

Some Reminders on Rules for Fairway Residents

RULE

- #6 Umbrella style laundry lines <u>must</u> be collapsed when not in use. Hanging laundry in driveway or carport is prohibited.
- #7 Overnight parking in the street is prohibited. You **must not** park on sidewalks or grassy area between sidewalk and street.
 - #8 Garbage can **must** be stored in your shed.
 - #13 You must register any overnight guests with the office.
 - #17 Only golfers are allowed on the golf course.
- #19 No food or drink (except for clear water bottles) are allowed at the pools. No private parties at the pool.
 - #22 Speed limit is 15 miles per hour.
- #25 Residents and guests <u>must</u> wear footwear and cover-ups when riding in golf carts, going to or from the pool, cycling, or walking in the village.
- #31 Tricycles, bicycles and golf carts ridden after dark <u>must</u> have a front light and back reflector. Motorcycles may only be used between 8:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m.






