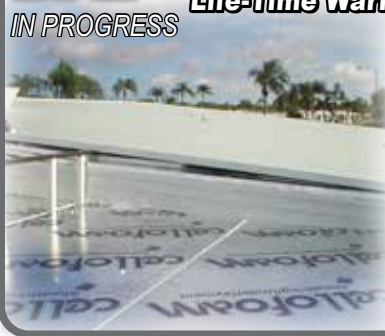

PARK MANAGER'S REPORT

The winter mowing schedule continues through March - every other Tuesday of the month. I continue working with Tampa Bay Plumbers regarding our water system. TBP is preparing a proposal for ROC Board review. We have had our Park water lab-tested; no lead has been detected.

Shuffleboard and pool area expansion and improvement is underway.

We continue to monitor the condition of the water in the channel between FSE and Pointe West. In early December, the City of Largo was out with a huge dredging tractor/machine and I have requested a timeline for future work. I will keep you informed as that schedule becomes known. The channel (between Pointe West and Four Seasons) is the responsibility of City of Largo. The City of Largo has sprayed for weeds in the channel. The larger canal is maintained by Pinellas County.

Clay has added a storage area in the clubhouse for the new equipment purchased by the SAC. Additional improvements for the existing closets will also be done. Over the past few years, the office has processed more than 1400 work orders.

The office staff (Desiree and Beryle) continues to be extremely busy at this time of year; sales and rentals, paperwork on a variety of projects, support for the Resident Review Committee, servicing our residents' complaints and other important issues. Thanks to Beryle for filling in when Desiree is unavailable.

Please sure to register your guests and also let Desiree know when you leave the Park for any length of time. It is important for park safety that we know which units are occupied or not. If you have a change in your contact/emergency information, please notify us as well.

By now, everyone (hopefully) is aware of the new STOP SIGNS that have been placed at each exit of the park as you drive on to 101st Street. Placement of these new signs was required by City of Largo as part of the permit process for the Sealcoat project done by Asphalt Maintenance Company during the summer. Please be sure to observe all stop signs in the park, particularly now that many residents are walking and riding bikes. Make sure the lights on your golf carts and bikes are in good, working order.

Please be mindful of the speed limit on 101st Street – particularly during school hours when children and parents are crossing. When the lights are flashing the speed limit is 15 MHP. You must obey that or you could be cited for a costly traffic ticket.

If you notice a street light out in your area, jot down the number on the pole and give Desiree a call. She will notify Duke Energy for repair.

We appreciate that many of you have taken care of your planters, removed weeds, power-washed your coaches and painted. All of this makes our park more attractive to our current residents and potential buyers. Carport clutter must also be kept to a minimum. It is incumbent for each owner to maintain his/her own home for the benefit of the entire community.

We also appreciate your cooperation on our trash/recycling pick-up days. Trash in a covered trash receptacle will keep the streets clean and the animals and birds under control.

For those owners who wish to have Alexander's (or any individual/other company) care for your planter and/or flower beds while you are away, I am requesting that you deal directly with Alexander's and contract with them. The FSE office will not be responsible for any contractual agreements between a home owner and Alexander's (or any individual/other company). 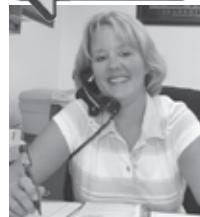

I really like what the Lord has had recorded for us from the Apostle Paul's epistle (letter) to the church at Ephesus. Let's look at it, and then I'll explain.

Ephesians 2:4–7 “*But God, who is rich in mercy, for his great love wherewith he loved us, Even when we were dead in sins, hath quickened us together with Christ, (by grace ye are saved;) And hath raised us up together, and made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus: That in the ages to come he might shew the exceeding riches of his grace in his kindness toward us through Christ Jesus.*”

When the airplanes piloted by terrorists struck the World Trade Center buildings on September 11, 2001, hospitals across New York City were quickly mobilized to take care of the many patients they thought would be coming. But sadly, only a comparatively small number of people needed immediate medical care because most of the victims perished in the collapsed towers. One of the few who survived was Genelle Guzman. She was trying to make her way down the stairs when the building collapsed. Her legs were trapped under a concrete pillar, but she had enough of an air pocket to keep her alive. For the next 27 hours she remained trapped in the rubble of the North Tower. Finally, the next day she heard voices and screamed for help. After twenty minutes she was pulled to safety—the last person to be rescued alive from the World Trade Center.



