ummer mowing is in effect – every Tuesday weather permitting.

Please observe 10 MPH speed limit throughout the park.

Two new coaches #480 and #483 are for sale. Contact Desiree in the office for additional information.

PLEASE notify Desiree when you are leaving the park for vacation or for the summer. And also let her know when you return. This helps to keep our resident records up to date. Provide any up to date telephone numbers and update emergency contact information. Many times the numbers are outdated in just a short time.

Contact Alexander's Landscape Maintenance Company directly if you wish to have them take care of your planter and/or flower beds while you are away Phone 727-535-7314 or info@alexanderspm.com. Ryan Hudson is our representative and is usually in the Park on our Tuesday mowing days. Please also be advised to use the company of your choice.

The office has the right to hire out this work to be completed & then charge back to the owner, as necessary. Please advise the office if any damage is done by the lawn crew as soon as possible. We can then address immediately and have an immediate response system in place.

At my continual requesting, Golden Corral cut back invasive exotics to the rear of their property and along the golf cart path to the street. Excavation is now underway to create the retention area at rear lot and clean out of existing debris. Thanks to Code Enforcement Officer City of Largo working with me steadily to accomplish this feat.

Pinellas County continuing their spraying of the canal on an intermittent basis. We are in a drought & Lake Seminole is down by one and a half feet. City of Largo will be performing their one time cleanup along the canal & drainage ditch area. City of Largo did clear the mouth of the channel from large silt, mud buildup.

Next tall palm trimming shall be end of summer, beginning of fall. Trees less than 10 feet are handled by Joe & James.

I continue to receive many appreciative & kind comments on the trash & recycling performances. Thanks much to Joe, James, & Johnny.

We are working toward some resolution on the water distribution & valve scenario in the park. The engineer Richard Claybrooke is in process to formulate next plans from the utility survey & will report back to the BOD.

The perimeter PVC fence cleaning shall commence in early summer. Clay & Joe completed new PVC fencing installation at the maintenance yard & parking lot, also placing new irrigation for plantings in the bed area.

Remember to hire only licensed & insured contractors for their necessary work. Always check with the City of Largo whether a permit might be required for remodeling. Please come to the office for any construction requests & approval form.

WATERING SCHEDULE RESTRICTIONS FROM PINELLAS COUNTY UTILITIES

Phase I Water Shortage – May 2017

SWFWMD has issued a Phase I Water Shortage effective May 8, 2017. The current restrictions are still in place but residents should reduce all wasteful and unnecessary water use and be prepared for more stringent restrictions if drought conditions continue.

All watering is prohibited between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m.

This is a very interesting passage where Jesus is saying, "neither knoweth any man the Father, save the Son, and he to whomsoever the Son will reveal him."

HURRICANE SEASON IS HERE – JUNE 1st

Florida resident or new to the area, now is the time to take an inventory of your home, prepare your evacuation kit, decide where you will go if we need to evacuate. Because we live in a mobile home community, we will be required to evacuate in case of a hurricane. Make sure you have your medications at the ready with a supply of them in case you are gone for an extended length of time. There are many things to consider – we will publish information each month to help you prepare in case of an emergency evacuation.

First thing...where would you go? Friends or family? Hotel? If you need help by police/ fire there are forms that must be filled out and returned into them before a disaster strikes. Which hotel would you go too? How long will it take you to get ready to leave? Remember you have to also prepare the outside of your home...bring in "flying" objects like outside chairs, tables, plants, decorations, BBQ grills, etc. - how long will this take? Put your awnings down! Will you need help? Is there gas in your car as the gas pumps won't work if no power? Do you have cash available in case there is no power and you can't withdraw from an ATM as most stores won't take a credit/debit card?

FOOD: What do you have in your evacuation kits? Put high protein non-perishable food items like tuna, chicken, beans, peanut butter, spam, maybe some dry cereal cups, crackers. How about non-refrigerated milk. Can opener? Plastic utensils? Paper plates, napkins, utensils.

BEDDING: If you have to leave do you need to bring bedding supplies with you? Your favorite blanket or pillow? What about bath towels and toiletries?

CLOTHING: What will you need for a couple of days? What about a week? Warm clothes in case of a chill? Rain gear? Footwear? Anything special?

MEDICATIONS: Do you have your medications together? Do you have enough for a couple of weeks in case pharmacies are closed or shipments can't get in? If the medications need refrigeration do you have a note in your evacuation kit to remind you? Do you need needles? Alcohol swabs? Do you have a first aid kit for emergencies?

Most important - if you are in need of assistance, Largo Fire Department will send someone to help you in the event of an evacuation. Desiree has a special form which must be filled out NOW – in advance – and will only be put in effect as needed.

Do you have a NOAA weather alert radio/device? Make sure you have it on and replace the batteries in case of an electrical outage. Are you listening to the weather to keep track of the updates? DONT PANIC BUT BE PREPARED!

IMPORTANT PAPERS - take them with you. If you have fireproof box take that! Let your family and friends know where you will be staying for the duration. Let the Four Seasons office know where you are going and when you are leaving. And let Desiree know when you have returned to the park.

If you need help, don't hesitate to ask a Board member or a neighbor.

BE SURE TO SEND THIS TO YOUR KIDS OR RELATIVES SO THEY **WILL KNOW WHAT HAPPENED TO YOU!**



- ¼ cup finely diced celery (you'll need one stalk)
- 2 tablespoons finely chopped fresh parsley
- 1 pound lump crab meat
- ½ cup panko
- · Canola oil

DIRECTIONS

- 1. Line a baking sheet with aluminum foil.
- 2. Combine the egg, mayonnaise, Dijon mustard, Worcestershire, Old Bay, salt, celery, and parsley in a large bowl and mix well. Add the crab meat (be sure to check the meat for any hard and sharp cartilage) and panko; gently fold mixture together until just combined, being careful not to shred the crab meat. Shape into 6 crab cakes (about ½ cup each) and place on prepared baking sheet. Cover and refrigerate for at least 1 hour.
- 3. Preheat a large nonstick pan to medium heat and coat with canola oil. When oil is hot, place crab cakes in pan and cook until golden brown, about 3-5 minutes per side. Be careful as oil may splatter. Serve and enjoy!



BY-LAWS FOUR SEASONS ESTATES SOCIAL ACTIVITIES, INC

TERMS OF OFFICE:

GO GREEN AND KEEP THE BUGS AWAY

ooking to get rid of those pesky bugs that come with Florida heat and humidity? If you are like me, you hate to use any kind of poison in your home. So what to do?

Homemade recipe for roaches and palmetto bugs.

1/2 cup Borax laundry detergent

1 or 2 potatoes - boiled and mashed, and cooled

Mix together equal amounts of the Borax and mashed potatoes and form into 1 inch round balls. Water can be added if it is too dry to form balls. Place on a cookie sheet to dry overnight. Next day place balls in back of cabinets, behind stove and refrigerator, etc. Can even be used in the car. The roaches will eat and carry back to their nests and die. Within two weeks, you are pest free. These balls last 6 months or longer.

For ants you can put a small amount of honey mixed with Borax in bottle caps and leave on the ant trail. Same result. Also honey and peppermint essential oil - 6 drops (I use Young Living brand) works well for ants. Have a great bug free summer. From Linda Truitt
