PARK INFORMATION FROM THE OFFICE

If you need repair to your home, please remember to hire only licensed and insured contractors. If you have any questions, contact the FSE office. Please come to the office for a Construction Request, you only need a construction request for work you are doing to the outside of your home (mailbox, painting house, painting driveway, gardens, windows, roof, siding, concrete, pavers, carports, doors, handrails, awnings etc.). A construction request needs to be filled out and approved by our Construction Committee. You will also need to check with the City of Largo to see if your contractor will need to pull a permit. Most contractors know whether they need a permit or not. PLEASE make sure that the office receives a copy of the permit.

New coach #480 sold over the weekend for \$85,000. Four Seasons BOD is beyond thrilled that this happened right before the summer. Also, we have five empty lots - #162, 205, 366, 440 and 446. Lots #440 and #205 have houses that have been approved and the housing committee is ready to move forward with the permits for these homes. Nobility will be turning in all the paperwork for those two properties this week.

Please let Holly in the office know if you ARE NOT receiving VOLO messages so we can update our emergency list. All the emergency messages are sent by phone call, text messages and/or emails, so if your phone number has changed or your email has changed it is important to let us know.

PLEASE LET THE OFFICE KNOW IF are leaving the park for any length of time. And notify the office when you return. This helps to keep our resident records up to date. Provide any up to date telephone numbers and update emergency contact information. Many times, the numbers are outdated in just a short time.

Please make sure to dispose of your cigarettes properly. I've been noticing a lot of cigarette litter in the park. Cigarette waste has an enormous effect on environmental and health issues - it is more than just litter. Cigarette filters are not biodegradable and will never disappear.

If your planter is overgrown and needs attention, or your house needs power washed, or your driveway and home need painting, the FSE office will send out a violation letter to inform you that this work needs to be done in a timely manner (please read the rules and regulations). Now please understand that some of these letters that go out do take a while for you to receive, so sometimes the work is completed before you receive the letter. If that's the case just call the office to let them know. Please be sure that the outside of your home is kept neat year-round. I am considering some other smaller companies that do residential weeding. Once I find some smaller companies I will keep a list in the office and list them in the next monthly. Alexanders will no longer be doing summer weeding. The number of residents that



have signed up for this service has decreased every year and because they are a commercial company they can't handle doing small projects like this anymore.

You probably noticed that the rain we had in mid-April helped take some of the green Algae away in the East Canal. It looks much better. Once we get into the rainy season the condition of the canals will improve.

Please advise the office if any damage is done by the lawn crew on cutting days as soon as possible. We then can address this issue immediately and have an immediate response system in place.

IMPORTANT UPDATE: FOUR SEASONS WILL NOT BE DOING AN ENTIRE NEW WATER SYSTEM IN THE PARK! WE WILL BE FINISHING THE AREA OF THE PARK THAT DOES NOT HAVE WATER VALVES. WE WILL BE WAITING ON BIDS FROM OUR ENGINEER.

We appreciate your attention to the Pinellas County water restrictions in place. They are posted on the bulletin board in the clubhouse. PLEASE NOTE THAT WATER IS VALUABLE - USE IT WISELY. A SHUT OFF NOZZLE OR ANOTHER WATER-EFFICIENT DEVICE MUST BE USED. Water is our most valuable commodity – it is not free! If you do not have a copy of the water restrictions the office will gladly make you a copy.

FSE Office hours are Monday-Friday 9-3PM. The office phone is 727-584-1413, Office Fax is 727-581-8505. Please be sure to see Holly if you need to update your emergency contact information or address/phone. Holly's email is hross@associagulfcoast.com. After hours, the clubhouse can be accessed with your key card through the side door. If your key card does not work please have Holly check it first before you dispose of it. If you lose your key card to the door it is \$5 for a replacement card. Don't forget we have an after-hours emergency phone # that goes directly to Associa offices (727)-577-2200.

Even if you are a full time resident and particularly as people come and go from the park, it's important to notify the office when you leave and return. Also, important to watch out for your neighbors' homes – be alert – and report issues to the police if you ever feel threatened, or scared.

ARE YOU LEAVING THE PARK SOON? (Use this as a checklist)

o many things need to be done before you close up your home for the summer. Probably the worse job is emptying the refrigerator! Some folks actually leave their refrigerators plugged in and full of food, just always be mindful that if the power goes off during the summer and items defrost and then refreeze, you should discard everything when you come back in the fall. Better be safe than sorry!

- The second most important thing to remember Be sure to turn off your water.
- Store all outdoor furniture in your shed or porch heavy summer winds can cause items to be blown around.
- Remove fake flowers from your planters they only fade or blow away during hot & windy summer months.
- Take in and store your door mats and park mail pouch. Remove your flag and store away until you come back.
- Be sure to put a change of address/stop delivery with the US Post Office. And tape/tie your mailbox closed.
- If you have the newspaper delivered be sure to call them and give a stop date.
- Store your garbage and recycle buckets in your shed.
- Make arrangements for your planter to be weeded and shrubs trimmed while you are away. Notify the office with the name and phone number of the person/company who will take care of the weeds.
- Give a trusted neighbor a house key and ask them to check on your place once a month. Always good to have someone watching over things while you are away.
- Be sure to lock your windows and doors and shed door.
- Don't leave items like landscape lights or decorative items in your lawn. Difficult for the lawnmowers to mow around such items. Put your landscape lights in the planters looks nice at night in the summer when folks are out on their evening walk.
- Check your awnings now (before you have to leave) and put new fixtures on them if necessary. Be sure to lower and secure them when you leave. We saw what happened when Hurricane Irma came through last fall. It's such an easy way to secure your home and hopefully prevent serious damage.






