Summer Bean Salad

2 TBSP white wine vinegar or red wine vinegar

3 TBSP Fresh Parsley, Italian variety or basil, minced

1/8 tsp. black pepper

A RARE PRIVILEGE BY MARG AND DAVE BURRIS

arg and I live a rather uneventful life, which is fine. But a few weeks ago we had the privilege of taking part in an event that not many people will witness or live to see. It was not anything we earned, or maybe even deserved, but we were there.

A friend of ours, Brenda, who we have known for many years, was kind enough to invite us to her mother, Elsie's, birthday party. On July 11th Elsie celebrated her 110th birthday; we were there, it was held in Elsie's nursing home, in a common room, and it was nicely done. We had birthday cake, sandwiches and punch, etc. We met the family and some of their friends, and had a really nice time.

Elsie held court for about an hour and a half, dressed to the nines, before she asked to go back to her room. She enjoyed seeing old friends, and recognized most everyone. She needs a wheelchair now, but still carries on. Her mind is sharp, and she looks much younger than her years, she really is quite amazing.

We had also been to her 100th birthday party. The family had a reception and meal, and after the meal Elsie took herself downstairs and played the piano for the guests. not too shabby.

So a bit of Elsie's life story. She was born in 1909, 5 years before the FIRST World War, in England. Her family survived the war but her father couldn't get work in England, so they emigrated to Canada, I think in the early 1920's. They settled in Toronto, and Elsie grew up and went to work in Eaton's Dept. store. She met her future husband, John Evans, in Toronto. They got married and moved to Moncton, New Brunswick. They had two girls, identical twins, Brenda and Karen, in Moncton, in the early 1940s. Then the family moved to Windsor, Nova Scotia, and John owned and managed a jewelry store. Brenda and Karen grew up and went to University where Marg met Brenda in the early 1960s, and Elsie has lived in Windsor ever since.

The rest, as they say, is history.

FROM THE OFFICE

his month I am going to review several new Park rules that have to do with bringing the appearance and standards in Embassy Mobile Park Inc. up a few notches.

Rule #13, PARK STANDARDS FOR HOMES AND HOME SITES. It is on

Rule #13, PARK STANDARDS FOR HOMES AND HOME SITES. It is on page 14. Per section 13A, I will be reviewing all mobile homes as to the following: "Broken windows, peeling paint, dull exterior of a manufactured home, or dirt, grime or mildew visible from a Park roadway or an adjacent lot must be corrected", which means the complete exterior of all mobiles except those on the perimeter of the Park. It also states that "Manufactured homes must be washed at least annually." Having your mobile washed should be less than \$100 so don't hire anyone who charges more than this!

Per **section 13B**, Obsolescence--it is saying that even if the discoloration or fading of your mobile is due to age, you are still obligated to bring it up to acceptable appearance. I can already hear people saying "I can't afford to do that". In reality, only about 10% of the park residents are in a financial position where it could be a hardship-these are long time, elderly, often widows, on a low fixed income. Generally, maintenance is all about making choices; paint is cheap. Although the Office does not endorse any handy "persons" in the Park, there are several.

Park **Rule 4B**, page 3, states that "All applicants are required to have verifiable income which equals at least 2 ½ times the monthly housing costs", which include lot rent, utilities and any payment they are making on the mobile home upon purchase. The reason behind this rule is so tenants have enough discretionary income to maintain their mobile home as required by the rules. I understand that some current residents do not have that much income, so I will work with them on getting their repairs/maintenance completed. BUT AGAIN, this is only a small portion of the residents.

Rule **9G**, page 11, states that "No a/c units shall be located in the front window of the manufactured home or front wall of any manufactured home." I will grandfather in all of the existing, but no new ones will be allowed. It goes on to say "Window coverings visible from the street shall be limited to blinds, shutters, drapes, curtains or similar standard window treatments. No aluminum foil, sheets, towels, blankets, mattresses or similar materials may be placed in windows and doors. **THESE ITEMS WILL NOT** be grandfathered in, so please remove them.

In keeping with improving the overall appearance of Embassy Mobile Park Inc, Rule 27, Page 26, states "Only standard lawn or patio furniture, will be permitted on patio, lawn or driveway. The patio and driveway are not to be used for storage of any items including household furniture and appliances". If you currently have these items in the wrong place, please remove them.

On another note, you may have noticed that the Pool is being locked up overnight. There are people using it overnight; not sure if it is park residents or homeless people, this is the only way to put a stop to it.

The next Manager's meeting is Wednesday, September 11th, 9:30 a.m. in the Clubhouse. Everyone is welome to attemd.

How much coffee can you safely drink? A lot

offee lovers can be understandably confused by the mixed messages they're getting about the health risks/ benefits of their favorite beverage. Some studies have suggested that drinking too much coffee can cause stiffening of the arteries, increasing the chance of suffering a heart attack or stroke. On the other hand ...

A new study from the British Heart Association, reported on the CNN website, suggests that drinking three cups of coffee or more a day is no worse for arteries than drinking a single cup. Researchers studied more than 8,000 people in the United Kingdom, some of whom drank one coffee or less a day, others who drank one to three cups, and a third group who reported consuming up to 25 cups of coffee a day. All participants were given MRI heart scans and infrared pulse wave tests, and scientists corrected the data for such factors as age, weight

wave tests, and scientists corrected the data for such factors as age, weight, diet, tobacco and alcohol use, and other factors.

The findings appear to show that drinking three cups or more a day doesn't significantly increase artery stiffness compared with consuming just one cup. No one is recommending binging on 20 cups or more per day, but you can rest easier knowing your arteries apparently aren't in danger.

Cold or the flu? How to tell

You're coughing, sniffling, feeling achy. Is it a cold—or the flu? It can be hard to tell, but the NPR website offers this advice for telling the difference so you can be prepared when flu season takes hold:

• The flu strikes fast. If you suddenly feel flattened, chances are it's the flu. A cold will usually take several days to build up.

• Take your temperature. Colds generally cause a mild fever of 99–100 degrees Fahrenheit. The flu's fever is typically higher—101 degrees or more—and accompanied by chills and body aches.

• Listen to your cough. You'll be congested with a cold, and postnasal drip can make you cough. Flu's coughing is more severe, and can lead to trouble breathing.

In most cases, people can ride out the cold or the flu with the help of antiviral medications. However, many health factors can increase the danger—pregnancy, asthma, heart disease, and other conditions. Contact your doctor to deter- mine whether more aggressive treatment is called for.


