FROM THE OFFICE

Now that my vacation is over, I will be sending out letters (soon) to mobile homes that need attention, such as carports, weeds, etc. If you receive a letter and have concerns, call and schedule an appointment to see me. If you choose to ignore a letter from the office, you may soon receive a visit from Largo Community Development for any code violation. City letters can be accompanied by fines, so I strongly suggest you take care of any issues that I bring to your attention. Thank you to those who maintain their mobile homes by keeping it clean, weeded, painted, power washed, etc. If you have a complaint, remember that all complaints must be in writing. This gives me the leverage that I may need if I have to evict someone for non-compliance with park rules.

If you have committed to taking care of someone else's mobile home, please make sure that it is kept in good condition. Also, if you have a key, you should go inside it after a heavy rain to make sure there are no leaks.... if caught in time you may be able to prevent mold. You should also walk around the outside of the mobile to make sure it is still secure.

We are coming into the "active" time for hurricanes; the hurricane guides are available in the office and the laundromats.....be prepared! Make sure the title to your mobile home is with you if you leave....FEMA will not authorize financial help without it.

National Wildlife Day, Sept. 4. Also celebrated on Feb. 2, National Wildlife Day serves to bring awareness of endangered animals nationally as well as globally.

Labor Day, Sept. 7. A day off and a day to pay tribute to working men and women.

National POW/MIA Recognition Day, Sept. 18. This honors those who were prisoners of war (POWs) and those who are still missing in action (MIA). It is most associated with those who were POWs during the Vietnam War.

Rosh Hashanah, Sept. 18–20. The Jewish New Year and the traditional anniversary of the creation of Adam and Eve, the first man and woman according to the Hebrew Bible, and the inauguration of humanity’s role in God’s world.

World Alzheimer’s Day, Sept. 21. An international campaign to raise awareness and challenge the stigma that surrounds dementia.

The history of Labor Day

Labor Day is a creation of the labor movement, a yearly celebration of the American worker, and a national tribute to the laborer’s contribution to the social and economic achievements of the United States. There is some uncertainty about the origins of Labor Day. Some records show that Peter J. McGuire, general secretary of the Brotherhood of Carpenters and Joiners and a co-founder of the American Federation of Labor, was first to suggest a day to honor those “who from rude nature have delved and carved all the grandeur we behold.” Other research suggests that machinist Matthew Maguire, later the secretary of Local 344 of the International Association of Machinists in Paterson, N.J., proposed the holiday in 1882 while serving as secretary of the Central Labor Union in New York.



The first Labor Day holiday was celebrated on Tuesday, Sept. 5, 1882, in New York City, in accordance with the plans of the Central Labor Union. In 1884, the first Monday in September was selected as the official holiday. The first governmental recognition of Labor Day came through municipal ordinances passed in 1885 and 1886. The state of Oregon passed the first law recognizing the Labor Day holiday on Feb. 21, 1887. Four more states—Colorado, Massachusetts, New Jersey, and New York—followed suit that same year. On June 28, 1894, Congress passed an act making the first Monday in September of each year a legal holiday in all the states, the District of Columbia, and all U.S. territories.

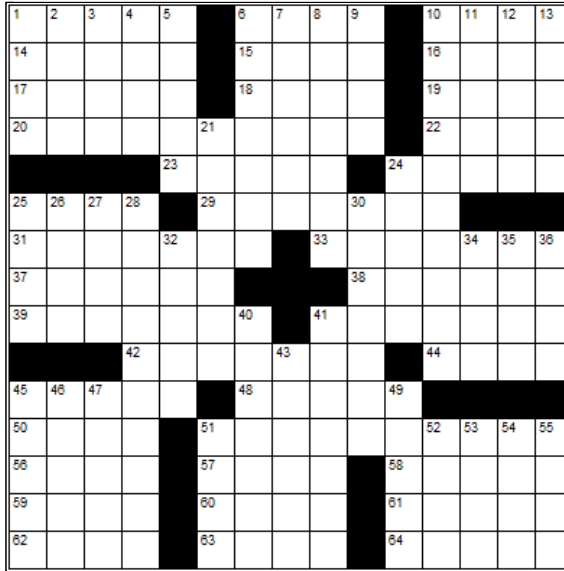

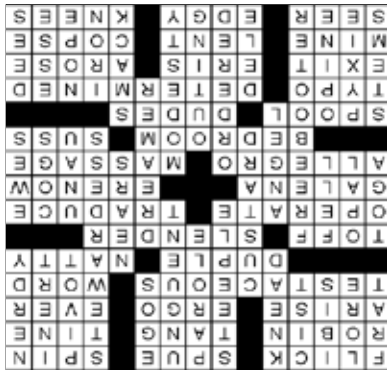
