# **Neighborhood Watch**

ear Resident,
As your Block Captain for the Neighborhood Watch, I would like to share with you some of the things that are important to keeping our neighborhood secure.

### Steps to take:

- Suppose you see a particularly suspicious person who does not appear to be innocently hanging around (like just walking down the street) but may be going up driveways or around the backs of houses. *Call your neighbors*, if they are home, and ask them to be aware of your suspicions and *then take action* as shown below, if needed
- Should you see a crime in progress call 911 immediately. Give the details as you see them and stay on the line to provide any details the police may need. after you feel that the police action has concluded, then call the FVRA Office to let them know.
- For a crime that apparently has been done (not in progress, such as a broken window, door left open when the homeowner has not been present, etc., call the non-emergency number (727) 587-6730, to report the incident. Then call the office to let them know.

### What should you look for?

- First of all, a license plate number, if it is in view.
- Then the clothing that the suspect is wearing, jacket, shirt, blouse, pants, and especially the shoes as they probably are the last thing a perpetrator would change.

As you well know, keeping ourselves safe is vital to our lifestyle.



## Residents: Do You Know the Rules for Your Visitors?

The spring break right around the corner our community will have many visitors, so residents, please remember to:

- 1) register your guests with the office.
- 2) get a visitor auto pass and if needed, a parking permit if parking in clubhouse lot.
- 3) persons visiting with pets may ONLY stay in the pet section.
- 4) Tell your visitors
  - a. That children (under 14) get to use the pools for 6 hours a day from 10-2 and Zrom 5-7. Cover ups and footwear must be worn to and from the pool and throughout the community. Water in a clear bottle but NO food is allowed at the pool.
  - b. Children must be 12 to play golf and be accompanied by a resident.
  - c. Children must be 7 years old to use the shuffleboard court and must be accompanied by an adult.
  - d. Florida law requires a bike helmet for children under 12.
  - e. You must be 18 years of age to play Bingo.
  - f. No one under the age of 16 is allowed to operate a golf cart.
  - g. After dark, bikes, trikes, and golf carts must have front light and back reflector.



# **History of Women Working Wonders, Continued**

This article will continue to explore the history of the Women Working Wonders group in Fairway Village. The history of the group left off last month with the second full season L of the group operation in 2009-10.

In the November 2010 - April 2011 season, the major new initiative was the establishment of a medical assistance equipment program. Used equipment such s crutches, canes, walkers, wheelchairs, commodes and shower chairs were collected, cleaned and made available to anyone in need. Equipment was stored in section of the FV maintenance facility and contact persons from the WWW membership were identified who could be called to sign out equipment when requested. Equipment was returned when no longer needed, cleaned and returned to the facility for future availability. Inventory was kept to ensure the whereabouts of all items.

In the following season, November 2011 - April 2012, the Red Cross Telephone Reassurance Program was promoted to residents who lived alone and wished to be contacted daily each morning to ensure they were safe and in good health The service was advertised through monthly flier articles and individual outreach and continues to be promoted periodically in articles in this monthly flier.

Working with the shuffleboard organizations, members delivered light supper meals to those unable to come to the clubhouse for the meals. For Christmas 2011, WWW purchased and delivered poinsettia plants to all those 90 or older and any shut ins. This became an ongoing program each year with a many as 50 or more plants being distributed annually. A program of delivering birthday cards to any 90 or older residents and shut ins in residence was initiated and continues to be an ongoing activity with as many as 70 recipients annually.

During the November 2012 - April 2013 season, the WWW mission statement was revised to reflect the current needs of residents and the scope of service provided: "The mission of Women Working Wonders is to provide financial and other forms of assistance through memberselected projects that will enhance the quality of life for the special needs of the residents of our community."

Information on obtaining amplified telephones was distributed to residents with hearing

deficits and continues to be promoted periodically via articles in the monthly flier. The publication of articles in the flier continues to be an almost monthly activity, informing residents of the availability of many local services to aid those who wish to remain independent in their own homes and also to highlight ongoing activities of WWW.

Seat cushions were purchased and stored in the clubhouse to provide comfort to those who found sitting on CH chairs uncomfortable when attending meetings and other functions. This effort continues with a few new cushions purchased annually to supplement the supply.

Working with the Thanksgiving Dinner Committee, WWW purchased (as needed) and delivered Thanksgiving dinners to those unable to come to the clubhouse for the meal. This service continues on an annual basis. Koffee Klatch left over donuts/muffins started to be delivered by WWW members to shut ins and those 90 or over who found accessing the CH difficult. This service continues monthly, with WWW now purchasing extra donuts/muffins to cover those served by WWW. Availability of a reading machine for those visually impaired was promoted through information in the monthly flier. The machine is housed at the residence of a FV resident who continues to be willing to share the equipment with anyone else in need.

In the November 2013 - April 2014 season WWW continued providing Thanksgiving dinners as well as the Shuffleboard lite supper meals. Working in conjunction with the Canadian Lite Supper Committee, WWW initiated purchase and delivery of lite supper meals in January - March and continues to do so annually, not working with the group(s) sponsoring a particular meal. WWW hosted a Memorial Service for Diane Davis, an original WWW member whose contributions to the organization were invaluable. Her loss was particularly felt by all her fellow WWW colleagues. Without her, WWW would not have come so far, so fast. Knowing how well the holiday time poinsettia plants were received, the purchase of springtime plants/flowers was initiated and they were delivered during the Spring/Easter season. The practice continues.




