CREATIVE COLORING



your inner artist, relax and color.



ateway Management wishes to thank everyone for their continued effort in cleaning up their properties but we still have three very big remaining issues.

- **ALL FENCES MUST GO**- Absolutely Every Fence (Front and Back Yards Must Go) I am doing my absolute best to get these problems fixed without handing out violations. I am trying my best to clean up (YOUR HOMES, YOUR PARK)
 --WITHOUT CREATING ANYMORE ANOMOSITY BETWEEN THE OFFICE AND OUR RESIDENTS. But I keep falling on deaf ears. I must get these issues taken care of one way or the other and I will make sure it does.







Surprising discoveries around the solar system

discoveries about other worlds orbiting the sun:

• The moon. A mass of metal beneath the surface of the moon's south pole has been discovered by scientists, The New York Times reports. It's under a huge, 4-billion-year-old impact crater, and it's five times bigger than Hawaii. Scientists at Baylor University speculate that it's composed of the remains of an ancient meteor that created what's known as the South Pole-Aitken—near where the Chinese Chang'e 4 lunar rover landed in January.

The solar system is full of surprises. Here are three startling new



- Mars. Scientists have discovered a huge reservoir of water underneath the Martian north pole, the Gizmodo website reports. The water was detected inside a deposit of multiple layers of water ice mixed with sand, and it formed over hundreds of millions of years. It's about 1.2 miles beneath the north pole, and contains enough water to submerge the entire planet.
- Europa. This moon of Jupiter has long been known to have an ocean beneath its surface layer of ice—an ocean with more water than all of Earth's oceans combined. Now the Hubble Space Telescope has detected what appears to be sodium chloride— NaCl—in the seas, the Fox News website reports. Sodium chloride, which makes up ordinary table salt, is also a major ingredient in Earth's salt-water oceans—meaning that Europa may be more Earthlike than previously thought.
