



As previously noted, John Jones and I have been gathering information about the history of Four Seasons and will periodically be putting in some of this into the Newsletter. So here's the third installment.

DID YOU KNOW: I recently spoke to Gerry Androvett # 406. Gerry told me that her parents Christian and Virginia Atkins were part of the original home owners here in Four Seasons Estates. To Gerry's knowledge, Bill Nudelman who was the original owner of the park, lived somewhere in the park, but she didn't know what lot (actually it was #110). She said her parents and other prospective buyers were shown empty lots and then asked to choose one. Then they were given pictures of different mobile home models and layouts. After making their choice, they were offered another catalog of the furniture they might choose for their new model or they could purchase furniture on their own at the local stores. Her parents chose from the catalog and the furniture lasted forever and was very attractive. Gerry's mother was still living with this original furniture when Gerry moved down here 26 years ago. They were in Lot # 403 and she is in Lot # 406. Gerry remembers that there were two rules in the park at that time; only small dogs allowed and no laundry hung on the line on Sundays!

PARK MANAGER'S REPORT

Well here it is already February 2016. Can you believe it? The days seem to be flying by! The winter mowing schedule is now in effect – every other Tuesday of the month. Tampa Bay Plumbers has cited many additional areas of original valves in the north part of the park. The areas are marked with stakes spray-painted white.

We continue to monitor the condition of the water in the channel between FSE and Pointe West. In early December, the City of Largo was out with a huge dredging tractor/machine and I have requested a timeline for future work. I will keep you informed as that schedule becomes known. The channel (between Pointe West and Four Seasons) is the responsibility of City of Largo. The City of Largo has sprayed for weeds in the channel. The larger canal is maintained by Pinellas County.

By now, everyone (hopefully) is aware of the new STOP SIGNS that have been placed at each exit of the park as you drive on to 101st Street. Placement of these new signs was required by City of Largo as part of the permit process for the Sealcoat project done by Asphalt Maintenance Company during the summer. Please be sure to observe all stop signs in the park, particularly now that many residents are walking and riding bikes. Make sure the lights on your golf carts

and bikes are in good, working order.

Please be mindful of the speed limit on 101st Street – particularly during school hours when children and parents are crossing. When the lights are flashing the speed limit is 15 MHP. You must obey that or you could be cited for a costly traffic ticket.

If you notice a street light out in your area, jot down the number on the pole and give Desiree a call. She will notify Duke Energy for repair.

The current FSE Rules & Regulations are being reviewed under the direction of the ROC Board.

We appreciate that many of you have taken care of your planters, removed weeds, power-washed your coaches and painted. All of this makes our park more attractive to our current residents and potential buyers. Carport clutter must also be kept to a minimum. It is incumbent for each owner to maintain his/her own home for the benefit of the entire community.

For those owners who wish to have Alexander's (or any individual/other company) care for your planter and/or flower beds while you are away, I am requesting that you deal directly with Alexander's and contract with them. The FSE office will not be responsible for any contractual agreements between a home owner and Alexander's (or any individual/other company). You must deal directly with the company – phone 727-537-7314 or info@alexanderspm.com.

Also, I encourage those interested to attend Largo Commission meetings which are open to the public. **Largo City Commission** meetings are held on the first and third Tuesday of the month at 6 pm. All meetings take place in City Commission Chambers at Largo City Hall, 201 Highland Avenue. 

On June 8th, we left Halifax, N.S., flew to Montreal, Que., then to Hamburg, Germany and on to Faro, Portugal. It is lined with mountains and numerous vineyards. We toured many and sampled wines and ports. The scenery is absolutely breath-taking – we will never forget it. Returning to Porto early in the morning, we headed directly to the airport and flew to Frankfurt, Germany where we stayed overnight. It is a large and modern city. The next day, we flew to Halifax via Montreal. It was a wonderful trip!

Our next adventure in July is another riverboat cruise starting in Amsterdam, down the Danube to Switzerland where we plan to spend four or five days. Happy traveling everyone!
