

Fairway Village Lakes

airway Village consists of three lakes; they are really ponds, but we like to call them lakes. Both, ponds and lakes, are inland bodies of fresh water that contain living creatures. Lakes are much deeper and have a larger surface area.

Coming into the park you will see Half Moon Lake. Its large fountain illuminates at night over approximately three acres of liquid emerald glass. Its depth can be from two to fifteen feet. Half Moon Lake is the perfect place to enjoy an afternoon of fishing or just watching the launching of the sailboats from our miniature sailboat club.

The large lake on the golf course, between the 7th and 8th hole, is known as Golf Ball Lake (you can guess why). It is approximately one acre and is from two to twelve feet in depth. Not only does the lake contain fish; but, also a lot of golf balls as well.

The small lake on the golf course is known as the Little Lake. It is approximately onethird of an acre and is from two to twelve feet in depth. This lake also contains fish and an occasional golf ball.

Each lake has a fountain and aerators that improve the water quality, reduce algae and weeds caused by excess nutrients. An aeration system helps the oxygen levels of the lakes. Several of the storm drains in the park empty into the lakes.

Fishing at any of the lakes is catch and release only. The lakes have an assortment of fish; largemouth bass, catfish, tilapia, and sunfish. In 2013 the annual Fishing Derby resumed on Half Moon Lake. Prizes are awarded in two divisions (male and female participants) and three categories (biggest fish, most bass, most catfish).

Whether you are a resident or a visitor, a fun day at a lake is always a great time.

Our Neighbors to the North


From its majestic mountains, rolling plans, forested valleys, and beautiful blue rivers and lakes; Canada is unique and awe-inspiring. Canada boasts the longest coastline in the world, with 150,993 miles along its shores of over 52,000 islands. With its two million lakes, more than the rest of the world combined, and the largest source of freshwater you have your choice of Walleye, Rainbow Trout, Northern Pike or Smallmouth Bass. If you prefer to just take a walk, head to Mount Logan in Yukon, the tallest mountain peak measuring 19,551 feet, located in the Kluane National Park and Reserve. Besides the breathtaking views of nature; you can also check out the numerous indoor activities – ice hockey, anyone?



Canadian Flag – Before 1965 Canada used the United Kingdom's Royal Union Flag; known as "The Union Jack". The current flag of red and white depicts in the center an eleven-point maple leaf. The maple leaf represents unity, tolerance, and peace. Since the flag was adopted, many

claim that the eleven points represent each of the provinces and territories. This is not true. The original prototype had thirteen points, however, on its way to the print shop they thought it looked busy and dropped the extra points.

Fairway Flags Fun Facts



Maines State Flag – The farmer and the sailor represent Maines strong agricultural and nautical ties. The state motto "Dirigo", under the north star, translate to "I Lead". The original 1901 flag consisted of only a pine tree and a blue north star on a buff-colored background. The flag used today was approved in 1909. However, in 2019 a contest to create a flag for Maine's 2020 Bicentennial took place. The winning design depicts an off-center pine tree and a blue field of water with a white north star.

Maryland State Flag – Two very distinctive designs representing the history of Maryland. The black and yellow represents the family crest of the first Baron of Baltimore. The red and white represent the flag that was flown by Maryland-born Confederate soldiers during the Civil War. Maryland is the only state that has specific guidelines on how to display the flag. The flagpole must be adorned on top with a gold cross bottony. All state government buildings, as well as, public schools obey this guideline; private individuals and businesses do not.



Coralee's Cooking Corner

his month Coralee decided to share with you some of her cleaning tips; just in time for the fall cleaning.

- Walls/woodwork mix together in 1 gallon of water, ½ cup baking soda, ½ cup vinegar and 1 cup ammonia.
- Steam iron fill tank with vinegar, let sit overnight, then rinse out with warm water.
- Showerhead soak overnight in diluted vinegar.
- Chrome fixtures mix together 1 tsp. salt and 2 T. vinegar
- Stainless steel rub with vinegar
- Toilet bowl pour vinegar in and let sit for 5 minutes, flush
- White rings on furniture rub with equal parts olive oil and vinegar, rub with the grain, then apply polish
- Oven with a damp rag, wipe vinegar and water to prevent grease build up
- Remove stickers from the car apply oven cleaner and let sit 15 minutes, then scrape and rinse

Before you begin your project please obtain a Home replacement or Modification Request form from the FVRA office or download it (page 12, Exhibit D, in the manual) and return the completed form to the FVRA office. The ARC, which meets most Mondays in the Clubhouse, looks forward to working with you in replacing your home or planning the changes to the outside of your home.

Rosh Hashanah, Sept. 18–20. The Jewish New Year and the traditional anniversary of the creation of Adam and Eve, the first man and woman according to the Hebrew Bible, and the inauguration of humanity's role in God's world.

World Alzheimer's Day, Sept. 21. An international campaign to raise awareness and challenge the stigma that surrounds dementia.

The history of Labor Day

abor Day is a creation of the labor movement, a yearly celebration of the American worker, and a national tribute to the laborer's contribution to the social and economic achievements of the United States. There is some uncertainty about the origins of Labor Day. Some records show that Peter J. McGuire, general secretary of the Brotherhood of Carpenters and Joiners and a co-founder of the American Federation of Labor, was first to suggest a day to honor those "who from rude nature have delved and carved all the grandeur we behold." Other research suggests that machinist Matthew Maguire, later the secretary of Local 344 of the



International Association of Machinists in Paterson, N.J., proposed the holiday in 1882 while serving as secretary of the Central Labor Union in New York.

The first Labor Day holiday was celebrated on Tuesday, Sept. 5, 1882, in New York City, in accordance with the plans of the Central Labor Union. In 1884, the first Monday in September was selected as the official holiday. The first governmental recognition of Labor Day came through municipal ordinances passed in 1885 and 1886. The state of Oregon passed the first law recognizing the Labor Day holiday on Feb. 21, 1887. Four more states—Colorado, Massachusetts, New Jersey, and New York—followed suit that same year. On June 28, 1894, Congress passed an act making the first Monday in September of each year a legal holiday in all the states, the District of Columbia, and all U.S. territories.




