

#### **President's Report**

he hot days of summer have come to Florida. Rain almost every day and high humidity to make it very uncomfortable. But the work in our park keeps going on through the summer.

The storm grates on several streets have been repaired. The areas around the grates have been collapsing over time and becoming a hazard to walking and driving. The areas around the grates (about a foot wide) were removed and replaced with new stronger cement.

The pool heater that was only three months old was finally replaced with a new heater and we hope it will last a longer time than the last one. We are still trying to get our money back on the last heater but are having trouble with the company that installed it.

We had a request to change the rail going down in the pool to two hand rails for easier access in and out of the pool. Some of our residences need more support to navigate the stairs in and out of the pool.

Last spring when replacing a section of sideway by Robert's work shop we encountered a hole that dropped four foot in the ground. At first, we thought it was a sink hole. We called the insurance company to look at the hole. They concluded it was caused by water. We hired an engineer and tested for water leaking but no leaks were found. He thought that a drain line from the washers caused the hole. We called in the drain team and they recommended having the area excavated. We had the excavation done and the only thing found was a rotten tree root that was buried years ago caused a void in the ground. The area was refilled, and the area was cemented over again.

Don Webb has been working with the city about installing a fence from the hobby shop to San Christopher.

We had a request from the resident on the end of Fourth Street to finish the last section of fence. We only own the land to the center of the culvert. We asked if we could install the fence next to their chain link fence. We are waiting till we get something in writing from the city before going forward with the fence.

We are scheduling road repair and street sealing for October first. We are having 862 feet of road repairs and the whole park sealed.

#### **Highly Processed Foods Linked to Weight Gain**

study found that when people consumed a diet of highly processed foods, they took in more calories and gained more weight than when on a diet of minimally processed foods. Researchers compared the effects of a highly processed and a minimally processed diet in 10 men and 10 women residing for four weeks at the NIH Clinical Center. Each diet lasted for two weeks.

People received three meals per day plus snacks. They could eat as much or as little as they wanted. Processed foods usually have a lot of calories, salt, sugar, and fat and are low in fiber, but the researchers matched the meals for these nutrients. The highly processed diet had foods like canned ravioli, hot dogs, chicken nuggets, pork sausage, and tater tots. The minimally processed diet had foods like salad, grilled beef roast and vegetables, and baked fish. People noted that the diets both tasted good and were satisfying. On the highly processed diet, people ate more calories and gained an average of 2 pounds. On the unprocessed diet, they ate fewer calories and lost about 2 pounds.

The results support the benefits of unprocessed foods. But the researchers note that processed foods can be difficult to avoid. "Just telling people to eat healthier may not be effective for some people without improved access to healthy foods," says NIH obesity expert Dr. Kevin Hall, who led the study. More studies are needed to better understand how processed food affects weight.
