FROM THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The Board of Directors receives information on a daily basis of residents who are not following rules in the community. In response to a request for Board intervention, please see the listing below:

*** Quoted from Rules & Regulations***

- Dogs and cats shall be leashed and under the control of the owner/handler at all times when outside the home. The leash should not exceed six feet in length.
- Overnight parking on streets is NOT permitted. Use of parking spaces at the garage area require a permit issued by the Condo office.
- Residents and guests are expected to abide by the 15 miles per hour speed limit in the community.
- Residents are NOT permitted to work on vehicle repairs in their carports.
- Children under the age of 16 are NOT permitted to operate golf carts in the neighborhood.
- Garbage should be secured in the appropriate containers for pick-up.

Quoted from the By-Laws

• 15.18 **FEEDING OF WILD ANIMALS AND BIRDS.** The feeding of all wild animals and birds, including but not limited to pigeons, egrets, rabbits, opossums, feral cats, and squirrels are prohibited. Bird feeders on common ground, limited common ground, or Units is prohibited.

Any person who violates this Rule may be subject to a fine.

The only pets which are permitted are cats, dogs, fish and small birds.

The total number of dogs and cats allowed in any Unit shall be limited to two (2). Birds ae also limited to (2). Birds should be caged when taken outside the home.

In addition, our community has a serious problem with feral cats. Residents are feeding these animals and they are multiplying. They are causing considerable damage to the community. There are also issues with racoons causing damage to the roof of the clubhouse. It is difficult to trap these animals because they being fed by residents on a regular basis. If any resident witnesses someone putting food out for wild animals (this includes bird feeders), please contact the office.

Life is born, then dies, on the moon

Excitement was high when China announced that it had successfully grown cotton on the lunar surface—cotton seeds planted in a "minibiosphere," according to the Newsweek website, using a sealed container filled with water, soil, and air, that was carried to the far side of the moon in its Chang'e 4 lander. Scientists also added yeast, fruit fly eggs, and seeds including cotton, rapeseed, and potato.

The Chinese National Space Administration reported that the cotton seeds had sprouted a significant achievement. However, the next day the CNSA reported that the sprouts had died over the lunar night. The deaths weren't unexpected—the seeds require natural light from the sun.

It's not considered a failure, though. Controlled growth of plant life on the moon increases hopes that someday humans will be able to build a sustainable base on Earth's lunar partner.

Fast radio bursts are a puzzle to scientists

RBs have been a puzzle to astronomers since they were first detected. An FRB consists of a brief, bright signal of radio energy emanating from distant galaxies. Although most FRBs last only a few milliseconds, two repeating FRBs have been detected—one in 2016, and a second one today in 2019, according to the Science News website.

The 2016 repeating FRB was tracked to a black hole in a far-off galaxy. The new one is about 1.6 billion light-years away. Theories about what causes repeating FRBs include spinning neutron stars, black holes, and even—possibly—alien life.

Science means constantly walking a tightrope between blind faith and curiosity; between expertise and creativity; between bias and openness; between experience and epiphany; between ambition and passion; and between arrogance and conviction—in short, between an old today and a new tomorrow.

How to help a friend with depression

ne in six people will experience serious depression during their lifetime, and knowing what to say and how to act around them can help them cope with the condition better. From the HuffPost website come these suggestions for helping friends and family deal with their depression:

• Listen. Don't offer solutions nor try to "fix" things. Most people with depression have heard suggestions. They mostly just want someone to listen to them.

• **Help out**. Many people with depression find themselves unable to perform everyday, routine tasks. Offer to do some household chores that they can't handle.

• Make specific offers. Don't just say, "Is there anything I can do?" Instead, volunteer with specific suggestions: "Can I do your laundry?" or, "Would you like me to take you grocery shopping?"

• **Be patient**. Try to remember what they're going through. If they're sad, frustrated, or lethargic, don't insist that they feel better. Reassure them that you still care about them.

• Send a quick text. A joke or cartoon can brighten your friend's day and signal that you're thinking of him or her.

• **Don't take things personally**. Depressed people sometimes resist efforts to help. They may withdraw into themselves and shut others out. Don't abandon them. Remember that it's the depression talking, not the person inside.

• Offer reassurance. Don't be a Pollyanna, but remind them that they're good people and strong enough to get over this. Even if they don't respond, hearing such reassuring words will help.



• Tell them it's all right. Don't blame them for their depression, nor let them blame themselves. Tell them that it's OK not to feel OK all the time.

• Share small gifts. Bring a treat or some flowers, or send a card letting them know you're thinking of them. A small gesture can mean a lot to someone who's depressed.



Avoid Alzheimer's with these tips

Izheimer's disease is the sixth-leading cause of death in the United States and the only one in the top 10 that cannot be prevented, treated, or cured. However, growing evidence indicates that people can reduce their risk of cognitive decline by making key lifestyle changes. From the Alzheimer's Association come these tips for keeping your mind healthy as you age:

• **Break a sweat.** Engage in regular cardiovascular exercise that elevates your heart rate and increases blood flow to the brain and body. Several studies have found an association between physical activity and reduced risk of cognitive decline.

• Hit the books. Formal education in any stage of life will help reduce your risk of cognitive decline and dementia. For example, take a class at a local college, a community center, or online.

• Fuel up right. Eat a healthy and balanced diet that is lower in fat and higher in vegetables and fruit to help reduce the risk of cognitive decline. Although research on diet and cognitive function is limited, certain diets, including Mediterranean and Mediterranean-DASH (Dietary Approaches to Stop Hypertension), may contribute to risk reduction.

• Catch some z's. Not getting enough sleep due to conditions like insomnia or sleep apnea may result in problems with memory and thinking.






