GATEWAY HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION

The Editor (source: GHA Meeting Minutes)

The February 6th meeting of the GHA Board of Directors was chaired by President Len Stevens. Following the Treasurer's Report and Approval of the January Meeting Minutes it was noted under Old Business that the primary issue of interest is the growing number of Muscovey ducks and concerns for the health hazard they continue to present. It was noted that the Homeowners Association at the behest of residents had contacted a company specializing in removal and maintaining a duck free environment at a cost estimated to be \$5000 to \$6500. This information was forwarded to park management.

It was reported a petition has been circulated, again regarding the duck population, and how there existed another option for removing the ducks at a cost of \$10 per head. (At last Editors count there were approximately 60 mature Muscoveys at any particular time within Gateway. On February 13th nineteen (19) newly hatched ducklings were observed in the grass of the Sienna Bay apartments just beyond the side entrance.)

Pool and Hot Tub repairs/renovations originally scheduled for October, 2016 are now in limbo with no firm date scheduled.

Other issues discussed were dead palm trees, street lights out and how the street sign and front entrance camera were damaged by an errant motorist. There were also concerns expressed regarding the health of pets being impacted by the existence of duck droppings throughout the streets and yards in the park.

[Editors Note: Pinellas County Animal Control has said that there is nothing they can do regarding the ducks but when a stray cat is captured you can contact the department and they will come and take the cat away.]




GATEWAY YARD AND PATIO SALE





Help for Severe Aortic Stenosis



Severe aortic stenosis is a narrowed aortic heart valve that doesn't open and close properly, reducing blood flow to the rest of the body.

Morton Plant Hospital is now enrolling eligible patients in the Medtronic Evolut R low-risk trial, which investigates the safety and effectiveness of a transcatheter aortic valve replacement (TAVR) system in patients with severe aortic stenosis who are at a low surgical mortality risk. TAVR is a minimally invasive alternative to open-heart surgery used to treat failing aortic heart valves in patients with severe aortic stenosis. Morton Plant Hospital was chosen as the first hospital in Tampa Bay to offer the TAVR procedure for patients with severe aortic stenosis who were at an intermediate or high surgical mortality risk. Our team has completed more than 700 TAVR procedures over the last five years.




