t the Homeowners meeting held November 2nd the Directors reported on the rent negotiation session



held with management on October 29th. They noted that management addressed prior issues raised by Directors. Chairs and/or benches to be provided at the laundry room and that the drainage ditch at the east side of the park was the responsibility of the county. [Since that time it has been reported to NewsNDos that maintenance of the eastside ditch is up to the City of Saint Petersburg.]

It was reported that management plans for 2021 include tree trimming, acquiring permits for installation of two new homes, paving the north portion of 1st Lane and possibly some of north 1st Way and to address the erosion occurring at the front pond. Also that the \$12 rent increase had been reduced to \$11.

Among requests by Directors for management consideration were provisions for shading at the pool, an ID system for pool use, Bocci Courts, a variety of security issues.

It was noted that management would no longer be responsible for trapping and removing feral cats, opossums, coyotes, raccoons, armadillos, fruit rats etc.

Seven (7) officers of the Homeowners Association and twenty-one (21) residents attended the meeting. All residents of Gateway are invited to attend the Homeowners Association Annual Meeting and Election to be held Wednesday evening at 7:30 pm, December 9th at the clubhouse. Masks and social distancing Covid-19 protocols will be observed. Members who wish to pay dues and those wishing to join the HOA are requested to arrive prior to the 7:30 start time.
