It's hurricane peak season through November. In case of an emergency we need to know who we have to check on. You can call the office, 727-584-1413, and let Holly or Desiree know or leave a message. Sometimes names are not understood on a message machine so also give your lot number.

Checking in would also be a good time to verify that your emergency contact information is correct. This summer the Largo PD needed to contact one of our residents. We had no idea whether the person had gone north or if they were here. The contact information on file was 12 years old. Ask Holly to check phone numbers, addresses, and email addresses. This will also help with notifications from Volo Village.

HURRICANE SEASON is still upon us. I have hurricane information printed out in the clubhouse for your protection and safety. If the copies run out come and request copies in the office from Holly or me.

The Clubhouse is going to look brand new!! We are putting in new LED lights in the next couple of weeks and the clubhouse will have brand new windows and doors - hurricane protected - and that installation project will start the 2nd week in September. We all are all excited to see our Clubhouse being renovated.

James and Clay are doing touch up work this summer. They have pressure washed the clubhouse and are touching up the paint inside and out. James and Clay have also become CPO certified (Certified Pool Operators). They are both maintaining our pool now and taking real good care of it. I let TREND our pool company go because the board and I felt like they were not doing their job. The Health Department was out the week of August 6th to check the pool and we passed with flying colors. Come by and look at the pool and our new pool sign. The shower has also been retiled. If you see the guys, make sure to tell them they are doing a great job!!!

If you need repair to your home, please remember to hire only licensed and insured contractors. If you have any questions, contact the FSE office. Please come to the office for a Construction Request, you only need a construction request for work you are doing to the outside of your home, ex (mailbox, painting house, painting driveway, gardens, windows, roof, siding, concrete, pavers, carports, doors, handrails, awnings etc.). A construction request needs to be filled out and approved by our Construction Committee. You will also need to check with the City of Largo to see if your contractor will need to pull a permit. Most contractors know whether they need a permit or not. PLEASE make sure that the office receives a copy of the permit.

If you see the Coyotes running around please come to the office and get one of the coyote handouts called living with Urban Coyotes. Holly printed them out and also put one up on the bulletin board in the clubhouse. I took the Coyote phone number out of the monthly because the trapper is charging \$500 a coyote and the board of directors cannot be paying that every time. I spoke to the FWC and they do not come out to catch Coyotes. Please make sure you put all your garbage in bags and keep it in a closed container. The coyotes can smell anything, including other animals.

ALLIGATORS!!! If you see anyone feeding an alligator please report it to FWC Law Enforcement. This kind of behavior is illegal and they will get fined. I have posted flyers with the law enforcement phone number up at the Clubhouse or you can call the office and request the number. I also have a FWC open permit for catchers to come out and catch the alligators.

Four Seasons has five empty lots - #162, 205, 366, 440 and 446. Lots #440, #205 and #446 have houses that have been approved and the housing committee is ready to move forward with the permits for these homes. I have been staying in touch with Nobility Homes requesting an exact delivery date for #205 which will be the first home to be delivered. As soon as I get a

delivery date for 205 I will let everyone know. I'm hoping soon!

Unit #469 is for sale for \$15,000, it's a 2 bedroom, 2 bath and fully furnished. I have it posted on <u>WWW.MHVILLAGE.COM</u> if someone wants to see pictures. I also can show the house if anyone wants to go inside.

Unit #212 was sold and is being completely renovated. Stop by and take a look.

Please let Holly know if you ARE NOT receiving VOLO messages so we can update our emergency list. All the emergency messages are sent by phone call, text message and/or email, so if your phone number has changed or your email has changed it is important to let us know.

If you have any questions on plants, flowers, grass etc. you can speak to Holly in the office, our master gardener and she may have some answers or resolutions to your questions.

PLEASE LET THE OFFICE KNOW IF are leaving the park for any length of time. And notify the office when you return. This helps to keep our resident records up to date. Provide any up to date telephone numbers and update emergency contact information. Many times, the numbers are outdated in just a short time.

Please make sure to dispose of your cigarettes properly. I've been noticing a lot of cigarette litter in the park. Cigarette waste has an enormous effect on environmental and health issues it is more than just litter. Cigarette filters are not biodegradable and will never disappear.

If your planter is overgrown and needs attention, or your house needs power washed, or your driveway and home need painting the FSE office will send out a violation letter to inform you that this work needs to be done in a timely manner (please read the rules and regulations). Now please understand that some of these letters that go out do take a while for you to receive, so sometimes the work is completed before you receive the letter. If that's the case just call the office and let us know. Please be sure that the outside of your home is kept neat year-round. Alexanders will no longer be doing summer weeding. I have a few contacts to call for weeding, one is Tony Webb (he used to live in the park) his cell is 727-314-0286, Karen Delmont who lives in unit #100 and her number is 330-367-7853 and Paul Young 727-348-2414. You will have to call and discuss charges with them.

Please advise the office if any damage is done by the lawn crew on cutting days as soon as possible. We then can address this issue immediately and have an immediate response system in place.

IMPORTANT UPDATE: FOUR SEASONS WILL NOT BE DOING AN ENTIRE NEW WATER SYSTEM IN THE PARK! WE WILL BE FINISHING THE AREA OF THE PARK THAT DOES NOT HAVE WATER VALVES. WE WILL BE WAITING ON BIDS FROM OUR ENGINEER.

