



dead fish immediately. I don't know and was not contacted by a USA Agriculture person. Fish kills happen every so often in all of our lakes. Most of the time it is due to the lack of oxygen in the water. There is no cause for alarm.

In addition, the word is that our swan recently transferred to the north (laundry room) pond is getting along famously. It is also reported that since he arrived, there has been little or no need to clean up after any of our muscovy duck population in the vicinity of the laundry.

RUMOR MILL & OTHER THINGS

The concrete road deck beams are in place over 4th Street and Roosevelt Avenue, replacement of the fire scared wall from the tanker fire back in December is proceeding and building of the approach ramp immediately south of the Gateway will likely be completed by summer when construction of the road deck itself can begin.

It has been reported that the Sheriff's Department has been conducting radar speed checks on 106th Avenue (side entrance to Gateway) as people enter and leave the park and pass through the 10 mph posted Sienna Bay neighborhood. Sienna Bay management has expressed their concern that people are traveling too fast through the area.

Other than the Annual Bazaar and Halloween and Valentine Dance ticket donations the only other source of GAO General funding is through the paper and can recycling. The paper 'dumpster' is located at the north end of 1st Way and aluminum cans (free of cigarette butts and ashes please) can be deposited in the clubhouse storage room or the barrel marked for aluminum cans at the east entrance bulletin board.

Stay optimistic to get ahead

uccessful people are optimistic. They're realistic, and they see the challenges, but they don't lose their confidence. Here are some of the characteristics of "intelligent optimists" that anyone can master:
