

MESSAGE FROM MANAGEMENT

(Editors Note: The following is a reprint of a community flyer that management distributed throughout the park and is included in News N Dos at their request.)

RULE REMINDER - the prospectus and rules state:

BOAT AND RV STORAGE AREA: All items in this area have been red tagged June 1, 2015. You have 30 days to bring your registration to the office in order to claim ownership of your stored item. All unclaimed items will be removed after the 30 days at the owners expense.

•GUESTS: Register your guests with the office

•PETS: Register your pet with the office. 2 Pets per home with a weight limit of 35lbs

•THE MOBILE HOMÊ SITE: The home site shall be kept orderly, neat and free from litter and debris. Mowing, trimming, watering, weeding and general care of lawn and shrubs once every (10) days during the growth season from April through October. All trash containers must be stored out of sight. No mowing is permitted on Sunday's.

•THE MOBILE HOME: No storage is permitted on CARPORTS and around the outside of the home. Only furniture specifically designed for outside use and in good useable condition is allowed outside the home. The items must be kept to a reasonable limit.

•12 FOOT RIGHT OF WAY: Nothing can be planted or built except a private walk way to the front door within the 12' between the road and the front of the home.

•PAINTING AND PRESSURE WASHING: Homes must be pressure washed and painted to maintain community standards. Any changes to the outside of the home, including paint colors, must be approved by the Community Manager before any work is done.

•SPEED LIMIT: The community speed limit is 15 MPH. Please slow down to help keep everyone safe.

•PARKING: No overnight parking on the streets or around the Clubhouse is permitted. Parking on the grass is prohibited. Please remind your guests.

•PROPER ATTIRE: Proper dress is required while using the recreational areas and in the common areas of the community. Shirts and/or cover ups must be worn to and from the pool area.

•WILDLIFE FEEDING: Do not feed the ducks and stray cats.

•POOL AND SPA: This Pool and Spa area is only open from 7:00AM until DARK. Do not use this area after DARK



Trust in others rises as people grow older

In a cynical world, trust can seem hard to come by. But new research suggests it may grow as we get older. The World Values Survey, collecting data from more than 200,000 people in 83 nations, found that more than a third of people 80 years old or older agreed with that most people can be trusted, although just a quarter of 20-year-olds said the same.

The results were consistent regardless of nationality, gender, education, and income.

A similar study, analyzing data from the General Social Survey of 1,230 U.S. citizens over time, also found that our willingness to trust increases as we grow older.

One possible explanation: As time goes on, most people tend to simplify their lives and spend more time with their families, resulting in a more positive and generous attitude about the world.



That morning cup of coffee may be really good for you

lot of us depend on a cup of coffee or two to get going in the morning. But coffee may have even more significant health benefits. Here's a quick look at what it may do to improve your life:

- Melanoma. A study by the National Institutes of Health and the AARP found that the more coffee people drink during the day, the lower their chances of developing melanoma over a 10-year period. Four cups of coffee a day was associated to a 20 percent drop in melanoma risk.
- Multiple sclerosis. An analysis of two studies of people diagnosed with MS (one in the U.S. and one in Sweden) found that consuming at least four cups of coffee a day appears to delay the onset of symptoms. The caffeine, researchers say, seems to have neuroprotective properties that inhibit MS development.
- Liver cancer. Drinkers of three or more alcoholic beverages a day may be able to cut their risk of liver cancer by drinking coffee, according to a recent World Cancer Research Fund report. Coffee and coffee extracts appear to have a preventative effect on the expression of genes involved with inflammation—an effect that's most prevalent in the liver.
