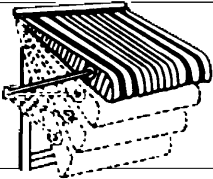

In other news, palm tree replacement and trimming has been approved and will start as soon as a maintenance position is filled.

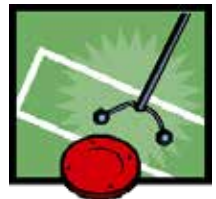
Power hook-up poles: If yours needs to be replaced you are to notify management so it can be added to the list. Those in the worst condition will be the first to be replaced.

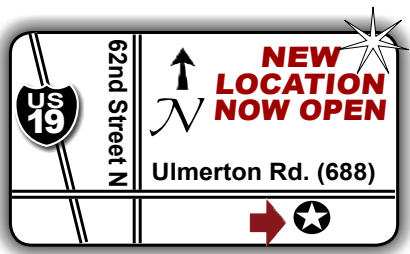

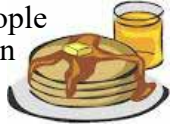




PANCAKE BREAKFAST
