Gateway home owner's meetings are **held every other month on the First Monday**of the month at 7:30 pm. The next meeting will be on March 4th. Notices are posted in the Club House, Laundry (at times various notices have been removed by someone at the laundry) and in the outside notice cases on the Club House. Meetings are also marked on the Gateway calendar and in Let's Connect. As the new President, I had signs made up to place at both park entrances as a reminder for up coming meetings. Everyone involved in various park activities posts information about upcoming events. Please take a minute when driving by the Club House to check notices in the outside notice boxes and read your News and Nos. AWARENESS!

Residents are encouraged to come to the meetings, as you hear various issues discussed with the Board and members present. You can talk with us after a meeting or call us if you have a more personal concern. Our phone numbers are on the inside front cover of this magazine. 





ateway Bingo continues to maintain a strong run of well attended and well paid Tuesday evenings. We enjoyed steady attendance exceeding 30 players throughout February with game payouts of \$30 and \$35. The Jackpot payout has averaged nearly \$100 during the season and on one occasion a special payout rule was put in effect the first time ever due to the size of a Jackpot exceeding \$150. All money collected from the sale of game sheets is paid back as game prizes each evening and this seasons average weekly total prizes are exceeding last years by \$100. The greater the number of players, the larger the payouts, so come by and add to your winnings.

A special introductory game package is available and you can enjoy all 18 games for a cost of \$11. Other multi-sheet game packs cost \$12 and \$18 respectively, are purchased and then combined with 'a la carte' sheets to round out the 18 game session.

Gateway Bingo begins with the sale of game packages each Tuesday at 4:45 pm. Game sheet sales end at 6:00 and play can begin as early as 6:15. There is a 15-minute half-time break following our 50/50 game and the session usually finishes prior to 9 o'clock.

Special thanks to all who volunteer additional time to assist in bringing each weekly Bingo session to a 'clean' and successful conclusion. 


