# (3) DID YOU EVER WONDER....

### WHY DO WE CALL IT RHODE ISLAND WHEN IT ISN'T ONE

When explorer Giovanni da Verrazano was mapping the east coast of North America in 1524, he noted in his diary that the coastline of Narragansett Bay was approximately as long as that of the Greek island of Rhodes. Subsequent explorers took it to mean that the area was, in fact, an island, and they thus called it Rhode Island.

It's an attractive theory, but so is this one: that Dutch explorer Adriaen Block (for whom Block Island is named) named the area "Red Island" because of the color of the soil.

In Dutch, that's Roodt Eyandt, which became the name we use today.

### Why is "The Life of Riley" SO TERRIFIC?

he life of Riley is a life of easy days and carefee nights. It's an odd expression because the real Mr. Riley was anything but lazy.

"Riley" was poet James Whitcomb Riley, who wrote poems like The Old Swimmin' Hole, which glorified the fast-fading innocence of the 19th century and comforted those who had already missed it.

But it wasn't just the subject matter of his poems that inspired the expression. It was the fact that Riley's writings made him rich, the wealthiest American author of his day.

To "live the life of Riley" wasn't only to be barefoot and fancy free. It was also to be as well-heeled as the man who wrote about such things!

# (4) **GOOD READS.....**

### "The Nest" by Cynthia D'Aprix Sweeney

"The Nest" follows the Plumb family, a set of wealthy New England siblings just months away from receiving a massive payout from their joint trust fund. That is, they were going to get a payout, until their black-sheep brother crashed his car while drunk with a 19-year-old waitress riding shotgun. The accident puts their trust fund, "The Nest," in jeopardy, and emotional chaos ensues. Sweeney's wit is on full display, chronicling the damage money can cause to relationships.

### "The Regional Office is Under Attack" by Manuel Gonzalez

Super-powered female assassins. A mysterious oracle. And a travel agency?

In Gonzales' send-up of action movie tropes, a travel agency is just a front for a highly trained group of deadly women with mysterious powers who fight against the "amassing forces of darkness." But someone has double-crossed the agency and — as the title suggests — the regional office is now under attack.

Gonzales ping-pongs between a teenage recruit roped into the chaos, a high level admin who just happens to have a robotic arm and the unwitting office workers caught in the crossfire. In the interstitial chapters, Gonzales provides an academic history of how the agency began and the dark secret at its core.

### "Eligible" by Curtis Sittenfeld

What if "Pride and Prejudice" were set in Cincinnati? Sittenfeld provides a modern twist on the Jane Austen classic in this summer beach read. In her version, Elizabeth writes for a women's magazine and is tangled up with a married man, while her sister Jane is near 40 and seriously considering having a baby with a sperm donor. Throw in a dose of reality television, and the romance begins.



What type of landform is Florida? peninsula

"Hogtown" is usually the first thing that new University of Florida students learn upon arrival in Gainesville. Jacksonville is the Bold New City; Valdosta, GA is Wernersville, and New Orleans is The Big Easy.



- 2. **Talk to your doctor** if you notice any changes in, or have any questions or concerns about, your health.
- 3. Follow your **health care providers' recommendations** for examinations, screening procedures, diagnostic tests and preventative measures.

**Lifestyle choices** throughout your life. And even if you haven't, start taking care of yourself now, and set your sights on good health in the years ahead.

Staying Healthy in Your 60s

Steps you can take to improve your health in your 60s:

First, quit smoking. Quitting is the most beneficial thing you can do for your health, even if you've been a smoker for many years. Don't give up—many smokers have to try several times before they're able to stop smoking for good. Talk to your health care provider—there are a number of treatment options and resources available to help.

**Protect your heart**. Heart disease is the leading cause of death in both men and women. According to the American Heart Association, most heart attacks in women occur in the 10 years after menopause. To reduce your heart disease risk, know your blood pressure, total cholesterol,

LDL, HDL, triglycerides, fasting blood glucose, body mass index (BMI) and waist circumference and keep them within a healthy range.

Maintain a healthy weight. Overweight and obesity can have a greater impact on our health—and on how we feel—as we get older. It's often more difficult to lose weight with age—our metabolism slows down and muscle is replaced by fat—so it's important to eat right and keep an eye on portion sizes.



**Exercise** regularly. Get at least 30 minutes of exercise on most days of the week. (Be sure to talk to your health care provider before beginning an exercise program.) It's important to find the right type of exercise for your body and choose an activity you enjoy doing, whether you've always been active or are just getting started. Walking, swimming, water aerobics, bowling, dancing, light weight training and resistance training can be good choices.

If you drink alcohol, do so **only in moderation**—no more than one drink per day for women and two for men. Talk to your health care provider about **all medications** you take—over-the-counter and prescription—as well as any herbs or dietary supplements you use. Take all medication as directed, follow information on drug labels carefully, and do not use illegal substances.

**Eat healthy.** Good nutrition is an important diet goal as you get older. Limit processed foods and those that are high in fat and/or sugar. Aim to eat a wide variety of foods, including:

Fruits and vegetables (4-5 servings per day)

Fiber-rich, whole grains (3 servings per day)

Non- or low-fat dairy products (2 or 3 servings per day)

Lean meats and proteins, such as skinless chicken, fish that is high in omega-3 fatty acids (salmon, trout, herring), legumes, nuts and seeds. Women in their 60s should get about 46 g of protein per day and men about 56 g.

See your health care provider regularly for check-ups, health screenings and diagnostic tests, and immunizations. Recommendations vary and are affected by several factors, including overall health. General guidelines for people in their 60s include:

Annual flu vaccine

Blood pressure screening—at least once every year or as recommended

Bone density test—at age 60 or 65, as recommended

Clinical breast exam and mammogram (in women)—every year or as recommended

Colonoscopy—every 10 years beginning at age 50 or as recommended

Dental exam—every 6 months or as recommended

Digital rectal exam and fecal occult blood test—every year or as recommended

**Eye exam** (the risk for glaucoma, cataracts and age-related macular degeneration increase with age)—every year or as recommended

Fasting blood glucose test—at least every 3 years or as recommended

Hepatitis vaccines—as recommended by your health care provider

**Fact:** If you're right-handed, nails on your right hand grow faster; if you're left-handed, nails on your left will.




