August is the slowest of summer social months and following the Potluck your summertime volunteers will begin preparing for the September 2nd Labor Day event.


#### TUESDAY GAME NIGHT

#### THESE ARE THE MOST COMMON VIOLATIONS AT Gateway

- **2. FENCES or GATES-** Rules & Regulations say ABSOLUTELY NO FENCES OF ANY KIND- Yard Or Driveway.
- **3. CLEANLINESS** Rules & Regulations say- No mold or Mildew, only yard furniture, bikes and grills on carport.
- **4. YARDS-** Rules & Regulations say yard needs to be Mowed at least every 10 days- and ABSOLUTELY no debris, junk or building materials in Front, Back or sides of Home.
- **5. PETS**-Rules & Regulations say ALL PETS MUST BE DOMESTIC (Dogs or Cat) And they must always be on a leash at all times and you must clean up after your pets. Not someone else's responsibility to clean up after your pet.
- **6. Cats-** your Cats are no better than Dogs If they are out of the House they must be on leashes, It is not the responsibility of your neighbors to take care of your cats, and they are breeding at a rapid pace which has got to stop. If this problem keeps up we will forced to trap ALL cats and have them sent to the pound. THEY ARE SUPPOSED TO IN YOUR HOME NOT WANDERING THE PARK.
- 7. DUCKS- Rules & Regs say- THEY ARE NOT PETS. They are uninvited Pains in neck to all tenants and Management. We at Gateway have the right to make and Enforce certain rules and RULE #1 for a long time has been \*\*\*DO NOT FEED THE DUCKS\*\* (THIS MEANS NO ONE IS EXEMPT FROM FEEDING THEM- NO MATTER YOUR PLACE OR POSITION IN OUR COMMUNITY) Which also means No Bird Feeders, No Bird Baths. Until we can get DUCK issue under control these items cannot be in your yards.

I am trying to make Gateway Mobile Home Park a Great Place to live and it will take each of you to help make it that way. Like I said, I have been trying to avoid at all cost to keep writing Violations, and or turning to evictions for Violations but I will if Necessary. I cannot let the Majority suffer for the few.

# **RUMOR MILL & OTHER THINGS**

The Editor

There been an online computer user from the earliest days of personal computing and even prior to the perils of identity theft and debit cards to purchase gasoline I was aware of and concerned for personal information privacy and security. I have been a purchaser and user of Norton/Symantec Security software for decades and can recall fondly how I was the one being called by friends when their systems had been compromised and was able, through the use of Norton/Symantec tools to get them back online and their fears of future loss allayed.

The following information involving **Home Cyber Security** is printed with permission from a recent **Norton Online Security Newsletter**.

#### **Personal Documents**

Paperwork that contains personal information like your social security number is extremely valuable to identity thieves. Make sure important papers (i.e., mortgage documents, vehicle titles, deeds, birth certificates, passports, loan information, estate plans, visas, passports, current and expired licenses) are stored safely. And check on them frequently to make sure they are still there – not just when they need an annual renewal.

#### **Desktop Computers**

Some people may think that if your computer is stationary it's not susceptible to hacking. Wrong. Your hardware, software, and network can all be compromised. If your desktop is older and you don't make updates to your operating system or software, you may be exposing the information on your desktop to security holes. Always check for updates, 'bug fixes', and stay alert to any suspicious emails from people you don't know.

#### Mobile

Our phones feel like extensions of ourselves, and thus they're popular targets for scammers. Cybercriminals continue to develop stealthy new threats for mobile devices - threats that can spy on your location information, steal your passwords or damage your device.

#### Recycling

While you're trying to be good for the environment you may be aiding identity theft. Make sure you do not throw bills or mail that includes your personal info into the recycling bin without shredding it first.

#### Laptops

To keep your computer safe, always keep software up to date (even a new laptop right out of the box can have outdated software that's vulnerable to attack). Manufacturers' updates are designed to address security holes in operating systems.

#### **Trash**

This one may seem old-fashioned, but your trash can be like a candy store for identity thieves. By digging through your garbage, they can snatch bills, receipts, and credit offers. If your trash has personal information on it, you may be vulnerable.

eep in mind the pipes supplying water to our homes and to water our lawns are old and not buried deeply in the ground. Parking and driving on the grass will most certainly lead to breakage and the interruption to water service during the time it takes to accomplish repairs to either of the systems. Pay attention to the signs and please do not drive on or park your motor vehicles on the grass.

Residents are reminded that the 4th Street North and Gandy (Frontage) Blvd intersection is, in my opinion, among the most dangerous in Pinellas County. Though the completion of the flyover has brought a great deal of relief to our ability to exit the park at the main entrance, still care should be taken at all times as you approach 4th Street seeing as how when drivers have a choice as to which of six lanes to select as they approach the traffic signal it is highly likely mistakes as to where they can go from the lane where they intend to be will be common. Try not to get in their way.

### A SUMMER OF RAIN AND DESPAIR

s many of you have come to know Kathy and I escape the heat and humidity of the Gateway summer at a riverside campground in East-central Ohio. For years it was a weekend retreat that was upgraded to accommodate full-time living when we retired in 2005. It has been the place of many enjoyable days, weeks and months of summer fun and relaxation.

The title for this column last August was A Summer of Cleanup and Repair that followed a disastrous flood of the campground as the result of winter ice damning our normally free-flowing river.

This Spring I returned north in early May to complete some home maintenance and looked forward to having our floating dock and pontoon boat in the water by the time the temperatures had warmed to Kathy's acceptable degree. Well, here it is mid-July, and the dock is sitting in the yard on blocks and the boat sits on its trailer. The problem? Ohio's weather.

In particular it has been a Spring and Early Summer of rain, lot's of it, and it just so happens that most all the rain that falls in eastern Ohio from a point nearly 100 miles to our north does eventually have to pass by our riverside home. It is not as though we are in danger of being washed away. At normal summer time water levels we get to our dock and boat down a set of 17 wooden steps. Throughout the latter half of May, all of June into early July only 6 of the 17 remained above the fast flowing river. To date we have yet to see the bottom 4 steps and even now the speed of the current is still hazardous boating for all but the more powerfully equipped vessels. It is not as though there will be no time on the boat, it is rather how it is not likely to be done from the convenience of our dock on the river.

There has been joy and fun, especially the day spent with Cheryl Williams and Bob Harris who stopped by while on their OH/PA/NY odyssey away from Gateway. But how ironic, late afternoon the day Cheryl and Bob departed a violent wind and what sounded to be a tornado passed close enough that two large river side trees about 1/4 mile down stream were toppled into a backyard and onto the roof of a screened porch. And then during the night a large portion




