

PARK MANAGER'S REPORT

Tuly was a very busy month at Four Seasons. The sidewalk project was completed by Tuesday, July 7. Concrete from the sidewalk repair was used along the canal(s) areas to help alleviate erosion.

The Sealcoat project started on July 8th because many areas of sidewalk repair had to be redone due to too much of a slant toward the street. In actuality we wanted the sidewalk at the appropriate height - if the height is too great, water runs back toward the driveway/carport areas.

Sealcoat color coordinated maps were provided by Linda, owner Asphalt Maintenance & Repair. We also had a cover sheet explaining days & areas where work would be performed. These were distributed throughout the park. Work days were Tuesdays, Wednesdays & Fridays. Due to a week's worth of rain, our schedule at this writing is a bit behind, but we look forward to completing the project by month's end.

I adjusted Alexander's schedule for a couple of weeks regarding lawn care. I added few more areas for crack sealing at no extra charge. Billboard signs were posted at each entrance into the park. The Community Facebook page alerted residents of any last minute changes.

We have a few more park owned coaches currently under contract while also taking back Lot #228. Lot #300 is almost finished and is looking great.

Queen palm trimming is best scheduled for late July, early August. Alexander's has cut back substantially on the invasive growth on the Golden Corral property at my request and at no charge to us.

The pool shower is slated to be redone as soon as possible.

The City of Largo placed safety chains on all six recycle dumpsters and Republic will follow suit on the two trash dumpsters.

REMEMBER TO CALL BEFORE YOU DIG! Please remember that the office must be notified if you plan to do any work on the outside of your coach - particularly plantings, fences, patios, etc. Underground cables for phone and electricity and fragile water lines need to be protected. A construction request must be filled out and approved before any work can begin.

Be careful out there! We have an emergency contact phone number 24/7 to Associa after office hours – do not hesitate to use it if needed: 727-577-2200.

IMPORTANT TIPS FROM ASSOCIA REGARDING HURRICANE **PREPARATION**

Hurricanes are frightening, but can be survived with minimal impact given the proper preparation. The following guide is designed to help you minimize damage and save lives through quick response and clear thinking that come from having a complete plan in place. Following you will find information to help you weather the storm, including checklists to make sure you have everything you need, tips for preventative measures you can take to facilitate



a fast response, and helpful guidelines for evacuation, damage assessment, and rebuilding your community. At Associa, we consider our clients to be family and we want you to be safe this hurricane season.

Listed below are suggestions for preventative measures to take before a disaster.

GATHER PERSONAL SUPPLIES: • Water – at least 1 gal. per person for three to seven days • Non-perishable packaged or canned food/juices • Snack foods • Non-electric can opener • Paper plates/plastics utensils • Garbage bags • First-aid kit • Flashlight(s)/batteries • Rain gear

- Medicines/prescriptions Cash ATM and/or banks may not be open for a few days/weeks
- Gas fill your car with fuel in case of an evacuation• A fully-charged emergency cell phone
- Keys to unit Waterproof container of important documents (medical, insurance, financial, social security, etc.) • Reading material, games, etc.

WHEN YOU EVACUATE: • Contact family/friends as to the situation •Let the FSE office know where you will be staying. Leave in daylight if possible • Secure/lock mobile; remove everything from carport or deck • Place towels on all window and door sills in case of water • Do not tape windows, this will not strengthen them • Turn off all water faucets • Disconnect all electrical items at the switches in the breaker panel box (except refrigerator) • Remove antenna(s) or satellite dish, be careful not to touch electrical wire • Have a primary and secondary evacuation route (traffic may be heavy) • Relocate ASAP prior to winds/rain becoming too dangerous • Bring any of the provisions listed that can be managed; add a pillow and blanket. We strongly recommend you evacuate in the event of a hurricane. If you choose to remain, please remember that you do so at your own risk.

SHOULD YOU CHOOSE TO STAY: • Clean, sterilize and fill available containers with water for emergency drinking purposes • Fill bathtub with water for bathing and to flush the commode • Move to an interior room or closet of your unit without windows • Be aware that as the hurricane approaches you should remain in your mobile. There will be no help available until after the storm passes.



WHERE IN THE WORLD HAVE YOU BEEN?

his is a new feature for our FSE Forum! Write a paragraph or two to tell us where you've been this summer. I'll kick it off with a couple of photos from my trip to New Jersey and New York City. I spent a wonderful day with my daughter and granddaughter visiting Ellis Island and the Statue of Liberty. Millions of Americans can claim ancestors who came through Ellis Island. Beginning in 1892, the majority of new immigrants, mostly Europeans, took their first steps toward becoming Americans at this historic site. It now houses a museum – three floors of exhibits documenting immigrants' experiences as well as a general history of immigration to the U.S.

The Statue of Liberty is a site to behold – sitting proudly in New York Harbor – it can be accessed by boat from Battery Park on lower Manhattan or Liberty State Park in NJ. Miss Liberty was built in Paris in 1876-84, dismantled in 1885, shipped and reassembled the following year on Bedloe's Island. Auguste Bartholdi was the young sculptor and in 1883, a young writer, Emma Lazarus, wrote a poem for a fundraiser for the statue's pedestal. She titled it "The New Colossus" after the Colossus of Rhodes, the ancient statue that inspired Bartholdi. The words are inscribed on a bronze plaque and affixed to the pedestal. Ellis Island and The Statue of Liberty are part of the National Park Service.

atthew 8:9–10 "For I am a man under authority, having soldiers under me: and I say to this man, Go, and he goeth; and to another, Come, and he cometh; and to my servant, Do this, and he doeth it. When Jesus heard it, he marveled, and said to them that followed, Verily I say unto you, I have not found so great faith, no, not in Israel."



Jesus marveled at the faith of a Roman centurion who understood the link between faith and active obedience. The centurion's faith was displayed when he recognized that the disease afflicting his beloved servant would be obedient to Jesus just as his soldiers were to his orders. Jesus healed that servant without even going to the town where he was because of the centurion's faith. There is no such thing as passive faith—it is a contradiction in terms. When we have faith, we do whatever God says, trusting that He knows better than we do.

Oswald Chambers wrote, "The goal of faithfulness is not that we will do work for God, but that He will be free to do His work through us. God calls us to His service and places tremendous responsibilities on us. He expects no complaining on our part and offers no explanation on His part. God wants to use us as He used His own Son." If we are not willing for God to use us as He sees fit, we are not truly living by faith.

Some people do things that have nothing to do with what God tells us in His Word and call that faith, but it is not. But a bigger problem for many of us is not doing what God says because we do not see how it will work out if we do. Whether it is giving, witnessing, parenting, or anything else, following God's plan works and it demonstrates that our faith is a real and living faith.






