

STREET SEALING AND REPAIR PROJECT

Jan Troke, Jim Wildes, & Bob Green

The following is information about the repairing and sealing of our streets. Everyone will receive a color coded schedule with this on the reverse side. If there is rain, the work will be done the next day.

People and pets can walk on the streets after 2 hours. Vehicles (bikes, golf carts, cars, etc.) can be on the streets after 2 days (48 hours).

The following is a list of adjustments for the work period:

- 1. Lake water pumps will be turned off for the duration of the work, 7/7 thru 7/14 depending on the weather.
 - 2. No garbage pick-up on 7/9.
 - 3. Parking rules will not be in effect. Parking will be allowed on the streets, club house, Trash and Treasure building if work is not being done at that time.
 - 4. Grass cutting will be done on 7/7. You will be notified about 7/14.
- 5. Daily handouts with current information will be distributed to appropriate streets during the

work period.

6. U.S. mail will be delivered.

How can you help?

- 1. Follow walking/driving times.
- 2. Try not to have UPS/FedEx deliveries during the work period. Other deliveries, i.e., furniture,
- appliances, etc. will not be allowed in if access requires using streets being worked on or are

in the 48 hour drying period.

- 3. Stock up on groceries and supplies.
- 4. Volunteer to work at the Access Control Building to direct traffic and make deliveries on a golf cart. A sign-up sheet will be posted later.
- 5. Call Jan Troke (593-8178) you know of residents who have to go out for Chemo, dialysis, etc.
 - 6. Help your neighbors, if needed, and try to keep smiling.

IRRIGATION

et us try, once again, to clarify who is responsible for damage done to your sprinkler heads by the mowers. Contrary to popular belief they are not ALWAYS at fault. Each resident has to be mindful that their irrigation system is functioning properly. This means making sure your sprinkler heads retract to ground level when watering is completed. Let me quote the Rules & Regulations pg. 7, "SPRINKLERS" rule 4. "Sprinkler heads must be located at ground level to prevent damage from lawn cutting. The lawn cutting contractor is responsible for damage to sprinkler heads at ground level. Damage to sprinkler heads above the ground level is the responsibility of the home owner." It is just as simple as that. Proper maintenance of your irrigation system is the best defense you have against damage from the mowers.

Eliminate the obstacles to a good night's rest

good night's sleep is essential to everyone's health, and yet many people have trouble getting the shut-eye they need. If you're not waking up feeling refreshed and ready to start your day with energy, check out these problems that may be preventing you from sleeping soundly:

- Procrastination. You know you should go to bed, but you let yourself get distracted by household tasks or the TV. Set a firm time limit on your evening and stick to it.
- Caffeine. Avoid coffee and other caffeinated drinks after 3 p.m. The effects can linger for up to seven hours, making sleep difficult by the time you need to go to bed.
- Heat. You may not be sweating, but feeling just a little too warm can keep you from dropping off. Try sticking one foot out from under the covers to balance the temperature.
- Stress. The news, your job, or personal worries can make relaxation and sleep difficult. Practice meditation and other techniques to un-tense your body and your mind.
- Work. If your job starts too early in the morning, you'll have trouble waking up and performing well. Try to negotiate a later arrival time. Emphasize how your productivity will increase if you get the right amount of rest.

Prevent back pain before it strikes

Back pain can make your work difficult no matter what job you do. Lifting heavy items is only one potential source of damage; poor posture and repetitive movements can also cause strain and pain. Keep your back in good shape with these general tips from the Mayo Clinic website:

- Get some exercise. Losing weight and staying in shape will decrease wear and tear on your back muscles. Combine aerobic activity with strength training that stretches and strengthens your stomach and back.
- Practice good posture. Your parents were right when they told you to stand up straight. Make a point of keeping your weight balanced on both feet without slouching. Use a chair with good back support, and make sure it's the right height, allowing you to keep both feet flat on the floor and your knees on the same level as your hips.



Trust in others rises as people grow older

In a cynical world, trust can seem hard to come by. But new research suggests it may grow as we get older. The World Values Survey, collecting data from more than 200,000 people in 83 nations, found that more than a third of people 80 years old or older agreed with that most people can be trusted, although just a quarter of 20-year-olds said the same.

The results were consistent regardless of nationality, gender, education, and income.

A similar study, analyzing data from the General Social Survey of 1,230 U.S. citizens over time, also found that our willingness to trust increases as we grow older.

One possible explanation: As time goes on, most people tend to simplify their lives and spend more time with their families, resulting in a more positive and generous attitude about the world.



That morning cup of coffee may be really good for you

A lot of us depend on a cup of coffee or two to get going in the morning. But coffee may have even more significant health benefits. Here's a quick look at what it may do to improve your life:

- Melanoma. A study by the National Institutes of Health and the AARP found that the more coffee people drink during the day, the lower their chances of developing melanoma over a 10-year period. Four cups of coffee a day was associated to a 20 percent drop in melanoma risk.
- Multiple sclerosis. An analysis of two studies of people diagnosed with MS (one in the U.S. and one in Sweden) found that consuming at least four cups of coffee a day appears to delay the onset of symptoms. The caffeine, researchers say, seems to have neuroprotective properties that inhibit MS development.
- Liver cancer. Drinkers of three or more alcoholic beverages a day may be able to cut their risk of liver cancer by drinking coffee, according to a recent World Cancer Research Fund report. Coffee and coffee extracts appear to have a preventative effect on the expression of genes involved with inflammation—an effect that's most prevalent in the liver.

- Tamara Rojo, ballet dancer. "An idea never comes to me suddenly; it sits inside me for a while, and then emerges."
- Mark-Anthony Turnage, composer. "If you get overexcited by an idea, take a break and come back to it later. It is all about developing a cold eye with which to look over your own work."
- Fyfe Dangerfield, musician. "For me, the image of the tortured artist is a myth—you don't need to be miserable to write songs. In fact, if I am feeling down, the last thing I want to do is write; though it's important sometimes just to sit down and get on with it, however you're feeling. Your creativity is like a tap: if you don't use it, it gets clogged up."




