rmistice Day – The Allied powers signed a ceasefire agreement with Germany in France at 11:00 am on November 11, 1918. This agreement brought the end of World War I. Over 116,000 Americans had been killed, wounded, missing in action or had died from disease. Germany was the last to sue for peace, so the eleventh hour was chosen to allow time for the news to reach combatants. The United States, Great Britain, and France continue to celebrate Armistice Day every November 11. Germany does not observe Armistice Day; their national day of mourning is observed two Sundays before the first Sunday of Advent, or the Sunday closest to November 16.

'And now the Torch and Poppy Red, we wear in honor of our dead...' from the poem "We Shall Keep the Faith", written by American Moina Michael. Poppies became the symbol of World War I, and on the Western Front they were a common sight. Poppies were first sold in Britain in 1921 to raise money to support ex-servicemen and the families of those who had died in the war. Poppies continue to be sold worldwide to raise money and to remember those who lost their lives in the first World War and in subsequent conflicts.

In 1926, United States congress adopted a resolution requesting President Coolidge to issue an annual proclamation calling for observance of November 11. In 1938, a congressional act approved the request.

After World War II, the United States declared November 11 a federal holiday, honoring military veterans. All men and women who have served in the United States Armed Forces. In 1954, at the urging of major U.S. veteran organizations, Armistice Day was renamed Veterans Day. Today, many towns and cities honor our veterans with parades and church services; with the American flag hung at half-mast. This Wednesday, November 11, let us all take a period of silence lasting two minutes to honor all of our **Veterans!**



Fairway Flags Fun Facts

Minnesota State Flag – In 1893 a contest was held to design the state flag. The winner, Amelia Hyde Center, created white on one side and blue on the other. In the center was the state seal wreathed with white moccasin flowers. It also included a red ribbon, the years 1819 – the establishment of Fort Snelling, 1858 – statehood, and 1893 – adoption of the flag. In 1957 the flag was redesigned to eliminate two different colors and change the flowers to Pink and White Lady's Slipper (white moccasin flower is not native to Minnesota). In 1983, the state seal was changed and the background color was lightened. The white circle contains four groups of four stars spread out with the North Star at the top.

New Hampshire State Flag — The ship, USS Raleigh, is said to be the first ship to fly the American Flag. Adopted in 1909 the ship is surrounded by laurel leaves and nine stars representing the ninth state to join the union. The flag has only been changed once since its 1909. The seal was slightly altered in 1931. The ship was built in 1776, but the seal shows it flying flags were not adopted until 1777. The state flag's design was ranked 63rd out of 72 flags of the US states and US territories; as well as, the provinces and territories of Canada in a 2001 poll. One elected official made the suggestion of replacing the state seal in the center with the Old Man of the Mountain, but no official action has been taken.





Corn Casserole

Preheat oven 350 1-12oz. can whole style corn, do not drain

2 eggs, slightly beaten 1 cup sour cream 1 – 8oz. pkg. Jiffy mix brand corn bread ½ cup melted butter

1 – 12oz. can cream style corn 1 small pk. Shredded cheddar cheese

In a large bowl, mix all ingredients together, except cheese. Pour into a 2-quart buttered casserole dish. Top with cheese, bake for 45 minutes. Serves 6-8

Honey-Glazed Carrots

Preheat oven 350 2 T. honey

16oz. pkg baby-cut carrots 2 tsp. cornstarch

1 T. butter ½ tsp. salt

2 T. brown sugar

In a small bowl, mix all ingredients together, except carrots. Pour glaze over carrots, cover and cook for one hour – or until fork tender. If you are short on time; you may cook in microwave on high for 10-12 minutes. Serves 4.

Cheesy Potatoes

Preheat oven 350 1 can cream of chicken soup

2 lbs. hash brown potatoes 1 tsp. salt

1 stick of butter Dash of garlic powder

1 cup onion, chopped 2 cups corn flakes, crushed

8 oz. shredded cheddar cheese

Defrost potatoes – In a large bowl mix all ingredients (use only $\frac{1}{2}$ the stick of butter, the other $\frac{1}{2}$ is for the topping). Pour into a greased 2.5-quart casserole dish. Mix reserved butter with corn flakes, pour over the top of the potatoes. Bake for one and a half hours. Serves 6.




