





GATEWAY COMMUNITY TIE-DOWN PROGRAM

n September 6, Amber Turner, the representative from Windstorm spoke about the Free Tie Down Program. She gave very detailed information about the program. Here is what I can recap. Windstorm has been in Florida for 18 years and has done over 38,000 Tie Downs in 14 years. They are Licensed, Insured and bonded in the state of Florida.

One of the problems with old ties is that acid in soil can cause them to weaken or rust out. They place straps over the I beam and around structure and hand tighten straps. They leave a little bit of give when tightened. Straps protect your home and give more wind resistance as property protection allowed. This program in no way is intended to make your home up to Codes. The funds for this program come from a grant through the CAT fund.

The minimum for your home to quality - must be older than the year 2000 and be able to have at least 4 anchor tie downs put in place. She discussed other factors that could disqualify someone, such as lack of access to beams. They need 12 to 15 inches of clearance. If your home does not quality—your skirting will not be removed.

They come with a crew of 14 to 20 guys and all wear Windstorm shirts for ID.

The crew will work from 8 to 4:30 with a 1 hour lunch and on a good day may be able to do 40 homes.

Amber, Brent or Cody are managers from Windstorm, and one of them will always be in the park with the crews. She said that they request that if there is any problem, you locate a manager and not bother the crew workers. Crew workers work in any assembly type pattern on site.

WEEK 1 Skirting will be removed and placed on your property for storage.

If your skirting is still on, your home did not qualify. There needs to be 12 - 15 inches of clearance access. They do not remove continuous metal sheeting as it bends and too hard to put back on.

Star block with pattern will also not be put back, as it tends to crumble.

Chicken wire will be put back up if not rusty or so old that it will not keep its shape for reinstall.

They will not be responsible for broken items removed due to wear and tear, but as Amber said, if she trips while carrying a brick and breaks it, it will be replaced by Windstorm.

WEEK 2 Tie Downs will be installed.

An inspector from the State of Florida will come on site and randomly inspect 10% of homes done.

Third week Skirting will be put back up.

I think this is a good benefit. She said that if your skirting (bricks, chicken wire or other material) is in very poor shape or you did not have any, if you buy replacement skirting and have it waiting there at time of reinstall of skirting, they will put it on for FREE—yes FREE. They will not cut or size it. Example -- chicken wire in a roll would need to be cut and sized by the home owner if you buy new – remember install FREE!! You can get items at Home Depot, Lowes or Mobile Home Depot or any other place you choose.

Amber also discussed that as they work around the property, they paint mark and locate water line, sewer and other lines. They try their best not to cause a problem, but if a line would be hit, they would be responsible for fixing it. She said they have various parts with them for repairs if needed. She said they will also tell the home owner if they happen to see a pre existing

leaking water pipe when they are working.

When your home is finished, each person will receive a certificate of completion.

You may show it to your insurance agent, but it may not help to reduce your insurance depending on your plan. Amber stressed that the program is not to bring your home up to any codes or for insurance purposes.

She passed around booklets with pictures of the procedure and what the strapping looks like. At the end questions were answered.

One interesting question was that car ports are not done. Car ports not anchored as they would be the first to blow off and if anchored would do more damage to the side of your home.

Someone asked about how much tie downs would cost if they had to pay for them and not getting them through this grant program. Amber answered between \$3000 and \$5000.

They will also put as many tie downs as they can for each home and each one is different, you will receive a minimum of at least 4.

There were over 40 people in attendance and we have 48 forms received. Several people took forms for neighbors with them. We are confident that Gateway will meet the 100 forms to qualify for the program on our own and not have to wait to be combined with another park.






