

#### **RECIPE OF THE MONTH**

#### **Baked Onion Soup au Gratin**

#### Ingredients:

- 3 cups thinly sliced onions
- 2 1/2 Cups beef broth
- 3 Tablespoons butter or margarine
- 1 ½ cups water
- 1 teaspoon Worcestershire sauce
- Grated parmesan cheese
- Some red wine as desired
- French Baguette bread

#### **INSTRUCTIONS:**

- 1. In a pot, melt the butter and add the onions. Fry the onions until a deep golden brown. Add beef broth, water and wine; bring to a boil, cover and simmer for 20 mins.
- 2. Add Worcestershire sauce and season to taste with pepper.
- 3. Butter the bread, sprinkle with parmesan cheese and toast in toaster oven on broil.
- 4. Ladle soup into individual soup baking dishes and float toasted bread on top.
- 5. Serves 2-4, depending on the size of the bowls.






