- 2. NO LIFE GUARD ON DUTY SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK.
- 3. NO FOOD OR DRINK OF ANY KIND ARE ALLOWED WITHIN 5' OF POOL OR SPA
- 4. MAXIMUM BATHING LOAD POOL 50 PERSONS / SPA 6 PERSONS.
- 5. PLEASE SHOWER BEFORE ENTERING POOL OR SPA.
- 6. POOL & SPA ARE FOR GATEWAY RESIDENTS ONLY. GUESTS MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A RESIDENT.
- 7. NO LOUD OR BOISTEROUS BEHAVIOR, RUNNING OR JUMPING.
- 8. NO AIR MATTRESSES, FLOTATION DEVICES, MASKS & SNORKELS WHEN POOL OCCUPIED BY MORE THAN 10 PERSONS.
- 9. NO CHILDREN UNDER 12 YEARS OF AGE ARE PERMITTED IN THE SPA.
- 10. PROPER SWIM ATTIRE REQUIRED NO CHILDREN WITH DIAPERS.
- 11. SWIMWEAR COVER-UPS, SHIRT & SHOES REQUIRED TO ENTER THE RECREATION HALL.
- 12. MAXIMUM SPA TEMPERATURE 104 DEG. LIMIT SPA USE TO A MAXIMUM OF 15 MINUTES.
- 13. PREGNANT WOMEN, SMALL CHILDREN, PEOPLE WITH HEALTH PROBLEMS & PEOPLE USING ALCOHOL, NARCOTICS OR DRUGS THAT CAUSE DROWSINESS SHOULD NOT USE SPA WITHOUT CONSULTING A DOCTOR.
- 14. ABSOLUTELY NO GLASS OF ANY KIND IS PERMITTED IN THE POOL OR SPA AREA.

MESSAGE FROM MANAGEMENT

First off I would like to say the swimming pool and Hot Tub situation is getting really out of control and just like in any other situation I know you all have heard me say this before (A nail that sticks out gets hammered) so with that being said now let me give the translation of that statement. We here at Gateway have Residents that complain to the Gateway office about things going on at the pool (Which is Great) but then we have other Residents that send complaints directly to our Home Office (Which is also fine). But when Home Office hears enough of these complaints then they start to look at things as well and they decide to put a stop to certain activities all together. So let me take this a step further. We here at Gateway MHP wish everyone could follow all of the rules of the swimming pool and spa in their entirety, but some or most of the rules posted are being ignored so brushing up on the pool rules may be needed. Here we go.

Rule #3- NO FOOD OR DRINKS OF ANY KIND ARE ALLOWED WITHIN 5 FT OF POOL OR SPA- This means ALL Residents/Guest (No Drinking or Smoking in the pool or hot tub AT ALL)

Rule #6-POOL & SPA ARE FOR GATEWAY RESIDENTS ONLY. GUEST MUST BE **ACCOMPANIED BY A RESIDENT-** Means Everyone

Rule #7- NO LOUD OR BOISTEROUS BEHAVIOR-This has many aspects that are being Ignored (#1-Music at the Pool-Ear Phones to be used-No one else is supposed to hear YOUR music -#2 LANGUAGE- Profane, Vulgar and other wise Offensive Language should not be used at the pool- Although every Resident is important we must keep in mind that we all are a part of a community and others may be offended by foul language, Profanity and/or Racial Slurs and this will not be Tolerated (AT ALL). #3 The Smoking of Cigarettes should be done at the tables (Be mindful of those around you) (Be Respectful) and the Smoking of other Substances (Even if Lawful) should be done in the comforts of your home not passed around like a Sorority House at the pool). #4- Be Mindful of how much you have to drink while at the pool-Although you all are adults when a person drinks a little more than they plan other factors come into play; safety- of intoxicated person & volume levels and content of conversations become less important and we should always be mindful and respectful of our neighbors and possible children in the area

Rule#14-ABSOLUTELY NO GLASS OF ANY KIND IS PERMITTED IN THE POOL OR SPA AREA. - Speaks for Itself

One last issue: Although we want all of our Residents to enjoy their Pool /Spa and other Recreational Facilities- Unauthorized and/or Unplanned parties at the pool should all be going through the GOA Committee to make sure there are no conflicts with scheduling.





PERSONAL SAFETY—BE PREPARED

UCLA Crime Prevention Unit

y taking a few simple precautions, you can reduce the risk to yourself and also discourage those who commit crimes.

- Always be alert and aware of the people around you.
- Educate yourself concerning prevention tactics.
- Be aware of locations and situations which would make you appear vulnerable to crime, such as alleys and dark parking lots.

STREET PRECAUTIONS

- Be alert to your surroundings and the people around you—especially if you are alone or it is dark.
- Whenever possible, travel with a friend.
- Stay in well-lighted areas as much as possible.
- Walk close to the curb. Avoid doorways, bushes and alleys where someone could hide.
- Walk confidently at a steady pace.
- Make eye contact with people when walking.
- Do not respond to conversation from strangers on the street—continue walking.
- If you carry a purse, carry it securely between your arm and your body. Although a purse snatcher's intent is to steal the purse, your personal safety may depend on not clinging to it.
- Do not use or wear anything that will impede your vision or hearing (i.e. iPods).

