

ARE YOU LEAVING THE PARK SOON? (Use this as a checklist)

o many things need to be done before you close up your home for the summer. Probably the worse job is emptying the refrigerator! Some folks actually leave their refrigerators plugged in and full of food, just always be mindful that if the power goes off during the summer and items defrost and then refreeze, you should discard everything when you come back in the fall. Better be safe than sorry!

- The second most important thing to remember Be sure to turn off your water.
- Store all outdoor furniture in your shed or porch heavy summer winds can cause items to be blown around.
- Remove fake flowers from your planters they only fade or blow away during hot & windy summer months.
- Take in and store your door mats and park mail pouch. Remove your flag and store away until you come back.
- Be sure to put a change of address/stop delivery with the US Post Office. And tape/tie your mailbox closed.
- If you have the newspaper delivered be sure to call them and give a stop date.
- Store your garbage and recycle buckets in your shed.
- Make arrangements for your planter to be weeded and shrubs trimmed while you are away. Notify the office with the name and phone number of the person/company who will take care of the weeds.
- Give a trusted neighbor a house key and ask them to check on your place once a month. Always good to have someone watching over things while you are away.
- Be sure to lock your windows and doors and shed door.
- Don't leave items like landscape lights or decorative items in your lawn. Difficult for the lawnmowers to mow around such items. Put your landscape lights in the planters looks nice at night in the summer when folks are out on their evening walk.
- Check your awnings now (before you have to leave) and put new fixtures on them if necessary. Be sure to lower and secure them when you leave. We've seen damage over the years and this is such an easy way to secure your home while you are away



INFORMATION FOR FLORIDA RESIDENTS

eal ID FLORIDA - While it's been talked about for several years, the Real ID deadline is less than eight months away for Florida residents. Starting Oct. 1, drivers' licenses and state IDs must be Real ID compliant to meet federal security standards. After that date, drivers' licenses and state IDs that are not Real ID compliant will not be accepted as identification by federal authorities.

You'll need the new ID, with a star in a circle in the upper right corner, if you plan to fly or enter any military base or federal building as of Oct. 1. Real IDs will be needed to board a domestic commercial flight as of Oct. 1, unless you have a valid passport or military ID card. Already some military bases may no longer accept non-Real ID compliant credentials which display "Federal Limits Apply."

The REAL ID Act was passed after the Sept. 11, 2001, terrorist attacks to establish minimum security standards for state-issued driver's licenses and identification cards. While Florida began offering the secure ID in 2010, the national deadline countdown has begun. Many residents continue to have questions about the law's requirements.

Here are answers to your questions...

<u>Do I have to get a Real ID? No. Real IDs are optional.</u> If you have a passport, you can



use that form of identification to board flights and obtain entry into federal facilities. Real IDs are not required to drive in Florida.

Do I need a REAL ID to vote? No. You do not need a Real ID to vote.

How and where do I get a REAL ID? Customers must visit an office to become REAL ID compliant for the first time. Visit www.flhsmv.gov/locations to find a driver license service center or tax collector office near you. We recommend making an appointment prior to your office visit.

What documents do I need? Obtaining a Real ID requires the following:

- o One proof of identity
- o One proof of legal presence
- o Two proofs of Florida residency
- o One proof of Social Security number
- o Current driver's license, if you are applying to exchange one issued by another U.S. state, territory or jurisdiction
- o If proof documents contain different names (for example, if the last name on a birth certificate is different than the name on a payroll check stub), it's necessary to supply documents showing proof of the name change, such as a marriage certificate, divorce decree, or a court order.
