## **MESSAGE FROM MANAGEMENT - July, 2017**

While doing a routine inspection just this week, we noted several issues that need to be addressed such as homes that need to be pressure washed and or painted, carports becoming cluttered and items being stored or just left sitting all around the exterior of the homes.

#### Please take a moment and read over these reminders:

- Your home must be kept neat, orderly and clean. No items should be stored or left sitting outside on your carport or around your home. This means things like empty flower pots, old furniture, dilapidated bicycles, storage boxes, indoor furniture etc. need to be removed from the home exterior.
- The home should be washed and/or painted as often as necessary in order to keep your home up to community standards.
- Lawns should be mowed at least once every 10 days during the growth season from April through October. No work will be permitted on Sundays that will disturb your neighbors.
- Any changes to the outside of your home must be approved by the Community Manager before any work is done. All exterior paint colors must be approved by the Community Management. Any structural changes will also require a building permit.
- The speed limit in the community is 15 mph! When using the side gate entrance please remember that the speed limit is 10 mph until you reach 4th Street! Be considerate to all your neighbors and SLOW DOWN!! Please also remember to STOP at all stop signs.
- No antennas are permitted at the front of the home. They must be installed at the rear of the home and be approved by management before installation.
- The park reserves a 12 foot right-of-way strip in front of all homes on which nothing can be planted, placed or built, except a private walk way to your front door.
- NO PARKING ON THE GRASS AT ANYTIME FOR ANY REASON.



There are also many residents whose homes and yards are maintained beautifully – and to you we say a big <u>THANK YOU</u>!

We would also like to mention that when the water is shut off to your home and the community; that we are in the process of completing repairs. Unfortunately, many times this is an emergency repair and we cannot give any advance notice. We will work diligently to have the water back on as quickly as possible.

Above all, we would like to thank you all for being residents in our community and let's all work together to keep Gateway a community everyone can be proud to call home!

### **ANOTHER SPECIAL SUMMER**

his summer Ohio has presented me with a different experience than the last. If you recall, last summer at our river 'home' there was a 17 year cicada (large noisy bug) hatch.

Kathy came north weeks too early, so she says, just to make sure I had an appropriately prepared 70th birthday celebration. (It was great!)

So this year she hung out at Gateway until mid-June. Thank goodness the weather in Ohio, managed to make it to upper 80's daytime, upper 60's night, just prior to her arrival. Oh, the week prior to here arrival and throughout much of the month of May? Daytime highs in the 60s and nighttime lows, hold on to your heating pad, upper 30's to mid 40's! Enough rain that I was prevented from putting our dock and boat in place until the second weekend in June.

All the Ohio people say it was a very mild winter. A couple said they managed to golf a time or two every month. I know it had to have been as they say. Bugs! Lots of them, ants and spiders, even some in the house, neighbors reporting ticks on their dogs and how they check their clothes closely after they mow and work in the yard. Wasps and bees. Fly Catchers and Blue Birds non-stop perching and pouncing. And snakes, garter snakes, water snakes and black snakes. The neighbor said his cat found one in the house over the weekend.

My major month of May project, removal of a 20" diameter tree, was accomplished over a couple days with the assistance of my son Bud and friend Frank. Frank and I were the ground crew as Bud worked out of the basket of a 45' Articulated JLG Lift Machine that I rented for the job. I live-streamed the operation on Facebook, first time I tried that, and if you have access to my page you can scroll back and find it. What one of the neighbors told me he really enjoyed was listening to Kathy (1100 miles away) instruct me how and where to place the camera for the best view.

The tree was nearly 60' tall and took some doing but the last big piece hit the ground after about 3 hours. We spent a couple hours ground time sawing it into firewood size pieces and prepping branches and the large diameter trunk for removal by the landlord. The yard was still covered with debris and I spent four hours the next day raking, cutting and burning and another half day later in the week until all that remained was filling some ankle breaking holes where big pieces hit the ground from high up.

As I complete this months NewsNDos, the muddy water rushing past our riverside place is approaching 7' above normal but still not a threat to our safety. A four day stint of heavy rain is about to end and experience says this high water will be gone over the next week or so.

## **RUMOR MILL & OTHER THINGS**

The Gateway website currently lists 7 homes ranging from \$8500 to \$89900 available for immediate occupancy. The Park consists of approximately 312 improved lots and the fact that there appears to be less than 3% of the homes vacant, certainly bodes well for we residents. If Gateway remains a popular and desirable place to reside we should expect that Park owners and their management staff will have adequate revenue and incentive to maintain and improve the amenities they provide, and will adequately vet new residents in an effort to attract and keep responsible individuals of good moral character.

#### **No-See-Ems!**

Florida, unfortunately, is home not only for abundant mosquitoes, but also for minute biting insects known locally as "sandflies" (elsewhere as "no-see'ums" or "punkies"), although the more correct name is "biting midges." They are especially troublesome in coastal areas, where most of Florida's population lives.

No-See-Em Repellents

Avon Skin-So-Šoft; Skin-So-Soft + Rubbing Alcohol (50/50 Spray); Sandalwood Incense & Oils; Manuka Oil (pricey); or this: Mix 1 cup of Original Listerine with 1 cup of witch hazel and 3 drops of tea tree oil, apply as spray every few hours. (Editors Note: Before you use any of these make certain you are not allergic to any of the ingredients they contain!)

Keep in mind the pipes supplying water to our homes and to water our lawns are old and not buried deeply in the ground. Parking and driving on the grass will most certainly lead to breakage and the interruption to water service during the time it takes to accomplish repairs to either of the systems. Pay attention to the signs and please do not drive on or park your motor vehicles on the grass.

Other than the Annual Bazaar and Halloween and Valentine Dance ticket donations the only other source of GAO General funding is through the paper and can recycling. The paper 'dumpster' is located at the north end of 1st Way and aluminum cans (free of cigarette butts and ashes please) can be deposited in the clubhouse storage room or the barrel marked for aluminum cans at the east entrance bulletin board.

The rains of summer have brought Gateway lawns back to life. Great to hear and look forward to seeing them in September. The Gandy Boulevard flyover construction is nearing completion, still, regular lane closures and changes to traffic patterns will likely continue right up to the very end. Traffic flow is reported to be much improved at the Gandy entrance during times other than rush hour. The newly opened Culver's on 4th Street is getting good reviews from residents.


