

IT'S THAT TIME OF YEAR AGAIN!

¬ropical Storm season or some people say Hurricane Season is upon us again! June through November on every Floridian's calendar. Are you prepared JUST IN CASE?

Because we live in a mobile home we are required to evacuate in case of a hurricane. Where will you go? Do you have your medications at the ready with a supply of them in case you are gone for an extended length of time? What about food and water? Clothes?

If you need help due to medical issues, there is a form that must be completed and returned to the Largo Fire Department so you can be put in their data base. This is very important for any resident who might have a health issue and need assistance during an evacuation.

First thing...where would you go? Friends or family? Hotel? Shelter? Which hotel would you go to? How long will it take you to get ready to leave? Remember you have to also prepare the outside of your home...bring in "flying objects like outside chairs, tables, plants, decorations, BBQ grills, etc. how long will this take? Put your awnings down! Will you need help? Is there gas in your car as the gas pumps won't work if no power? Do you have cash available in case there is no power and you can't withdraw from an ATM as most stores won't take a credit/debit card?

FOOD? What do you have in your evacuation kits? Put high protein non-perishable food items like tuna, chicken, spam, beans, peanut butter, dry cereal cups, crackers. How about non-refrigerated milk. Can opener? Plastic ware? Paper plates, napkins, paper towels and toilet paper?

BEDDING? If you have to leave do you need to bring bedding supplies with you? Your favorite blanket or pillow? What about bath towels?

CLOTHING? What will you need for a couple of days? What about a week? Warm clothes in case of a chill? Rain gear? Footwear? Anything special?

MEDICATIONS? Do you have your medications together? Do you have enough for a couple of weeks in case pharmacies are closed or shipments can't be made? If hurricane is called you can generally get a two week supply before you have to evacuate. Call your pharmacy. If the medications are in your refrigerator do you have a note in your evacuation kit to remind you to grab it/them? Do you need needles? Alcohol swabs? Do you have a first aid kit at the ready?

DO YOU HAVE A NOAA weather alert radio/device? Make sure you have it on and if it needs batteries put them in in case of electrical outages. Are you listening to the weather to keep track of what the updates are? DONT PANIC BUT BE PREPARED! Also if you have a CELL PHONE and there is no power how will you charge your phone, you need to purchase a power bank and make sure it is fully charged before evacuating. If you have a C- PAP or other MEDICAL DEVICE how will you run it if we have no power. You can check on Amazon or other places for a personal generator. They can be recharged with home AC, car cigarette socket, or solar. BE PREPARED - JUST IN CASE.

Take IMPORTANT PAPERS with you. If you have a fireproof box take that! Let your family and friends know where you will be staying for the duration. Have one person be your immediate contact person and let that person spread the information to family members and friends. And please let the Four Seasons office know where you are going and when you are leaving. And be sure to call the office when you return. God Bless and Keep Us Safe.



GOOD NEIGHBOR REMINDER #2

t certainly is fun to look at the gators under the bridge, but did you know that it is against the law to feed them – actually to feed any Florida wildlife. Intentionally feeding species listed as threatened, endangered or of special concern is prohibited because it can negatively alter feeding behavior and can cause them to become accustomed to people. Alligators, in particular, can overcome their natural wariness and learn to associate people with food. 
ANNUAL 2020 CANUCK GOLF TOURNAMENT



Independence Day, July 4. Celebrate the date that the 13 colonies announced their independence from Great Britain.