There was nothing Genelle could do to save herself, even as there is nothing we can do to save ourselves from our sin. Only Jesus Christ could save us by His substitutionary death on the cross and His resurrection three days later. The same power that raised Jesus from the dead offers us our only hope. For those of us who have trusted in Christ for salvation and been saved, there is a great obligation to share the Good News with others. We are surrounded by people who are spiritually dead. Almost all of them do not even recognize their condition. With love and compassion, let us tell them that there is hope in Jesus Christ. *It is because of the resurrection of Christ; even those who are dead in sin have hope for salvation.*

PEOPLE IN OUR PARK

My Sister-in Law-Rita Doyle –the person who has lived in the Park the longest of ANYONE, by Jim Degenhart, #462. My wife, Ginger, and I currently live at #462 and have been here for 11 years.

In 1972 my father in law and mother in law along with 2 of their children (Phil and Betty Doyle along with their children Rita and Betsy Doyle) moved into this Park at #199. At that time what a different Park it indeed was.

That winter (1973) Ginger and I first came to this Park with our children to visit our relatives. At that time I could stand in front of #199 and look all the way to Lake Seminole. No interruption. Where we live now (462) was only vacant land at that time. I can remember the streets were cut in and they were working still on the infrastructure. I would ride my mother-in-law's trike and watch the workers bring the new homes in--all sold.

We continued to come down for a long time after that--every winter--and what wonderful times they were. Everyone in the Park was kind, considerate and cared very much for each other. No little "clans", no nasty gossip and no back stabbing. OH--to have those times back I would give anything!

Regardless, my reason for writing this article is to recognize and give recognition to my great sister in law Rita, who is, as I previously stated, the person who has lived in this Park the longest time - uninterrupted - now 44 years!

Going the store? Why leave the house?

Shopping online has exploded in recent years. One example: A survey conducted by 72 Point Inc. and commissioned by Door to Door Organics, an online organic grocer, found that shoppers increased their online grocery purchases by an average of 29 percent in the past year, and those shoppers do about 19 percent of their weekly grocery shopping via the Internet.

Extra sleep may not lead to longer life

Most of us look forward to sleeping late on the weekend. After a hard week of work, we deserve a few extra hours, right? But a study from the *Journal of Clinical Endocrinology & Metabolism* suggests that sleeping in may contribute to a higher risk of diabetes and heart disease.



Researchers tracked more than men and women age 30-54, using devices that recorded their movement to determine when they fell asleep and woke up for a one-week period. Close to 85 percent went to bed later and got up later on their days off from work, and those people tended to experience lower levels of HDL cholesterol (the good kind) along with higher triglycerides, greater resistance to insulin, and a higher body mass index, even after controlling for factors like physical activity, calorie consumption, and alcohol use.

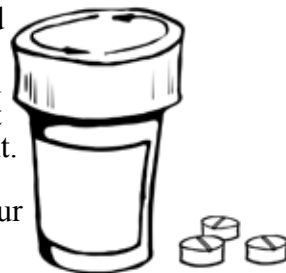
The implications are clear: Maintaining a consistent sleep schedule, even on weekends, is better for everyone's long-term health.

Aspirin prevents skin cancer?

Aspirin is known to cure our aches and pains and improve heart health. It may also be useful in preventing certain kinds of skin cancer, according to an article on the *Discover* magazine website.

Non-steroidal anti-inflammatory drugs (NSAIDs) like aspirin and ibuprofen are already known to help prevent cancers in the colon, lungs, prostate, and breasts. A meta-analysis of studies, some previously unavailable to researchers, turned up evidence that non-aspirin NSAIDs can reduce the risk of developing squamous cell carcinoma by 15 percent, and that when aspirin is added to the mix, the risk drops to 18 percent. NSAIDs are known to inhibit COX-2, an enzyme produced by skin cells in response to ultraviolet light.

Talk to your dermatologist about aspirin, and otherwise limit your exposure to UV light to stay safe from skin cancer all year round.

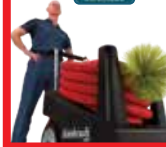