CAR SAFETY

- Always lock your car doors after entering or leaving your vehicle.
- Park in well-lighted areas.
- Have your car keys in your hand so you don't have to linger before entering your car.
- Check the interior of your vehicle for intruders before entering your car.
- If you think you are being followed, drive to a public place or a police or sheriff station.
- If your car breaks down, open the hood and attach a white cloth to the car antennae. If someone stops to help, stay in your locked car and ask them to call the police, sheriff or a tow truck service.
- Don't stop to aid motorists by the side of the road. Make a phone call requesting help for them.

WHILE WAITING FOR A BUS

- Be alert to your surroundings and the people around you.
- Try to avoid isolated bus stops.
- Don't open your purse or wallet while boarding the bus—have your pass or money already in your hand.
- Keep jewelry out of sight; don't flash jewelry; turn rings around so the stones don't show.



ON BOARD BUSES

- During off hours, ride as near to the bus operator as possible
- If someone bothers you or makes you feel uncomfortable, change seats. Inform the driver of the situation.
- Carry your wallet inside your coat, or in a front pocket.
- Keep your belongings in front of you and hold close to your body with both hands.
- Be alert to pickpocketers on crowded buses; check your purse or wallet if someone is jostling, crowding or pushing you.

OFFICE SECURITY

- Never leave your purse or wallet in plain view or in common accessible areas.
- Don't leave cash or valuables at the office.
- If you work alone or after business hours, keep the office door locked.
- If you work late, try to find another worker or a security guard to walk out with you.
- In an elevator, be mindful that there is a distress alarm on the control panel.
- Be alert for pickpocketers on crowded elevators.
- Report all suspicious persons and activities to the proper authorities (office manager, building security, law enforcement).
- Be aware of escape routes for emergencies and post the police and fire department numbers near telephones.

Finally, if a crime does occur...REPORT IT! Everyone should consider it his or her responsibility to report crime. Many criminals develop favorite areas for committing crime, as well as predictable methods of operation. When you report all the facts about a crime, it helps the police assign officers in the places where crimes are occurring or where they are most likely to occur, and your report may help prevent a crime from reoccurring.

At least half of the crimes in the Unites States go unreported, either because people don't think the police can do anything about it, or because people don't want to get involved. If you don't report a crime, this allows the criminal to continue to operate without interference.

In many cases, it is the information provided by victims and witnesses that leads to the arrest of a criminal. So tell the police as much as you can; no fact is too trivial. The police need the eyes and ears of all citizens.

RUMOR MILL & OTHER THINGS

The Editor

The following is from the 2019 August NewsNDos and deserves repeating. In addition I would add that throughout the past year I have received multiple 'Friend Requests' from FaceBook 'friends' I already have. Prior to accepting 'added requests' you should contact your 'already friend' to verify they have created a new account or to warn them that their account information may have been compromised.

I have been an online computer user from the earliest days of personal computing and even prior to the perils of identity theft and debit cards to purchase gasoline I was aware of and concerned for personal information privacy and security. I have been a purchaser and user of Norton/Symantec Security software for decades and can recall fondly how I was the one being called by friends when their systems had been compromised and was able, through the use of Norton/Symantec tools to get them back online and their fears of future loss allayed.

The following information involving **Home Cyber Security** is printed with permission from a recent **Norton Online Security Newsletter**.

Personal Documents

Paperwork that contains personal information like your social security number is extremely valuable to identity thieves. Make sure important papers (i.e., mortgage documents, vehicle titles, deeds, birth certificates, passports, loan information, estate plans, visas, passports, current and expired licenses) are stored safely. And check on them frequently to make sure they are still there – not just when they need an annual renewal.

Desktop Computers

Some people may think that if your computer is stationary it's not susceptible to hacking. Wrong. Your hardware, software, and network can all be compromised. If your desktop is older and you don't make updates to your operating system or software, you may be exposing the information on your desktop to security holes. Always check for updates, 'bug fixes', and stay alert to any suspicious emails from people you don't know.

Mobile

Our phones feel like extensions of ourselves, and thus they're popular targets for scammers. Cybercriminals continue to develop stealthy new threats for mobile devices - threats that can spy on your location information, steal your passwords or damage your device.

Recycling

While you're trying to be good for the environment you may be aiding identity theft. Make sure you do not throw bills or mail that includes your personal info into the recycling bin without shredding it first.

Laptops

To keep your computer safe, always keep software up to date (even a new laptop right out of the box can have outdated software that's vulnerable to attack). Manufacturers' updates are designed to address security holes in operating systems.

Trash

This one may seem old-fashioned, but your trash can be like a candy store for identity thieves. By digging through your garbage, they can snatch bills, receipts, and credit offers. If your trash has personal information on it, you may be vulnerable.

Craigslist and Online Selling (Summer, 2020)

Since I have been in Ohio (about 2 months) I have sold several items using this popular online market place web site. Typically to avoid scammers I DO NOT list a phone number for contact with regards to the listing. It seems that scammers often use text messages offering to buy your item(s) at an inflated price saying the will send a 'check' and then you are requested to 'ship' the item and pay the shipper.

Everything I have sold was posted to the local Craigslist without a phone number and those interested first contacted me via email and purchase and delivery arrangements (local McDonalds, Post Office parking lot, one came to my home on the river) were made. I later listed a couple monitors and shredder and included a cryptically displayed phone number. Within minutes I received a text message from another area code inquiring whether the items 'were still available.' I responded 'YES' and then added that 'items would not be shipped' and never received a reply. My suggestion, do not include a phone number when offering things for sale online and never include your home address in an online advertisement.
