

The Annual Meeting of the Membership and Election of Directors of the Gateway Homeowners Association (GHA) of Pinellas County, Inc. will be held on Wednesday, December 9, 2015 in the Clubhouse. Registration of voters will start at 7:00 p.m. and the meeting will start at 7:30. Two Directors' positions will be open for election for a 3-year term (January 1, 2016 to December 31, 2018).

Each paid-up household is entitled to one vote. If you have not already done so, please remit your 2015 membership renewal fee of \$2 to the GHA Treasurer, Lana Kennedy. It is important to be a member and attend the meeting as a majority of the membership is required to constitute a quorum of 50% of the members. The election shall be by ballot and a simple majority (50%+1) of the votes cast shall be binding. Votes may be cast in person or by proxy. Proxy forms will be available from June and must be filed with the GHA Secretary, Sandy Vertz, before the meeting.

We thank Director Al Kirkley who is retiring after serving a 3-year term. Any Gateway homeowner who is interested in serving on the Board is encouraged to submit their name to one of the following members of the Nominating Committee: Chair, June Boudreau; Directors Susan Peckham and Al Kirkley; Members-at-Large Bonnie Sisco and Chris Kennedy. Nominations from the floor will also be accepted at the meeting on December 9.


#### **GATEWAY SHUFFLEBOARD**
