The Editor (source: GAO Meeting Minutes)

The February 1st meeting of the GAO Board of Directors was chaired by Vice-President Jackie Branson. Following the Treasurer's Report and Approval of the January Meeting Minutes it was noted under Old Business that prior subjects of interest, including swans, pool heater and rent refunds had yet to be discussed.

Under new business it was noted that the new pool heater had been installed and that pool and hot-tub temperatures were being reported daily on Facebook. It was suggested by a resident that pool and hot-tub heaters be converted to gas for better reliability.

It was reported the Board has again expressed concerns for park security to Manager Susan Worden.

A resident noted the existence of younger than 55 people living at Gateway. It was explained that up to 20% of residents can be under age 55 yet the park still be considered as a 55+ community. The Board noted they would put the question to Park Management.

There was some discussion regarding the storage area at the north end of the park and the recent request by Management that vehicles and trailers parked in the area be accounted for and ownership and current licensing information be provided to the Park Office.

There was mention of over-sized pets present in the park and in response to some remarks concerning Park security it was noted that the Pinellas County Sheriff's Department regularly patrol the streets during overnight and though less frequently during daytime hours.

Ms. Branson took note of the questions of residents and expressed how the Board would forward the concerns of the residents to Park Management.
