FROM THE OFFICE

s I mentioned in last month's article, I have been doing "Park Ride Inspections". I have sent out 82 letters, giving people up to 30 days to fix whatever their problem was. If you receive a letter, take care of YOUR problem, do not call or email me about other people in the Park who may have a problem; you have no way of knowing if they have received a letter or a visit from Largo Community development. Take pride in your home and lot and let me do my job. Another mobile home Park in St. Petersburg is closing, and the people that are coming here trying to relocate have commented that Embassy looks so nice. (I know, I know--the POOL).

Over the summer I have had the Hobby House, Old Library, Garage and Clubhouse painted; the Clubhouse had a new roof put on, as well as all new gutters. Several of the buildings had rotten facia boards on them, which were all replaced. Maintenance is currently working on fixing and painting the 3 swings by the Lake (Thanks to Jacki and Dennis Gross, Lot 1002, who are always a big help in maintaining the swings and trimming some trees for the Park). In accomplishing this, the maintenance bills were extremely high this year.

Future projects include:

Painting and repairing the 12th street laundromat; replacing the fence there with vinyl fencing; painting the poles in the circle where you enter the Park; hopefully getting the 12th street parking lot repaved, etc. The Pool, along with the pool fence and furniture, is on my list, but it has to get to the top of Mr. Larson's!!!! This will be very costly, but is well past the time to redo it. When we do, the pool will need to be closed for awhile.

Denis Phillips, local meteorologist, predicts we will have enough hurricanes this year to use all of the letters of the alphabet!!! There are currently 5 systems trying to form. PLEASE pick up a hurricane guide from the office and BE PREPARED!

I had a Manager's meeting today (Sept. 16th) and it was the general consensus that the Park stay closed, due to Covid, until it is discussed again at the November 4th Social Club meeting.
