

ctober! Black cats, scarecrows and brooms!! Halloween is right around the corner, can you believe that? As we head into the fall,

I would like to take this opportunity to address a few things about our rules and regulations. In accordance with our governing documents, the Board has authority to amend our rules and regulations from time to time. The Board of Directors has taken the time this summer to go over the rules and regulations and they have made some additions and deletions. Housekeeping, tidying up the verbiages, etc. Upon sending them to the Division in Tallahassee for review and filing, and after posting the new rules for 90 days, they will then go into effect on January 1, 2021. All of you will be made aware of when you can pick up your new copies in the office. We will also have you sign a rules receipt, for verification that you received your new copy. Any old copies that you have in your files should be tossed.

I also feel the need to reinforce the fact that I personally do not make our rules. It is my job and any other LCAM that comes after me to enforce our rules, equally and consistently. Without them, anyone could do whatever they want to do with no regard to neighbors or our community standards. That was not the spirit intended by our forefathers and foremothers of this community. The rules were put in place to provide everyone, shareholder and homeowner alike, with an aesthetically pleasing community. These people, our past Directors, labored and thought (maybe sometimes wanting to pull their hair out) and dedicated their service on our Board of Directors to provide rules and visions that could be built upon by future Boards. Rules and regulations that created structure. At some point, a shift occurred and things were not enforced consistently. The Board has been attempting to correct that. These efforts have shown in our property values increasing in the community. People are taking pride in their ownership of properties as witnessed by the amount of painted driveways, new roof overs, new siding, new windows, additions, new homes being brought in etc. I for one believe this was the vision of past Directors. Our little community has become one of the most desirable

in Pinellas County. Us, little ole Four Seasons Estates! I have said often, that I am merely a vessel of the Board of Directors. We are a business, and part of my job is to protect our assets and make sure that our community keeps to the standards that our previous Directors have set forth. I take no pleasure in telling someone "no", or enforcing a rule, I also take no pleasure in sending violation letters, nonetheless that is part of my job as the property manager. I am tasked with this sometimes unpleasant part of the job. I know I have great support in our community and I also know that I have some who do not. The Association cannot selectively enforce our rules, nor can our Board of Directors and they have been very clear with me on that note. Have you stopped to consider what position it puts them in when asking them to bend a rule? Have you considered the position they are put in when the manager tells someone no, because it goes against our governing documents and you then try to get a "yes" from one of them? Going forward, each Director will be explaining this as you come to them with this sort of request. They will also explain and instruct you to ask for a request form for anything you wish to do outside your unit. This includes painting of trim and driveways as well as anything that is planted outside of the planter box, etc. That is the policy. Once it is in writing, the approval process will start. It does not take long to get an answer. In some cases, I can give you an answer on the spot, as I have been given that latitude from the Chairman of the Construction Committee. In other cases, I may need to involve the Chairman. So, while some of you may be upset that we enforce our rules, others will continue to be happy that we will be unilaterally and consistently enforcing. We simply have to. If that makes me or a Director a bad person in your eyes, that is unfortunate as well. We are and will continue to be a united front. We all have the best interest of this community in our hearts. I hope that this clears up some misconceptions and it is received in the spirit in which it was intended.

I want to address the weeds in the park as well. We have had very few issues with that topic this year. During our summer months here in Florida, we get rain and usually lots of it. During that season, the weeds grow at a rapid rate. While we understand weed control can be an issue for our snowbirds, it is still a requirement as an owner that they are tended to. The office has nothing to do with finding you a person to tend to your weeds. I do not keep a list of people who do this work. Your best bet would be to contact a lawn/landscape service in our area if you do not know anyone who will do this service for you. Historically, the park office is not involved, except to hire someone and pass that charge on to you. Your best bet is, as I said, to contact a lawn service company to have it done. It is the best solution that I can offer. Letting them go unattended is not an option.

A reminder also that I have had a lot of calls and emails in the past few weeks about people parking in other peoples' driveways without written consent. If you do not have a written consent to park in someone's driveway, please don't do it. I have had people calling me from out of state, very upset over this. The Association does not want to have your car towed, even though it is within our right, and if the homeowner/shareholder exercises that right, you may find yourself looking for your car. None of us would want that. Please, get permission first.



As for parking on the streets. Parking on our streets is completely acceptable between 7AM and 11PM. After that, cars have to be parked anywhere else but the street. I have never had a conversation where I have told anyone that they could not park on the street in this community during the approved hours, ever. Please take note of gossip you may be spreading before spreading it. As I have said, I am paid to enforce the rules, not make them up as I go. Such things as this are malicious and rude.

In closing, on a positive note, we should be seeing the new Skyline unit come in on lot 187 very soon now. As well, things are progressing in the placement of the new Jacobsen home on lot 346. It is now finished and is proudly waiting for its new owner to come. Our community continues to grow and is flourishing. Let's all be happy and positive that we live in a little piece of paradise in the sun, in a place we call Four Seasons Estates!! That is the end goal in the game! We hope to hear news very soon on the return of our snowbirds from far and wide. Our community certainly is not the same without them!! In fact, he would have been one of the all-time greats except for one thing – no one could ever persuade him to put down his beer and hot dog and come out of the press box to play.

Most of us can empathize, for we all have people in our lives who criticize and secondguess. They are quick to point out flaws and quicker yet to offer advice.

When it comes to receiving criticism, I believe it helps to remember first that not all criticism is invalid. Wisdom listens for the kernel of truth and saves it for future growth. Norman Vincent Peale put it well. He accurately said, "The trouble with most of us is that we'd rather be ruined by praise than saved by criticism." Thoughtful criticism truly can be helpful.

But when criticism seems unfair or unwarranted, it helps to take a lesson from hawks. When hawks are attacked by crows, they will not counterattack. Instead, they will soar higher and higher in ever-widening circles until the pesky birds leave them alone. The next time crows caw and attack, be a hawk. 