We appreciate your attention to the Pinellas County water restrictions in place. They are posted on the bulletin board in the clubhouse. PLEASE NOTE THAT WATER IS VALUABLE. USE IT WISELY. A SHUT OFF NOZZLE OR ANOTHER WATER-EFFICIENT DEVICE MUST BE USED. Water is our most valuable commodity - it is not free! If you do not have a copy of the water restrictions, the office will gladly make you a copy. Check your garden hose

Please be sure to see Holly if you need to update your emergency contact information or address/phone. Holly's email is hross@associagulfcoast.com. After hours, the clubhouse can be accessed with your key card through the side door. If your key card does not work please have Holly check it first before you dispose of it. If you lose your key card to the door it is \$5 for a replacement card. Don't forget we have an after-hours emergency phone # that goes directly to Associa offices (727)-577-2200.

Also please remember to tell the office if you notice any unregistered occupants. Everyone staying over a month that is not family needs to come to the office and fill out the proper application for a background check. Make sure if you are selling your home that before any sale closes or any money is exchanged that buyers also get an application for a background and credit check. 10% of the homes in this park can be under 55 years old but not younger than 45. SOME STATISTICS FROM THE VIETNAM MEMORIAL WALL

The names are arranged in the order in which they were taken from us, by date, and within each date the names are alphabetized. The first known casualty was Richard B. Fitzgibbon, of North Weymouth, Mass., listed by the U. S. Department of Defense as having been killed on June 8, 1956. His name is listed on the wall with that of his son, Marine Corp LCPL Richard B. Fitzgibbon 111, who was killed on Sept. 7, 1965.

There are three sets of fathers and sons on the wall

39,996 on the wall were just 22 or younger

8,283 were just 19 years old

The largest age group, 33,103, were 18 years old

12 soldiers on the wall were 17 years old

5 soldiers on the wall were 16 years old

One soldier, PFC Dan Bullock, was 15 years old

997 soldiers were killed on their first day in Vietnam

1,448 soldiers were killed on their last day in Vietnam

31 sets of brothers are on the wall

31 sets of parents lost two of their sons

8 women are on the wall, nursing the wounded

244 soldiers were awarded the Medal of Honor during the Vietnam War; 153 of them are on the wall.

The most casualty deaths for a single day was on January 31, 1968: deaths: the most for a single month was May 1968 - 2,415 casualties were incurred.

Most Americans who read this will only see numbers that the Vietnam War created. To those of us who survived the war, and to the families of those who did not, we see the faces, we feel the pain that these numbers created. We are, until we too pass away, haunted with these numbers, because they were our friends, fathers, husbands, wives, sons and daughters. THERE ARE NO NOBLE WARS, JUST NOBLE WARRIORS.

THUNDERSTORM WATCH OR THUNDERSTORM WARNING - Do you know the difference?

evere Thunderstorm Watch: Be Prepared! Severe thunderstorms are possible in and near the watch area. Stay informed and be ready to act if a severe thunderstorm warning is issued. The watch area is typically large, covering numerous counties or even states.

Severe Thunderstorm Warning: Take Action! Severe weather has been reported by spotters or indicated by radar. Warnings indicate imminent danger to life and property. Take shelter in a substantial building. Get out of mobile homes that can blow over in high winds. Warnings typically encompass a much smaller area (around the size of a city or small county) that may be impacted by large hail or damaging wind identified by an NWS forecaster on radar or by a trained spotter/law enforcement who is watching the storm. (From the National Weather Service)







IT'S HERE FOLKS! Tropical Storm Season June - November

The are starting month #4 and we're not out of the woods yet! You might remember that last September we had Hurricane Irma come through – keep good thoughts that we don't experience anything this month.

month.

But, just in case, are you prepared? Because we live in a mobile home community we will be required to evacuate in case of a hurricane. Where will you go? Do you have your



medications at the ready with a supply of them in case you are gone for an extended length of time? What about food and water? Clothes? If you need help due to medical issues, there is a form that must be completed and returned to the Largo Fire Department before it's needed. You must be in their data base now. Check with our FSE office for the necessary form – copies are also on the credenza in the clubhouse.

First thing - where would you go? Friends or family? Hotel? Shelter? Which hotel would you go too? How long will it take you to get ready to evacuate? Remember you have to also prepare the outside of your home. Bring in "flying" objects like outside chairs, tables, plants, decorations, BBQ grills, etc. How long will this take? Put your awnings down! Will you need help? Is there gas in your car? The gas pumps won't work if no power? Do you have cash available in case there is no power and you can't withdraw from an ATM? Most stores won't take a credit/debit card.

FOOD? What do you have in your evacuation kit? Put high protein non-perishable food items like tuna, chicken, spam, beans, peanut butter, spam, maybe some dry cereal cups, crackers. How about non-refrigerated milk. Can opener? Plastic ware? Paper plates, and napkins?

BEDDING? If you have to leave, do you need to bring bedding supplies with you? Your favorite blanket or pillow? What about bath towels and toiletries?

CLOTHING? What will you need for a couple of days? What about a week? Warm clothes in case of a chill? Rain gear? Footwear?

MEDICATIONS? Do you have your medications together? Do you have enough for a couple of weeks in case pharmacies are closed or shipments can't get in? If hurricane is called you can get a two week supply before you have to evacuate. Call your pharmacy. If the medications are in refrigerator do you have a note in your evacuation kit to remind you to grab them? Do you need needles? Alcohol swabs? Do you have a first aid kit?

DO YOU HAVE A NOAA weather alert radio/device? Make sure you have it on and if it needs batteries put them in in case of electrical outages. Are you listening to the weather to keep track of what the updates are? DONT PANIC BUT BE PREPARED! Also if you have a CELL PHONE and there is no power how will you charge your phone? If you need to purchase
