Hi everyone,
Jackie and I arrived in FSE on the 5th of Nov. by auto-train and it appears that we got out just in time. We thought it was cold while we were packing the van to leave, 37 degrees F, but now the snow is flying and the temperature is dipping to single digits. We're glad to be back. Many things have happened in the Park over the summer months.

SHUT OFF VALVES: We have moved the final phase of this project, that of identifying



all sectors of the Park and the valves that control the water flow to them, to the month of January when 90% + of our residents will be back in the Park and able to monitor the water to their homes as we turn valves on and off and record the results. With your cooperation we hope to complete this in a couple of days. It will make life a lot more comfortable for all of us.

OFFICE SPACE UPGRADE: The renovation of the office spaces are well underway and looking good. Clay is doing a wonderful job and it should be complete before you receive this newsletter.

Digitization: The work of digitizing our files has been completed by Desiree and Beryle Patton. Thank you both.

ROC Units: Clay continues to work diligently on rehabbing these coaches and has reduced the yet to be rehabbed to 6.

We have said this many times before, but I will say it again, if you are having someone coming to occupy your coach they need to be approved before hand and they need to check in at the office. It can be very embarrassing for you and the guest if they are denied occupancy after they have traveled many miles because we find they do not qualify. Please make sure that your renters understand that we are a 55+ community and a pet free Park. If you are uncertain what needs to be done, contact Desiree in the office. Finally, we should all understand that we are responsible for the people that we allow to rent or occupy our units, so make sure they are fully aware of the rules and regs of our Park.

When you are leaving the Park for an extended period of time (cruise, visit friends, etc.), **please** inform the office that you are going to be out of the Park. Also, it would be a good idea to let the office know who has keys to your home. In case of an emergency we will contact that person and try to prevent further damage if possible. You might think about letting Desiree know who is responsible for maintaining your flower bed/s. Our Park has never looked better - let's keep our Park looking beautiful all year long. Our full time residents certainly would appreciate your help in this matter. We have people interested in our Park to purchase or rent a coach, so the Park should be in "A1" shape at all times. Our after hours/weekend emergency phone contact number is 727-535-2424.

Recycling: The recycling program has progressed in a very positive way. This will be our first full season for the recycling program. I would like to thank all for your past cooperation and participation in this important endeavor to help preserve our environment and look forward to it continuing into the future. It may be winter, but you'd never know it by looking at our lovely Four Seasons pool. Please observe these important rules for everyone's protection and enjoyment.

1. If you are the last one out of the pool, always be certain that the rope is secured across

the pool. Please ask your guests to be aware of the importance of this as well.

2. If you are a smoker and use the ‘butt’ buckets – please clean them out once in a while. Make sure the ‘butts’ are completely out before you put them in the trash can.
3. The life preserver is for emergencies only – it is not a toy – do not let children play with it in the pool.
4. Observe special times for your young visitors. Children under the age of 16 may use the pool between the hours of 10AM - 1PM and 5PM till dusk, and should be accompanied and controlled at the pool by their host/s or a designated adult.
5. Straighten the chairs and tables whenever you move them around – don’t leave them for someone else to rearrange.
6. If you put an umbrella up – make sure you put it down and tie it when you leave the pool. Winds can blow up quickly - we wouldn’t want anyone to be injured by a flying umbrella.
7. The green wrist bands serve to identify residents and guests – it’s important for everyone’s security to know who belongs here and who doesn’t. PLEASE WEAR THEM.
8. Be sure to dispose of trash properly – there is a special covered can to recycle aluminum cans – do not put household/personal trash in the trash can – NO GLASS ALLOWED IN THE POOL AREA (this is for everyone’s safety).
9. A few folks have taken to caring for the potted plants around the pool – please help out if the plants look like they need watering. There is a watering can by the hose along the back wall of the clubhouse. Thanks.

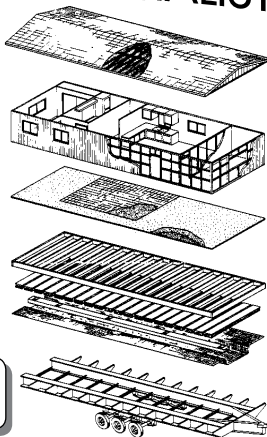

gentler, and the background changing from the stark brownish darks of winter to the lush bright greens of the tropics. After six days of driving, the car filled past capacity, we finally arrive at our little house on the Canal in Largo.

The next morning a sense of peace and tranquility overwhelms me as I sit on the familiar dock drinking delicious hot coffee and eating still-warm bagels from the local deli. The air, while by no means cold is brisk with a gentle breeze shifting the fronds of the ubiquitous palm trees. The most wondrous sight and sound of all, however is the BIRDS!!!!!!

By the second day the inevitable head cold (the price of traveling from one climate into another) has brought me down somewhat. I've finally relented and started taking the horrid cold tablets which dull my senses and make me incessantly hungry. I sat out here on my dock last night with a hot toddy (for the cold of course !!!) and got bitten by creatures called "no see'ums". These nasty little mosquitoes are invisible and their effects cannot be felt until later when you awake in a frenzy of itching and hive-like bumps. Why is it that some people (like my husband) are so unaffected and others of us are so tormented by our entomological brethren???

It's the third day and so far all we've done is shop, shop, shop. We need to do this because there was no room in the car for Xmas decorations (an oversized SUV). I'm dying to go to the beach and swim in the Gulf. Floridians think I'm a little eccentric because I like to swim in the ocean in the winter, however, it's still much warmer that at home in July. You'd think the mosquitoes would have the decency to lie low at least for Xmas...ooh I'm not feeling full of good cheer this morning...the d...cold still hanging on...need to regroup...need to work out - that always does it...another bite...sniff, sniff.

God Rest Ye Merry...My, but how precious they look...the ducklings I mean following closely after their mom, with every confidence vociferously greeting the day...let's hope the alligator is sleeping...has just settled down for a long winters nap.

It's Day Four and we saw "Christmas Carol" at Ruth Eckerd last evening....ahhhh, this is more like it. There is caroling this evening in the Park and the Parade of the Christmassy decorated
