their partner.

The survey found that 20 percent of members of Generation X (ages 35-54) argue about money, followed by 17 percent of millennials (18-34), and only 9 percent of people over 55.

The health of the relationship may influence money squabbles. Eight-two percent of the couples who claimed not to fight over money described themselves as "extremely satisfied in their relationships," but just 59 percent of people who do have arguments felt the same way.

One way some people avoid financial conflicts is by hiding purchases. Thirtyseven percent of survey participants said they have bought things without telling their significant other, and 11 percent said they have a private bank account, credit card, or loan that their partner doesn't know about.

#### Three steps to better heart health

mproving your heart health doesn't have to mean two-hour gym workouts or a diet of kale and water. The Mayo Clinic website offers three easy steps to keeping your heart in good shape for a long, healthy life:

• Eat five. Five servings of fruits and vegetables a day can boost your heart health. Include fruits and vegetables in all your daily meals, and snack on them instead of, or at least in addition to, chips or other junk food.

• Move 10. Add 10 minutes of physical activity a day to your routine. This can add up to 60 minutes a week to your exercise regimen, reducing your risk of heart disease by as much as 50 percent.

• Sleep eight. Make sure you get at least eight hours of sleep a night. Ample, restful sleep is important to keeping your heart healthy.

#### Learn what gout is all about

out—one of the most common forms of inflammatory arthritis—is on the increase. It affects approximately 8.3 million Americans, 50 percent of whom have three or more attacks a year.

According to an infographic on the Doctor-Patient Communication Tools website, gout is caused by a buildup of uric acid in the blood, where it collects in a joint and then crystallizes. About two-thirds of uric acid in the body is produced naturally, and the other third is an effect of diet. However, genetics plays a larger role than diet in the amount of uric acid in the body.

Talk to your doctor. Although limiting alcohol and other foods can help, dietary changes may not be sufficient. In many cases, medication is necessary to reach and maintain the proper level of uric acid in your body.

### Distant galaxy not as large as thought

For years, astronomers believed that the Andromeda galaxy, some 3.5 million light-years from Earth, was much larger than our own Milky Way—and that it would someday gobble up our galaxy. Recent research reported on the Sci-News website, however, suggests that Andromeda's size is roughly equivalent to ours, a mass of 800 billion solar masses.



Scientists analyzed the orbits of high-speed stars in Andromeda and found that the distant galaxy has less dark matter than previously estimated, lowering their measurements of its mass. The two galaxies will still eventually collide in about 4 billion years, but the new findings radically transform astronomers' knowledge of our local galaxy group.

he American Hospital Association conducts an annual survey on hospitals in the United States. The latest survey includes these numbers:

- Nongovernment nonprofit community hospitals: 2,849
- Investor-owned for-profit community hospitals: 1,035
- State and local government community hospitals: 956
- Federal government hospitals: 209
- Nonfederal psychiatric hospitals: 397



• Other hospitals, including nonfederal long-term care hospitals and hospital units within an institution such as a prison or school infirmary: 88

### Self-driving cars rising in drivers' acceptance

re you eager to buy a self-driving car? More and more Americans are warming up to the idea. A study by AAA last year found that 78 percent of Americans were scared of the idea of riding in a car that drives itself. A more recent survey saw that figure drop to 63 percent.



Age makes a different in attitude. Sixty-eight percent of Baby Boomers said they'd feel worried in a driverless car, and 70 percent of Gen Xers expressed concern too. However, fewer than 50 percent of millennials said they'd be frightened of riding in a self-driving vehicle.

Overall, half of drivers in the survey said they want their next car to have some self-driving features, like being able to stop on its own or stay within lanes on the highway.

### **Clutter is the top target of kitchen remodelers**

Thinking of renovating your kitchen? Tidiness is the biggest trend this year, according to the 2018 Houzz Kitchen Trends Study. The study found that 75 percent of homeowners named decluttering their counters as their No. 1 priority, followed by 66 percent who want to put things away and 49 percent who are focused on recycling.

The biggest issue? Storage, cited by 93 percent of survey respondents. That was followed by space planning (38 percent), entertainment (32 percent), and cleanliness (32 percent).

The survey notes that homeowners are also interested in pullout garbage bins, organizers for dishes and utensils, and wine bars.


