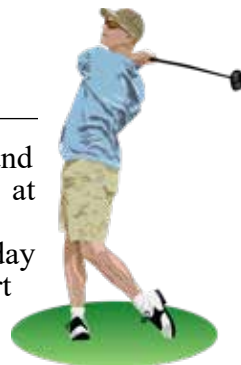
GATEWAY MEN'S GOLF

Last count showed the Park with 16 empty lots with rumors that at least two are soon to be filled with new double-wide homes. There are still some homes showing signs of wear and tear suffered by the passage of Hurricane Irma but all-in-all the homes throughout the park weathered the storm well. There should be no question that Park owners, ARC Investments is committed to maintaining the quality and profitability of its investment. The current active home sale picture at Gateway as of the second week of December was: three (3) single-wide on Bay Street; two (2) single-wide and three (3) double-wide on 1st Street; one (1) single-wide and one (1) double-wide on 1st Way, and; two (2) double-wide on 1st Lane.

Where has all the Gandy Blvd and 4th Street southbound traffic backups gone? I am loving it! Someone even remarked they did an over-and-back to Home Depot in under 20 minutes. I know they didn't have Kathy with them but west bound out the front entrance to the Park once you get a green light at 4th Street will have you to I-275 in under 4 minutes. You still have to be careful to avoid hitting the center divider curb under the 4th Street bridge when making a left turn onto 4th Street from westbound Gandy. I have not yet selected which will be my preferred eastbound Gandy U-turn location to get to the front entrance. Time of day, especially when the side entrance gate is closed will no doubt be my determining factor, otherwise from any point other than the flyover, the side entrance is my preferred route. One thing I will urge is that residents using the side entrance please respect the fact that there are children at Sienna Bay and that you drive slowly and be watchful while on 106th Avenue between the park gate and 4th Street.

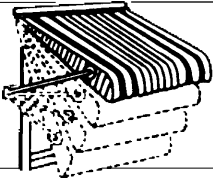

But when I consider how we have a new Dunkin' Donuts and Chicago Pizza to the north and new Culver's and possibly something opening where the Tic-Toc and Sloppy Pelican and whatever were formally located, I have to wonder just how much money some people have to gamble in the food service business.

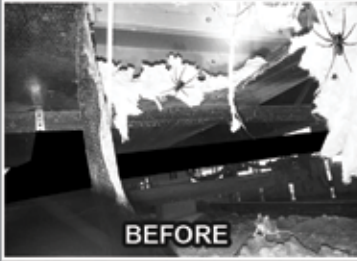
